PRESIDENTIAL VIDEO: GENERIC FAST TRACK MESSAGE

I'd like to talk to you today about an issue of critical national importance. The issue is free trade -- and the key is something called Fast Track.

The future of all the world -- and especially of the United States -- hinges on freedom and trade. Last year, exports provided 84 percent of our total economic growth. We want to build on that success by fighting for free-trade reform worldwide, in the Uruguay Round trade talks. We want to build closer relations with Mexico and Latin America, through the North American Free Trade Agreement and the Enterprise for the Americas Initiative.

A North American Free Trade Agreement would create a single economic market of 360 million people, who produce \$6 trillion in output each year. It would improve our ties to Mexico, with whom our trade has doubled in just five years, and which now is our third largest trading partner.

Free trade offers the promise of new American jobs, and new economic opportunities throughout the world. It can help us improve our lives. It can help other nations improve theirs.

But we will not be able to answer the call of free trade without Fast Track.

Let me tell you what Fast Track means. Fast track means "good faith." It means we will not alter trade agreements that

our negotiators have reached with their partners. It means Congress will vote yes or no on such agreements within a set period of time. It ensures honest negotiations -- and good agreements.

Fast Track promotes cooperation and consultation between the President and Congress, just as it builds good faith with our trading partners. It prevents our changing agreements -- and forcing trade negotiators to return to square one.

Soon, Congress will vote on whether to extend the Fast Track procedure. Although the issue may sound complicated, it's really very simple. A vote for Fast Track is a vote for the future.

So I ask this: Take the lead. Help me make the case for Fast Track -- in your communities, in the halls of Congress, across the country. Fast Track will keep us on the track to steady growth and a strong economy.

Good afternoon to everyone in beautiful Fenway Park. Soon you will watch two of baseball's most fabled teams -- the ((Detroit Tigers)) // and the Boston Red Sox -- battle it out on the field.

But before the game begins, I would like to honor a man and a feat that will live forever in the hearts of Red Sox fans -- and all baseball fans. This year marks the silver anniversary of a fabled feat by the Splendid Splinter. Fifty years ago, Ted Williams amazed America by hitting .406 for the season -- the last time anyone in major league baseball batted at or above .400.

As a student in Andover, I followed Ted's daily progress. Most days I'd turn to the box scores first thing to see how he had done the night before. I remember cheering his successful days at the plate, thrilling to his heroics on the basepaths and in the field.

Ted Williams may be the greatest hitter the game ever produced. Certainly, he was one of the most determined. He taught everyone a lot about character, hard work, and completing a mission.

I'll always remember that on the last day of the year, even though he was already at .400, he chose not to sit on the bench and protect his batting average. Instead, he played both games of a doubleheader. True to form, he went six for eight and lifted his average to .406.

As we celebrate the silver anniversary of Ted's unforgettable year, let's remember what he taught us about ourselves. His courage and leadership inspired a generation. He did not flinch from challenges, or shrink from doing what he considered right and good. With America on the eve of the second world war, Williams laid down his bat and served his country. He helped unite Americans in the struggle that followed.

So, Ted, congratulations on a baseball landmark and a career for our time -- for all time. And to all the mothers attending this game -- Barbara joins me in wishing each of you the happiest of Mother's Day.

Fast Track promotes cooperation and consultation between the President and Congress, just as it builds good faith with our trading partners. It prevents our changing agreements -- and forcing trade negotiators to return to square one.

Soon, Congress will vote on whether to extend the Fast Track procedure. Although the issue may sound complicated, it's really very simple. A vote for Fast Track is a vote for free trade.

He did not flinch from challenges, or shrink from doing what he considered right and good. With America on the eve of the second world war, Williams laid down his bat and served his country. He helped unite Americans in the struggle that followed.

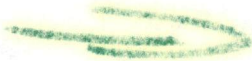
