SATURDAY, DECEMBER 7, 1991

- o Alumni of Army and Navy / fellow veterans / fellow Americans: I speak to you from the deck of the USS MISSOURI.
- o Today: a time to reflect -- look back to one of this century's defining moments....
- o This morning: a time of tremendous emotion.... On the Arizona.... At the Punchbowl....

- o Today, we celebrate another event which unites America: Something all-American about the fact that this 50th anniversary falls on the day of the great contest between Army-Navy.
