Today I am proud to announce my Fiscal Year 1993 budget proposals for programs that advance a whole new way of thinking about protecting our environment while promoting economic growth. With this new budget, I'm making it a top priority to foster innovative technologies that create new jobs and increase our national wealth -- while offering better means of preventing pollution.

Let me begin with our proposals to expand the cleanup of Department of Energy facilities and other federal installations. We're taking a big step forward -- we're making the federal government live up to the same standards it imposes on the private sector. I'm asking for over 5.5 billion dollars for Department of Energy cleanup programs -- a 26 percent increase over last year. Government-wide, I'm asking for almost 9.5 billion dollars to clean up federal facilities. I'm seeking to increase the Superfund to 1.75 billion dollars -- and most important, to shift Superfund allocations dramatically away from overhead expenses and into direct cleanup efforts.

With both our federal facilities cleanup and Superfund, we're putting greater stress than ever on fostering new technologies. We're also increasing by 24 percent our commitment to conservation research and development -- a program we've now doubled in size since I became President. American technological breakthroughs not only will save our taxpayers and businesses money in the long run -- they also will help this country create new goods and services for export to the rapidly growing international markets in environmental systems.

Good stewardship of the environment is a key element in our effort to reach new heights of prosperity through the North American Free Trade Agreement. My new budget will nearly double the funds for air and water quality and hazardous waste management along the United States-Mexico border.

The new budget builds momentum for my crusade to plant more trees in America -- at least one billion trees a year through the end of this decade. I'm asking Congress to more than double funding for reforestation -- an increase of 111 percent.

My budget proposes both to enhance the protection and to increase the recreational use of our parks, wildlife refuges, forests and other public lands. We will increase the number of boat ramps, campsites, and trails for outdoor recreation in parks and other public lands -- and we will do it while protecting their key environmental features.

Governor Wilson, it's a special pleasure to announce a number of environmental programs that will benefit California.

I'm proposing 18 million dollars in new funds for transforming the Presidio into a national park, as well as 14 million dollars for the new Santa Monica Mountains Park and 12 million dollars for the park project in the Headwaters Forest. I'm also proposing a total of 170 million dollars in new federal support for the Los Angeles, San Diego, Tijuana, and Mexicali sewage treatment programs. These latter two, of course, are connected with our efforts to promote environmental quality along the Mexican border in tandem with our negotiations to increase jobs and wealth through more open trade and investment.
