Prime Minister Gonzalez, it has been an honor to meet with you again. And it is a special pleasure to celebrate this anniversary year of the greatest mission ever undertaken beneath the royal banner of Spain -- Christopher Columbus' voyage of discovery. For half a millennium now, the people of Europe have shared their legacy -- their civilization -- with this new world called America.

It is fitting that this anniversary should coincide with a European renaissance. A new dawn of freedom casts fresh hope from Seville to Siberia. Tyrannical regimes and ideologies have collapsed. The cruel division of Europe has ended. Respect for human rights is on the rise. Renewed economic freedom points the way to new prosperity. And the threat of global war has given way to the prospect of lasting peace.

Each of these developments owes its origin to the work and sacrifice of free nations. Our talks today reaffirmed that America and Europe are linked inseparably. The Prime Minister and I agreed that NATO remains the foundation of European peace and that a continuing American military presence in Europe is the anchor for guaranteeing peace and a strong transatlantic relationship.

The changes we've worked to achieve will bring about an

evolution in our Atlantic partnership. Cooperation between the United States and the European Community is increasingly vital. The Prime Minister and I agreed that nowhere is this partnership more important than in assuring energetic support for Russia and the other new nations now emerging from the dark days of Communism.

Spain is among Western allies who are vital partners on the first part of the initiative I announced yesterday to support freedom in the lands of the former Soviet Union. That first element calls for a \$24 billion package to help stabilize the economies of Russia and other new states. The second part calls for comprehensive new American legislation for financial, security and cultural cooperation with the new republics. Finally, I announced new credit guarantees to enable people in the new states to purchase much-needed food and agricultural products. / This package will provide support and assistance at a critical time. All of us share an interest in welcoming Russia and all the former Soviet republics into the community of free nations. //

Prime Minister Gonzalez and I also agreed that we must not squander the opportunity at hand right now for an historic new world trade agreement. With the Cold War now ended, a trade war among the western democracies would threaten to blot out the great vision of Monnet, Truman and Adenauer at the very moment of its realization. A battle of trade barriers and subsidies would undermine the freedom and prosperity that have been the legacy of

the West and the envy of the East for all these years.

That is why we must rise above short-term and parochial interests to reform the world trading system. Today more than ever, it is imperative that we achieve a breakthrough in the GATT talks. We must achieve success in the Uruguay Round.

The Prime Minister and I have renewed the common commitments of Spain and the United States to support world freedom, peace and economic development. Spain proudly participated in the coalition that liberated Kuwait just one year ago. Last autumn, Spain played an extraordinary international role in hosting the Middle East Peace Conference -- bringing ancient enemies for the first time to the negotiating table. And today, Spain and the United States want to re-emphasize our commitment to the spread of freedom, democracy and peace in the Western Hemisphere. Both of our peoples look forward to the day when the last dictatorship in the Americas will have given way to a free and open society.

Again, Mr. Prime Minister, with the five hundredth anniversary of Columbus's voyage, we celebrate the long and abiding ties between Spain and the Americas. Indeed, many Americans will celebrate in a special way by attending the Summer Olympics in Barcelona and the World's Fair in Seville.

Mr. Prime Minister, it is always a pleasure to welcome you here -- to carry on the friendship and the common work of the people of Spain and the United States. May God bless both of our great lands and peoples.

DRAFT STATEMENT BY THE PRESIDENT

I have just met with the Congressional leadership to request their bipartisan backing for a new, comprehensive, and integrated program to support the struggle for freedom in Russia, Ukraine, and the other new states that have replaced the Soviet Union. The revolution in these states is a defining moment in history with profound consequences for America's own national interests.

The stakes are as high as any American has faced in this century. Our adversary for 45 years -- the one nation that posed a world-wide threat to freedom and peace -- is now seeking to join the community of democratic nations. A victory for freedom in the former USSR creates the possibility of a new world of peace for our children and grandchildren. A defeat could plunge us into a world more dangerous in some respects than the dark years of the Cold War.

America must meet this challenge, joining with those who stood beside us in the battle against imperial communism -- Germany, the United Kingdom, Japan, France, and our other allies.

Together, we won the Cold War. Today we must win the peace.

This effort will require new resources from the industrial democracies, but nothing like the price we would pay if democracy and reform failed in Russia and Ukraine, Armenia, Byelarus or the other new states. It will require the efforts of a united

America, strengthened by a consensus that transcends even the heated partisanship of a Presidential election campaign. Today I call upon Congress, Republicans and Democrats alike, and the American people, to stand behind this united effort.

Russia has already exhibited that commitment, and I am announcing today that the U.S. is prepared to join in a substantial multilateral financial assistance package in support of Russia's reforms. We are committed to developing, with our allies and the IMF, a \$6 billion currency stabilization fund to help maintain confidence in the Russian ruble. The U.S. will also join in a multilateral effort to marshall \$18 billion in financial support in 1992 to assist Russian efforts to stabilize and restructure

their economy. I urge the G-7 Finance ministers to complete action on this \$24 billion package by the end of April. // ✓

Second, I am transmitting to Congress a comprehensive bill -- the Freedom Support Act -- to mobilize the Executive Branch, the Congress, and our private sector around a comprehensive and integrated package of support for the new states. This package will:

- Authorize a U.S. quota increase of \$12 billion for the IMF, which is critical to supporting Russia and the other new states. The IMF and World Bank will be the primary source of funding for the major financial assistance needs of the new governments. The U.S. quota increase for the IMF was specifically assumed in the budget agreement, and need not require a single penny of U.S. cash outlays.
- Strengthen my authority to work with the G-7 and the IMF to put together the stabilization program for Russia, and possible subsequent programs for other states as they embark on landmark reforms.
- Repeal restrictive Cold War legislation so that American business can compete on an even footing in these new markets. (
- Broaden use of the \$500 million appropriated by Congress last year to encompass not only the safe dismantling and destruction of nuclear weapons, but also the broader goals |

of nuclear plant safety, demilitarization and defense conversion.

- Establish a major people-to-people program between the U.S. and the states of the former Soviet Union to create the type of lasting, personal bonds among our peoples so critical to long-term peace.

In sending this authorization legislation to Congress, I call upon the Congress to act concurrently to provide the appropriations necessary to make these authorizations a reality.

Third, I am announcing today \$1.1 billion in new Commodity Credit Corporation credit guarantees for the purchase of American agricultural products: \$600 million for U.S. sales to Russia, and an additional \$500 million for U.S. sales to Ukraine and other states.

Let me close on a personal note.

As President, I think every day about the challenge of securing a peaceful future for the American people. I believe very strongly that President Yeltsin's courageous reform program holds the greatest hope for the future of the Russian people, and for the security of the American people as we define a new relationship with that great country.

For more than forty-five years the highest responsibility of nine American Presidents, Democrats and Republicans, was to wage and

win the Cold War. It is my privilege to lead the American people in winning the peace by embracing the people so recently freed from tyranny -- to **welcome them** into the community of democratic nations. I know there are those who say we should pull back -- concentrate our energies, our interest and our resources on pressing domestic problems. I ask them to think of the consequences **here at home of peace in the world.**
