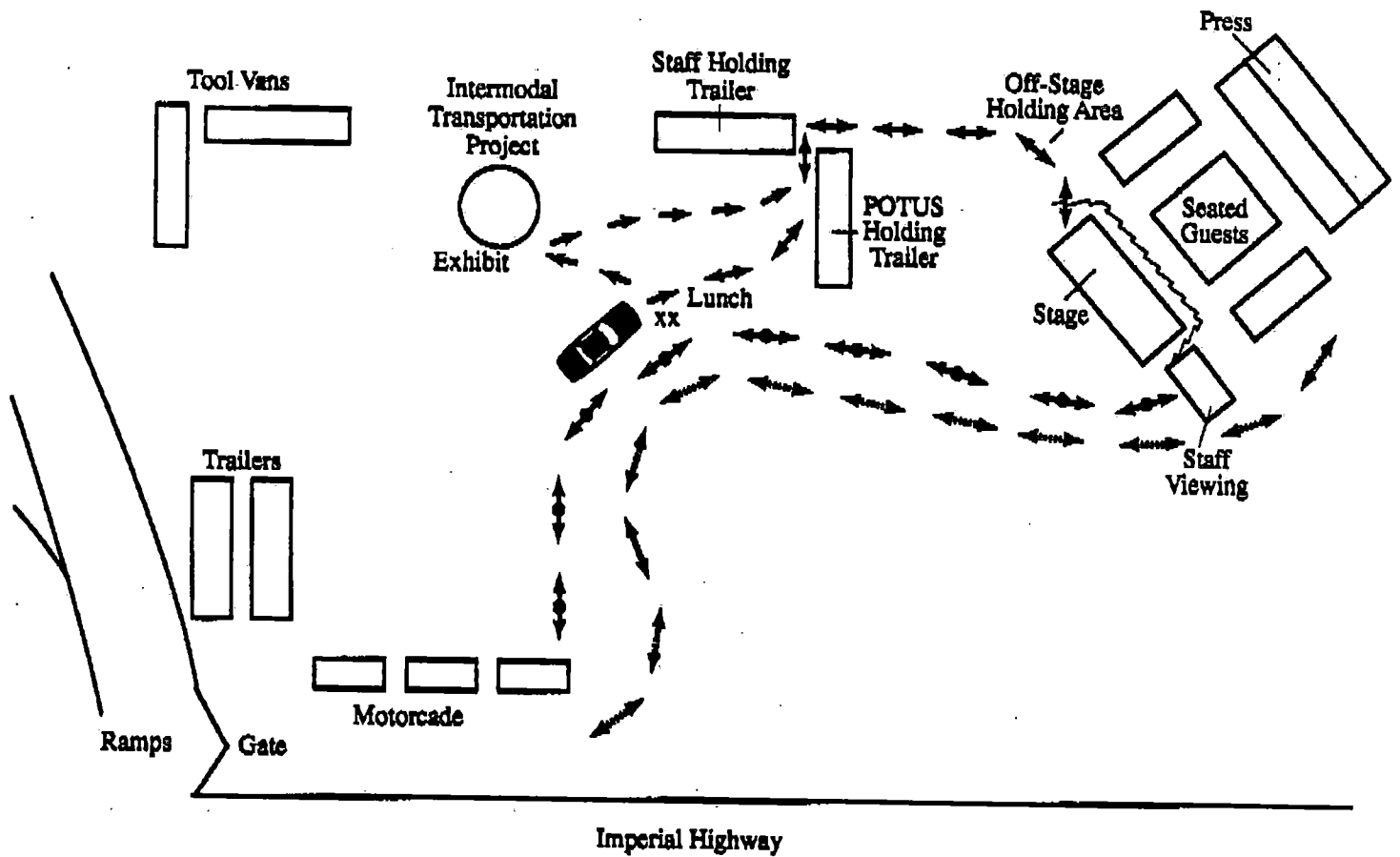

Leave the main entrance of the hotel, turn to your right, and proceed northbound towards the Hollywood Hills on Doheny Drive. Run past Beverly Boulevard and past Melrose Avenue across Santa Monica Boulevard to Elevado Street. Turn left, cross Doheny Drive, and run to the end of Elevado at Whittier Street. Follow the same route back to the hotel.

7 K RUN
(4.4 miles)

Leave the main entrance of the hotel, turn to your right, and proceed northbound towards the Hollywood Hills on Doheny Drive. Run past Beverly Boulevard and past Melrose Avenue across Santa Monica Boulevard through the intersection. This is the 1/2 mile mark. Turn left on Carmelita through the residential area of Beverly Hills. Carmelita ends at Wilshire which is the 2.2 mile mark.

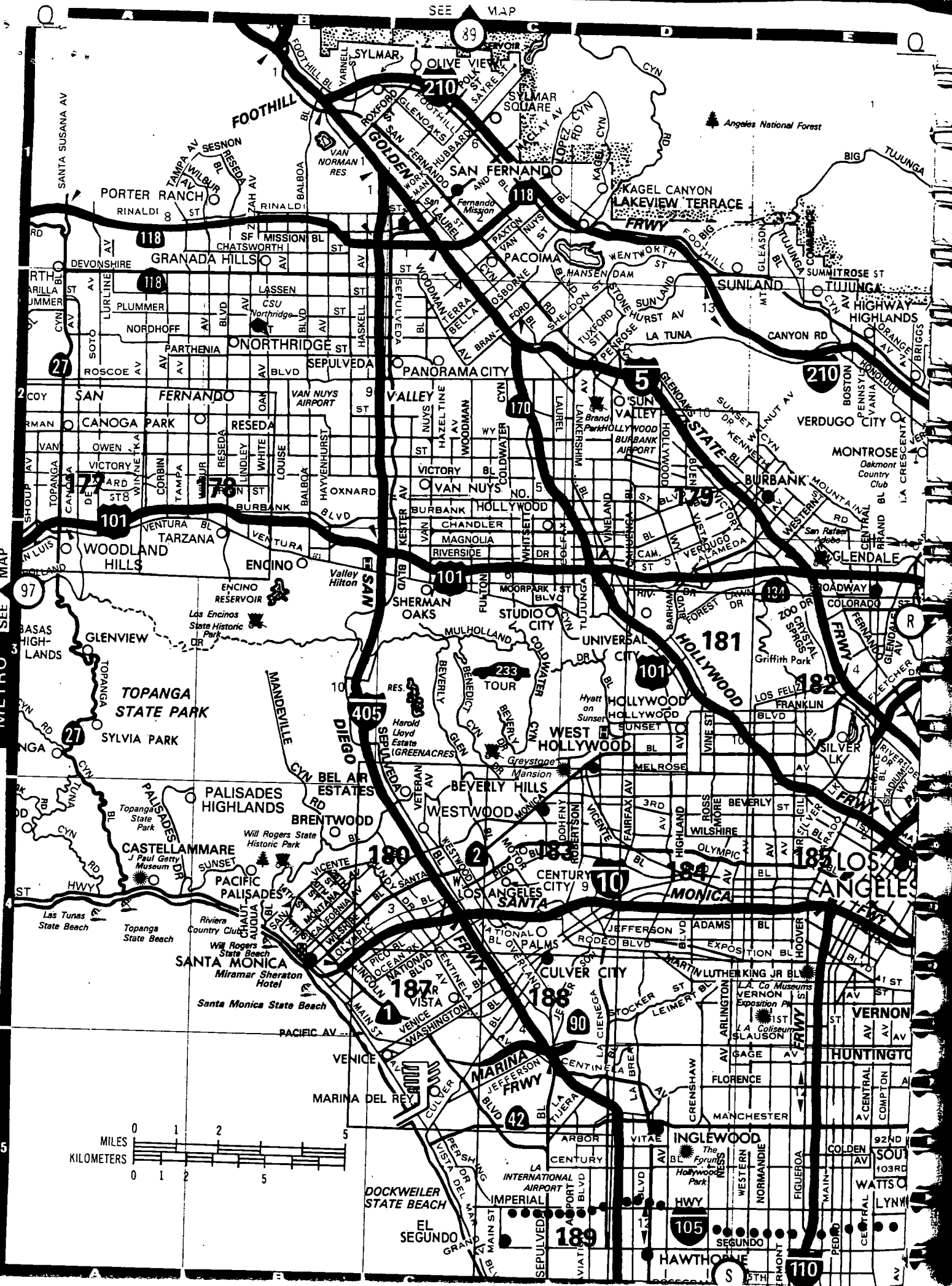
To extend your run proceed north on Rodeo Drive, a quiet tree lined street, to Sunset Boulevard and return. This extension adds 1 mile to your run.

Water is available at Foothill and Santa Monica, 1 block south of Carmelita.
