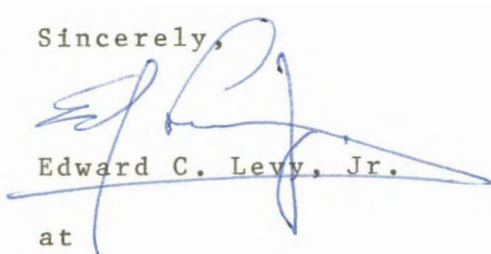
We covered a lot of ground in a short time. Surely, there is now an enhanced ability to communicate on the subject of Middle East arms sales. AIPAC is determined to do a better job of this and to help other interested parties to do likewise.

The U.S.-PLO dialogue provides America the opportunity to assist in resolving a major problem but, also, responsibility for ensuring that substantive deeds adequately support Arafat's words. At this early time, the Bush Administration can, by being very publicly explicit as to what it requires from the PLO, acquire great credibility in the area of international affairs. Such credibility would likely garner support and enthusiasm rather than criticism and opposition from interested Americans.

Your candor in expressing dismay at the attention given your Arab-American origins is well understood. Jewish Americans indulging in such tactics are, indeed, people in glass houses throwing stones. AIPAC is an issue-oriented organization. We abhor personal attacks and try to discourage others from such conduct.
