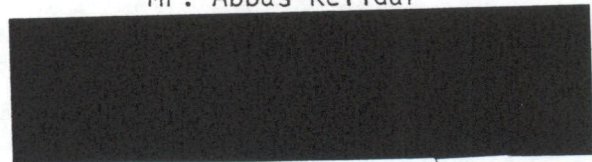

Dear Governor Sununu,

I am writing to express my gratitude for the kindness and friendly reception shown to me upon my recent visit to your office. It was terribly good of you to spare the time to see me. The gist of our conversation was reported to the Crown Prince Hassan in Amman. He, too, asked me to express his thanks and appreciation to you.

I feel certain that the Administration is according the Middle East the high priority it deserves. It is potentially a dangerous region and its problems, whether Palestine, Lebanon or the Gulf, are crying out for a resolution. Containment is no longer sufficient. These questions have to be addressed directly. For my part I would like to wish you personally, and the Bush Administration, every success. The peoples of the region will be eternally indebted to the United States if and when they can channel all their energies toward peace, cooperation and prosperity. You have their blessings for your endeavours.
