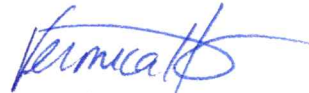
Dear President Bush:

I have sent for and received the application materials for the White House Fellow Program. I have had the good fortune to have been very successful financially in my endeavors in investment banking over the past five years and would like the chance to give something back to my adopted country.
