Since he is listed as going down over twenty years ago, I do not personally know him, but my dad has told me many stories about the good times that he and "Butch" had during their childhoods.

More than 2,331 soldiers are listed as missing in action in the Vietnam War. I think it is time that the families of these men know the truth about the disappearance of their loved ones.
