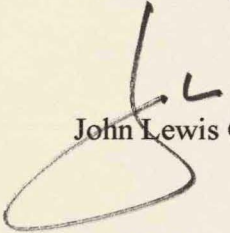
Dear Mr. President:

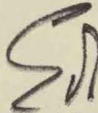

Dear Mr. President,

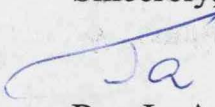
