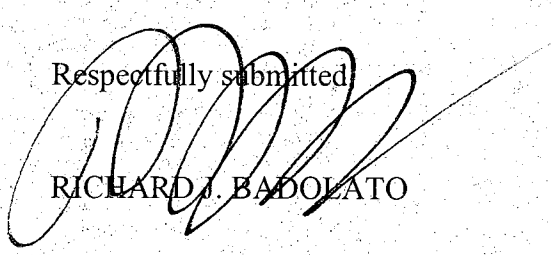
These qualities are shared by the members of the Bar of the State of New Jersey and by myself personally.

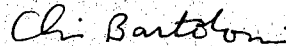

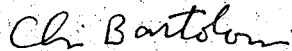
