Director, Surrogate Operations (7/00 - 12/00)

Democratic National Committee

Responsible for setting up and managing national surrogate operation for the Democratic National Convention and the Presidential election campaign. Solicited the participation of Governors, Senators and Representatives on behalf of the Democratic Party. Managed scheduling and communications staff.

Deputy Chief of Staff (8/98 - 7/00)

U.S. Department of Energy

Provided analyses and coordination of domestic policy issues and options for the Secretary. Represented the Secretary in dealings with White House staff. Reviewed drafts of proposed Departmental legislation, regulations, opinions, and substantive Secretarial pronouncements. Advised the Secretary concerning the extent and type of Departmental participation in activities with Members of Congress. Managed scheduling operation of the Secretary of Energy. Responsible for personnel matters.

Senior Policy Advisor for Management and Administration (1/98 - 8/98)

U.S. Department of Energy

Reviewed and made recommendations to resolve substantive program or policy issues arising with the Department to ensure compliance with Departmental policies. Advised the Chief Operating Officer on policy and programmatic issues. Served as liaison between program areas and the Secretary or Deputy Secretary to provide coordination to meet the policy goals of the Department. Represented the Secretary or Deputy Secretary in the initiation of meetings, conferences and contacts with other agencies and Department officials as necessary. Represented the Secretary in specific tasks, such as the Year 2000 computer problems, contract reform and privatization.

Senior Advisor to the Secretary (1/97 - 1/98)

U.S. Department of Commerce

Acted as the Secretary's liaison with the White House on a variety of sensitive issues including major announcements related to the Department and international trips. Liaison between the Secretary and Congress on various issues affecting the Department. Organized and managed various domestic and international trips for the Secretary of Commerce. Assisted with candidate selection for senior positions at the Department.

Senior Advisor to the Chief of Staff (6/96 - 1/97)

U.S. Department of Commerce

Carried out highly confidential and specialized liaison assignments with top level Department officials and representatives of other Federal agencies on matters of special concern to the Chief of Staff and the Secretary, which involved major office programs and policy issues. Researched and analyzed sensitive items of interest to the Secretary and Chief of staff, including internal developments, position statements from the White House and major office activities that were reported to the public and private sectors.

Special Assistant to the President (3/95 - 6/96)

Office of Cabinet Affairs, The White House

Responsible for the coordination of information between the President and his Cabinet, with a particular focus with the Departments of Justice, Health & Human Services, Housing & Urban Development, Veterans Affairs. Co-chaired the Interagency Veterans Policy Group, which monitored veterans' issues throughout the Executive Branch. Coordinated the follow-up to the Oklahoma City bombing, including writing briefing materials for the President on his trips to Oklahoma. Managed the creation of the President's Oklahoma City Scholarship Fund, to ensure that the children who lost parents in the explosion had the opportunity to go to college. Coordinated Cabinet delegations on Presidential trips, including the memorial service in Oklahoma City, the Papal Arrival Ceremony in New Jersey, and the State Visit to Japan.

Director, Legislative Correspondence (1/93 - 3/95)

Office of Legislative Affairs, The White House

Responsible for all correspondence between the President and the Congress. Developed tracking system to respond to correspondence to the President from Members of Congress. Responsible for the timely dissemination of White House materials to the entire Congress during floor debate on important Administration legislation. Worked with representatives from other White House offices, as well as other Executive Branch departments, to ensure that communication to Members of Congress was the Administration's position. Initiated special correspondence between the President and Members of Congress, including special messages, birthday greetings, condolence letters. Assisted on special projects, including the confirmation of Supreme Court Justice Stephen Breyer and Congressional passage of the North American Free Trade Agreement.

Congressional Liaison (11/92 - 1/93)

Office of Presidential Transition

Acted as the President-elect's representative to ensure good communication between the transition team and Members of Congress. Responsible for initiating the contact with United States Senate offices to schedule courtesy visits for Cabinet nominees. In this capacity, maintained the schedules of 20 Cabinet nominees and set up hundreds of meetings.

National Surrogate Scheduler (7/92 - 11/92)

Clinton/Gore Campaign & Democratic National Committee

Coordinated the schedules of speakers, including Governors, Senators and Representatives, traveling around the country on behalf of the campaign. Communicated with Senate and Congressional chiefs of staff the targeting information dictating travel.

Researched various Congressional issues for clients. Primary focus was in the areas of banking, trade and environmental issues. Responsible for tracking Congressional action on these issues and drafting background memos for clients' use on different subject matters.

Assisted with the fundraising effort in California during the Presidential general election, on behalf of statewide candidates as well as the Presidential ticket. Responsible for setting up numerous events and managed a staff of 20 volunteers that assisted with the fundraising events.

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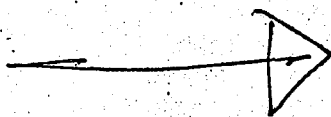

Niger Innis
National Spokesman, C.O.R.E.
TV Telejournalist and Commentator

Niger Innis currently serves as the National Spokesman for the Congress of Racial Equality (CORE), an organization committed to community development and empowerment. He works closely with the National Chairman and represents CORE across the country. Innis is also a freelance telejournalist and commentator, providing insight and analysis on the day's news events. He can often be seen and heard on CNN, Fox News, MSNBC News, and NY One. He served as an MSNBC commentator for political and foreign affairs from 1996 to 1998.

In addition to his role with CORE, Innis serves as an Advisory Committee member of The National Center for Public Policy Research Project 21 and is a Founding Member of Third Millennium, an organization dedicated to promoting young leaders that will focus on the problems facing the next generation.

In August, 1997, Innis served as a delegate for the 19th American-German Young Leaders Conference, sponsored by the American Council on Germany and Atlantik Brücke. He was selected along with 23 other young Americans to travel to Hamburg, Germany to meet their German counterparts to discuss America's relationship with the European Union.

In 1993, Innis served as campaign manager for the Roy Innis for Mayor campaign in New York City's Democratic Party primary. Although the candidate was outspent \$3.5 million to \$100,000 by the then incumbent Mayor David Dinkins, the Innis campaign was able to garner more than 25% of the vote in the primary.

Prior to his role as National Spokesman, Niger served in a variety of roles at CORE. In 1991, he was Special Assistant to the National Chairman and Director of Fundraising while acting as CORE's liaison to the Washington, D.C. chapter. In 1990, Innis was the Coordinator of Political Affairs while also serving as the Director of CORE's Washington chapter. Innis' involvement with CORE began in 1990 when he was appointed Deputy Director of the Washington chapter.

Innis' experience has lead to several appearances as a civil rights activist or political commentator on CNN, Fox News, CNBC's "Equal Time," Bill Maher's "Politically Incorrect," "America's Black Forum, and Black Entertainment TV. His radio appearances include "The Jimi Bohannon Show" and "The Gil Gross Show." Innis has guest-hosted on "The Bob Grant Show" and "The Barry Farber Show."

From 1986 to 1990, Innis attended Georgetown University where he pursued a B.S. in Political Science and American History. While attending the University, he became the Chief Executive Officer of the Association for the Preservation and Development of the Negro Spiritual. Innis, born and raised in Harlem, New York, currently lives in Westchester, New York.

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
