President today announced his intention to nominate four individuals to serve in his administration.

The President intends to nominate Cari Dominguez to be a Commissioner of the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission for a five year term expiring July 1, 2006, and upon confirmation, will be designated Chairman. She is currently a Principal at Dominguez and Associates, a Maryland based consulting firm that assists clients with workforce issues. She worked in the executive search field with Spencer Stuart in San Francisco, from 1993 to 1995 and with Heidrick & Struggles in Washington, D.C., from 1995 to 1998. Dominguez served at the U.S. Department of Labor from 1989 to 1993 as Assistant Secretary for the Employment Standards Administration and at the Department of Labor from 1974 to 1983 in the Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs. She has received numerous awards including being named one of the 100 Most Influential Hispanics in the Country by Hispanic Business Magazine. She received both an undergraduate and Master's degree from American University.

The President intends to nominate Dennis L. Schornack to be a Commissioner of the International Joint Commission, United States and Canada and upon confirmation will be designated Chairman.
