Ali,

Here is your listing. Just a couple notes: Jehangir Karamat is NOW the Pakistan Ambassador to the U.S.; thus, he is addressed as Mr. Ambassador. At the time of the photo, he was advisor to the President. Mohammad Sadiq at that time was charge d'affaires at the embassy; he's still there as the Deputy Chief of Mission. {On the other hand, the correct way to address these officials AT THE TIME OF THE PHOTO, would be "Mr. Karamat" and for charge, "Mr. Charge' d'Affaires."

For Major General Ullah, on the photo it's ok to put "Major General Ullah," but if you're writing a letter to him, the salutation should be "Dear General Ullah:"

Hope this helps. Sorry for being late with this, but I got a little confused regarding the Ambassador. Any questions, I'm here.
