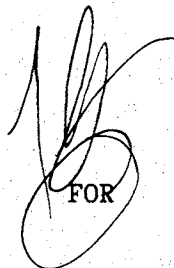

Dear Mr. President:

I am requesting that you urge General Pervez Musharraf of Pakistan to take immediate actions that would prevent any further terrorist activity by the Pakistan-based militant groups Jaish-e-Mohammad and Lashkar-e-Taiba.

Reports over the last several days have stated that India's intense investigation of the terrorists responsible for last Thursday's attack on the India Parliament have produced evidence that points to Jaish-e-Mohammad and Lashkar-e-Taiba. In addition, evidence corroborates that the directives behind this attack came from Pakistan's Inter-Services Intelligence (ISI). Although neither of these groups nor the ISI have come forward to accept responsibility, it is imperative that General Musharraf paralyze any further support, whether financial, material or logistical, to either of these groups. The administration must request that Pakistan at the very least arrest the leaders of these groups and freeze their financial assets.

India is a country that has suffered countless terrorist attacks over the years. Many of these attacks can be attributed to Pakistani-based terrorist groups in the Kashmir region. Since the tragic events in the U.S. on September 11th and the renewed alliance between the U.S. and Pakistan, I have been skeptical of Pakistan's ability to join the fight to end global terrorism while also continuing terrorism in Kashmir.

The attack on the Indian Parliament in New Delhi, however, is not simply an attack on India. The attack represents an attack on democracy worldwide. In light of the recent terrorist act in New Delhi, I want to reiterate the absolute necessity for Pakistan to cut all ties to Jaish-e-Mohammed and Lashkar-e-Taiba and to eventually cut ties to all guerilla groups engaging in terrorism. It is clear that Pakistan cannot continue relations on any level with these terrorist groups and at the same time truly invest themselves in a united fight against terrorism with the U.S.

I respectfully urge you to push General Musharraf to arrest the leaders of Jaish-e-Mohammed and Lashkar-e-Taiba and to freeze their financial assets. In addition, I urge you again to warn General Musharraf that he must root out terrorism in his own country in order to stand with the U.S. in the fight against global terrorism.
