1. **Military Planners Favor Striking Iraq In February**
(*Washington Times*)....Rowan Scarborough
U.S. military planners are focusing on February as the optimum time to begin a war against Iraq, and they would rely greatly on defecting Iraqi units to topple Saddam Hussein, according to senior defense officials.
2. **Bush Delivers Iraq Resolution**
(*Washington Post*)....Karen DeYoung and Jim VandeHei
President Bush asked Congress yesterday for unlimited authority to take whatever action he sees fit against Iraq, including the use of military force, without any further congressional consultation or approval. In a White House-drafted resolution, Bush cited for the first time "the high risk that the current Iraqi regime" would use weapons of mass destruction to "launch a surprise attack against the United States or its armed forces," in addition to the possibility it would turn such weapons over to international terrorists.
3. **Bush To Outline Doctrine Of Striking Foes First**

On Friday, the Bush administration will publish its first comprehensive rationale for shifting American military strategy toward pre-emptive action against hostile states and terrorist groups developing weapons of mass

destruction. The strategy document will also state, for the first time, that the United States will never allow its military supremacy to be challenged the way it was during the cold war.

4. **Persistence On Iraq Pays Off For Bush**

As President Bush sent his proposed Iraq attack resolution to Capitol Hill yesterday, his rout of congressional Democrats was virtually complete. The opposition party had all but resigned itself to passing the resolution with the wording Bush desired on the timetable he demanded.
5. **U.S. Eyes Pilot With Ties To Al Qaeda**

U.S. intelligence agencies are looking for a missing Sudanese air force pilot who is said to be planning to hijack an airliner and fly it into the White House. The pilot was trained in Afghanistan and is linked to the al Qaeda terrorist organization. The Washington Times has learned from U.S. intelligence officials.
6. **Suicide Bomber Kills 5 On A Bus In Tel Aviv**

A Palestinian suicide bomber blew himself up in a Tel Aviv bus outside the city's main synagogue today, killing five people and wounding scores. Several hours later, Israeli

tanks and armored vehicles encircled Yasir Arafat's compound in Ramallah and demanded over loudspeakers that he surrender wanted men who were inside with him. After an emergency meeting of the Israeli cabinet, the government said it had also made other "operational decisions."

Rumsfeld took the administration's case to Capitol Hill, where senior leaders of both parties expressed general support for Mr. Bush's request but signaled that there would be changes in wording.
8. **Powell Casts Attack On Iraq As 'Liberation'**

Secretary of State Colin L. Powell carried the Bush administration's case against Iraqi President Saddam Hussein to Capitol Hill yesterday and went beyond talk of weapons inspectors and United Nations resolutions to argue that any U.S.-led invasion of Iraq should be seen as an act of "liberation."

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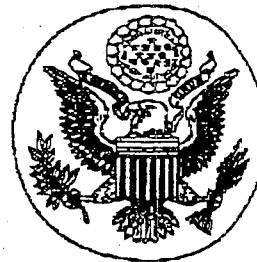
