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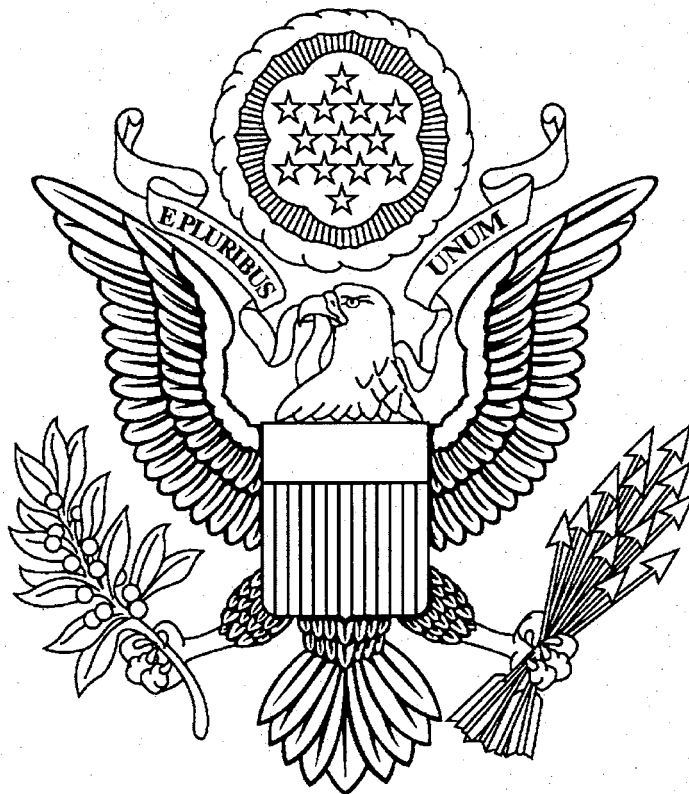

Mark Kravitz heads Wiggin & Dana's Appellate Practice Group. His practice is focused on appellate, as well as constitutional litigation.

Mark Kravitz graduated *magna cum laude*, and with High Honors in Government, from Wesleyan University in 1972, where he was elected to Phi Beta Kappa and received the Davenport Prize. He received his J.D. from Georgetown University Law Center in 1975, where he served as Managing Editor of *The Georgetown Law Journal*. Between 1975 and 1976, Mr. Kravitz served as a law clerk to the Honorable James Hunter, III, Circuit Judge, of the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit. He served as a law clerk to the Honorable William H. Rehnquist, then Associate Justice, United States Supreme Court, between 1978 and 1979. He has been a partner in Wiggin & Dana since 1980.



Mr. Kravitz has been an Adjunct Professor of Law at the University of Connecticut School of Law since 1995, where he has taught both Federal Courts and the Law of Privacy. During the Spring semester 2000, he was a Visiting Lecturer in Law at Yale Law School, where he taught Legal Writing.

Mr. Kravitz has been listed in *Best Lawyers in America* since 1990. Mr. Kravitz was elected a member of The American Law Institute in 1992 and a Fellow of the American Academy of Appellate Lawyers in 1996. He is also a James W. Cooper Fellow of the Connecticut Bar Foundation. In 1995, he received the Deane C. Avery Award for advancing the cause of freedom of speech in Connecticut.

Mr. Kravitz serves, by appointment of the Chief Justice of the United States, on the Judicial Conference Standing Committee on the Rules of Practice and Procedure in the United States Courts. He also serves on Connecticut's Advisory Committee on Appellate Rules by appointment of the Chief Justice of the Connecticut Supreme Court and on the Rules Committee of the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit by appointment of the Chief Judge of the Second Circuit. From 1995 to 1999, Mr. Kravitz served as a member of the Civil Justice Advisory Committee by appointment of the Chief Judge of the District Court for the District of Connecticut.
