I. PURPOSE

To address survivors and their families, runners, and walkers at the start of the 13th Annual Race for the Cure, and thank participants for their support in the fight against breast cancer.

II. BACKGROUND

Since it began, the Susan G. Komen Foundation and its affiliates have raised more than \$240 million for breast cancer research, education, screening, and treatment. The Foundation is credited as the Nation's leading catalyst in the fight against breast cancer. The National Race for the Cure is the largest 5K in the country, with close to 50,000 participants this year.

Last year, you hosted breast cancer survivors, research leaders, and race participants at the White House to kick off the 12th annual race. The Vice President and Mrs. Cheney also hosted an event at their residence. Earlier this year, Mrs. Bush hosted an event with Cherie Blair in Dallas, Texas, to help raise money for the cause. Mrs. Blair is an advocate for Breast Cancer Care, a similar British organization to the Komen Foundation. She has supported the cause since losing an aunt and a best friend to the disease. Also, Mrs. Bush recently stayed with Ambassador Nancy Brinker in Hungary and attended a women's wellness event with the Ambassador at the National Institute of Oncology in Budapest. Susan Komen, who died of breast cancer in 1980, was Ambassador Brinker's sister. Ambassador Brinker started the Foundation to honor her sister by fighting breast cancer.

We have made great progress over the years, and we will not rest until we win the fight against cancer.

- Your work over the last two decades has led to incredible advances in the battle against breast cancer. Today, the death rate from breast cancer is more than 15 percent lower than it was just 10 years ago.
- The federal government is your strong partner in this important effort. I have asked Congress for more than 5 billion dollars in 2003 for research into cancer cures and therapies at the National Institutes of Health. And I have asked Congress for an additional 9 million dollars for breast and cervical cancer screening in next year's budget – so that more low-income families have access to these critical services. We will press

ahead with strong support for cancer research until our victory against cancer is complete.
