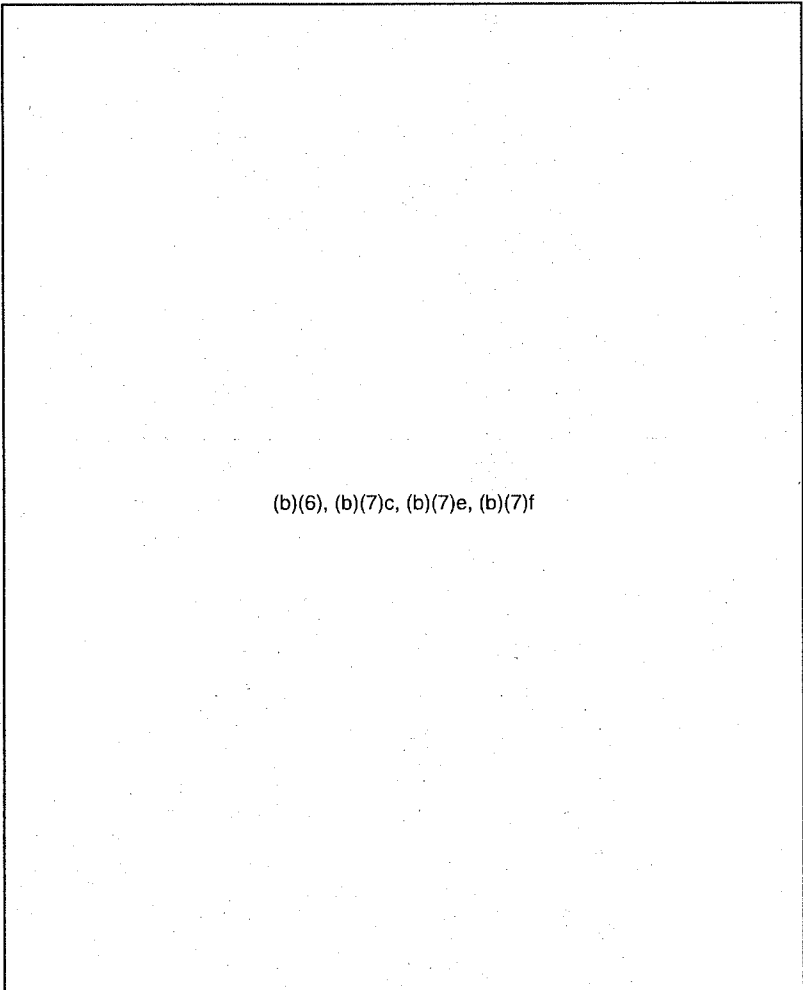

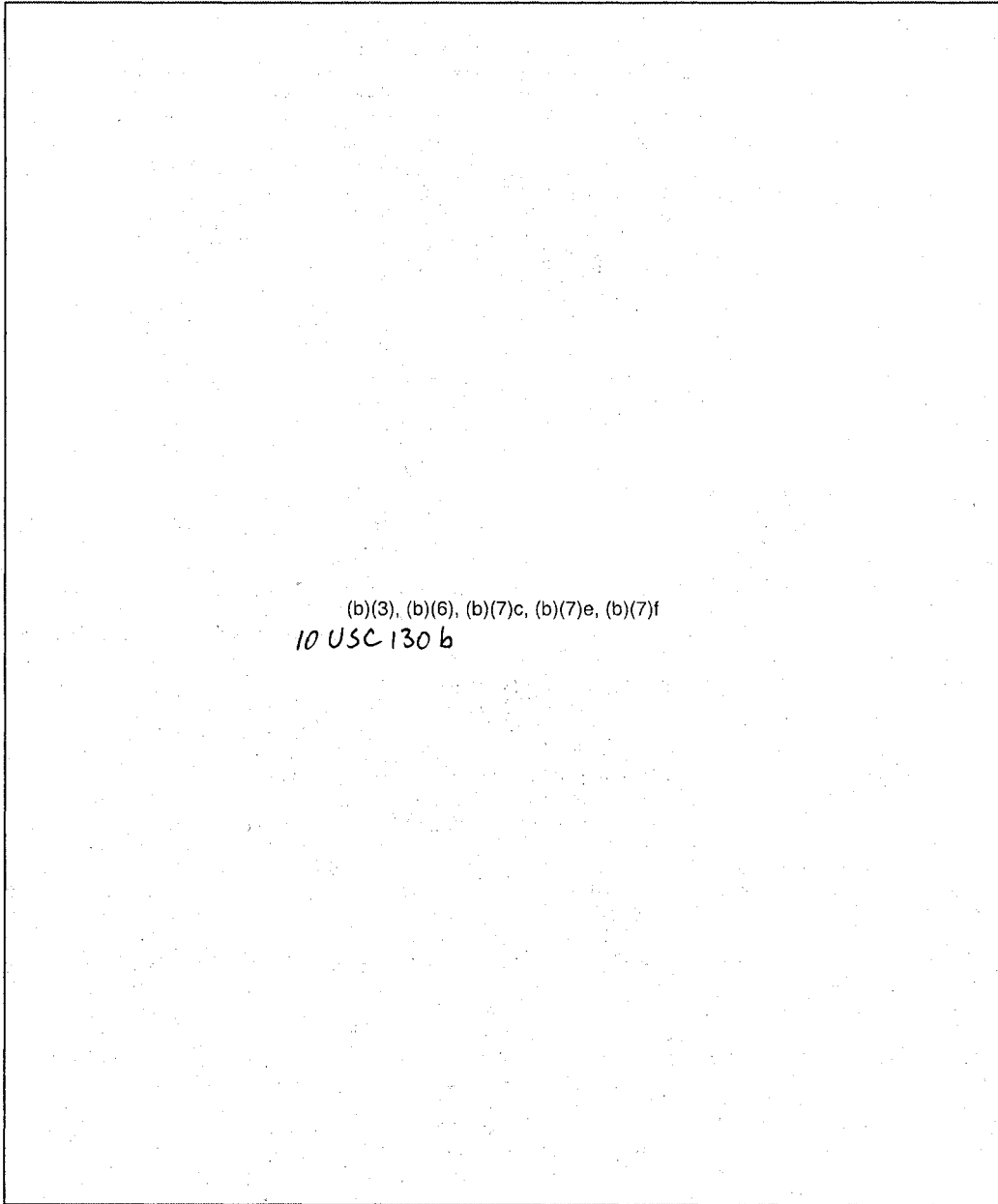

I. PURPOSE

To address the gathering of Scouts at their Jamboree.

II. BACKGROUND

The National Jamboree is a gathering of Scouts and leaders from across the Nation, highlighting Scouting skills, our Nation's heritage, physical fitness, conservation, and the spirit of brotherhood. Scouts participate in archery, orienteering, obstacle courses, trap shooting, boating, hunting safety, and take part in a disabilities-awareness trail, competitive events, the Merit Badge Midway, and an arts and science fair. Religious services are also available during the Jamboree.

You were unable to attend the National Scout Jamboree on July 30, 2001, due to inclement weather, and you delivered your remarks via videotape.

Attending this year are an estimated 32,000 youth from 883 troops in 30 countries, between ages 12 and 18. All are at least First Class Scouts. The Jamboree also includes female members of Scouting organizations. More than 7,000 adult volunteers support this event.

Today, before you give remarks, you will view two Scouting demonstrations: one teaching emergency preparedness and a second on reading featuring *Boys Life* magazine.

Good Turn for America Award

Just as you issued a call to all Americans to serve, the Boy Scouts of America issued a national call to service, "Good Turn for America." Since their call to service, Boy Scouts have volunteered an estimated 34,538,280 hours in communities feeding the hungry, building homes for the homeless, and volunteering in other ways. You will be presented with this award at the beginning of the photo line.

Support Our Scouts Act of 2005

The "Support Our Scouts Act of 2005" introduced by Senator Frist and passed by the Senate on Tuesday, July 26, guarantees the Boy Scouts' right to equal access on Federal property. The legislation, a response to groups seeking to exclude the group based on their belief that the Boy Scouts is a religious organization, ensures Federal government entities do not deny Boy Scouts equal access to public facilities, programs, or forums.

July 25 Electrical Accident at Fort A.P. Hill

Four adult Scout leaders from Alaska Troop 267 were killed Monday afternoon at the Boy Scout Jamboree in an electrical accident that occurred when a pole from a tent they were setting up struck an overhead power line. Three others – a Scout leader and two contract workers – were also injured in the accident. No Boy Scouts were injured. The deceased men are Michael Shibe, Mike Lacroix, and Ronald Bitzer from Anchorage, Alaska, and Scott Edward Powell, formerly of Anchorage, Alaska, and then of Perrysville, Ohio. [REDACTED] (b)(6) is the injured Scout leader and was treated at Virginia Commonwealth University Medical Center in Richmond. You [REDACTED] (b)(6) in the photo line. They are the first three individuals.
