I. PURPOSE

To update you on the status of the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act (TRIA) and to discuss alternatives with respect to an extension of the program.

II. BACKGROUND

The Terrorism Risk Insurance Act (TRIA) is a three-year Federal backstop that provides compensation for insured property and casualty losses resulting from acts of foreign terrorism. Under TRIA, the Federal government reimburses insurers for payments to policy holders for losses above their deductibles. TRIA expires on December 31, 2005. A Treasury Department report on TRIA is due to Congress by June 30.

In 2002, you advocated for the creation of a temporary Federal program such as TRIA.
