BACKGROUND ON DR. BOBBY WELCH

He is also co-founder of the FAITH/Sunday School Evangelism Strategy, which is widely used by churches across the Southern Baptist Convention. Dr. Welch is from Alabama and became a Christian after being wounded in Vietnam, where he served as a reconnaissance platoon leader. On August 29, 2004, Dr. Welch launched a nationwide bus tour from First Baptist Church in Daytona Beach, Florida. On this bus tour, he visited churches in all 50 states to encourage Southern Baptists to evangelize more passionately.
