Lateral Repatriation Update

September 29, 2003

Summary Sheet

- Report for September 8 through September 27, Day Twenty of the operation.
- Since the beginning of the lateral repatriation program on September 8th, CBP-Border Patrol has removed 5,354 aliens to the four Texas sectors (El Paso, Laredo, Del Rio, McAllen).
- A total of 5,077 (95%) of those removals are aliens from the interior of Mexico.
- The Tucson Sector's daily apprehension average comparison prior to and after the lateral repatriation program demonstrates a 17% decrease in total apprehensions. The West Desert apprehensions have dropped 32%.
- Out of the 5,354 lateral repatriations to the 4 Texas sectors, there have been 65 (1 percent) known attempts at re-entry in those locations.
- Prior to initiating the lateral repatriation program, the Tucson Sector was averaging one death per day.
- Since the start of lateral repatriation there has been one heat related death in the West Desert Corridor and two in the Douglas/Naco corridor. During the month of September, 2002 there were a total of 10 heat related deaths recorded in the Tucson Sector.
- This operation, as well as Operation "Desert Safeguard," is scheduled to conclude on September 30, 2003. All detailed assets will be returned to the sending sectors at the conclusion of this operation.

Summary Sheet

- Report for September 8 through September 28, Day Twenty-one of the operation.
- Since the beginning of the lateral repatriation program on September 8th, CBP-Border Patrol has removed 5,648 aliens to the four Texas sectors (El Paso, Laredo, Del Rio, McAllen).
- A total of 5,353 (95%) of those removals are aliens from the interior of Mexico.
- The Tucson Sector's daily apprehension average comparison prior to and after the lateral repatriation program demonstrates an 18% decrease in total apprehensions. The West Desert apprehensions have dropped 33%.
- Out of the 5,648 lateral repatriations to the 4 Texas sectors, there have been 67 (1 percent) known attempts at re-entry in those locations.
- Prior to initiating the lateral repatriation program, the Tucson Sector was averaging one death per day.
- Since the start of lateral repatriation there has been one heat related death in the West Desert Corridor and two in the Douglas/Naco corridor. During the month of September, 2002 there were a total of 10 heat related deaths recorded in the Tucson Sector.
- This operation, as well as Operation "Desert Safeguard," is scheduled to conclude on September 30, 2003. All detailed assets will be returned to the sending sectors at the conclusion of this operation.
