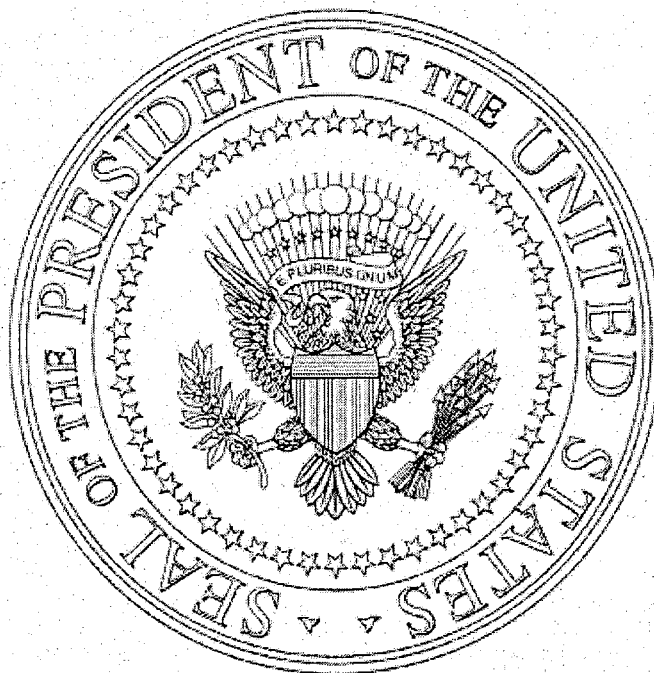

Volusia County RSVP in Daytona Beach has a total enrollment of 1,500 RSVP volunteers.

Approximately 200 volunteers participate in a Citizens on Patrol (COPS) program in partnership with local police agencies. The volunteer activities designed to help police with traffic and services that deter criminal activity. Volunteers wear uniforms and have their own patrol cars that they use throughout the county to patrol neighborhoods looking for suspicious activity as well as help remove disabled vehicles, watch vacant homes, search for missing children and older persons. These volunteers have fingerprinted more than 18,359 children in an effort to keep them safe in the community. During 2001, they served more than 51,000 hours, logging more than 360,000 miles in their patrol cars.

Volusia County also a small emergency disaster preparedness team. Twenty-three volunteers, called CERV (Community Emergency Response Volunteers) have been trained and are ready to assist with any kind of local disaster. Periodically, in the interim, they volunteer in other related safety projects, i.e., making up emergency disaster kits for shelters, etc. RSVP also has a well established relationship with the disaster preparedness agency and is continuing to recruit additional volunteers for this project and will mobilize other volunteers as the situation calls for.
