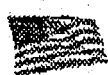

Two NH judges in running for U.S. Court of Appeals

CONCORD — With New Hampshire's second highest-ranking federal judge ready to move to semi-retirement, two lower court judges well known in state legal circles are the leading candidates to take his place.

Norman Stahl of Manchester will assume semi-retired "senior" status on the Boston-based U.S. Court of Appeals for the 1st Circuit on April 16. Stahl succeeded David H. Souter on the appeals court in 1990 after Souter was tapped for the U.S. Supreme Court.

Officially, Stahl's successor can come from anywhere in the circuit — that is, the six New England states and Puerto Rico. But the seat is viewed as a "New Hampshire seat," and The Union Leader has learned that two Granite Staters comprise the Bush White House short list to succeed him.

They are:

- U.S. District Court Judge Joseph DiClerico. DiClerico was appointed to the federal bench by the President's father, George Bush, in August 1992. Sen. Judd Gregg R-N.H., named DiClerico as chief justice of the state Superior Court system in 1991, after he had served as a state trial court judge for 14 years. DiClerico had earlier served in the state Attorney General's office under former U.S. Sen. Warren Rudman and Souter.
- U.S. District Court Judge Paul Barbadoro. He was appointed to the federal bench in November 1992. Barbadoro did not serve on the state bench, but had worked with then-Sen. Rudman in the congressional investigation of the Iran-Contra scandal more than a decade ago. Barbadoro also served in the state Attorney General's Office.

Both men are proteges of former Sen. Rudman and his long-time friend, former state Attorney General Thomas Rath.

Rath was a consultant for President George W. Bush's Presidential campaign. DiClerico and Barbadoro also have ties, through Rath, to Sen. Judd Gregg, R-N.H., who is, in turn, politically and personally close to President George W. Bush.

The New York Times reported on Sunday the Bush White House is moving "with extraordinary swiftness to put its stamp on the federal courts."

The Times said that more than 50 candidates have already been interviewed for judgeships, with an emphasis on filling vacancies on the federal appeals court. The newspaper said that of the 862 federal judgeships, there are currently about 100 vacancies for Bush to fill, with 29 of them on the appeals courts — the intermediate level between the federal district trial courts and the U.S. Supreme Court.

3 Sources say that no candidates for the Stahl seat have yet been interviewed by the Bush White House. But the White House has contacted local activists making inquiries about the Stahl seat.

Also, sources say, many state judges apparently realize that DiClerico and Barbadoro are the leading candidates for the appeals court seat and are already sending in resumes for the district court post one of them may vacate. Many of those resumes have come from sitting justices of the state Superior Court.
