WILFRED M. McCLAY

Wilfred M. McClay is the SunTrust Bank Chair of Excellence in Humanities at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga, where he has been professor of history since 1999. Senior scholar at the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars, he was educated at St. John's College at Annapolis and received his Ph.D. at Johns Hopkins University. He serves as a member of the National Council on the Humanities and on the advisory board for the National Endowment for the Humanities. He is author of *The Masterless: Self and Society in Modern America* and *Figures in the Carpet: Finding the Human Person in the American Past*, as well as several other books.

RICHARD GUY WILSON

Richard Guy Wilson holds the Commonwealth Professor's Chair in Architectural History at the University of Virginia. A specialist in 18-20th century architecture, design and art, he has served as curator for museum exhibits; lecturer at universities, museums and professional groups; and commentator for television programs on PBS and A&E. He has authored or co-authored 16 books on American and modern architecture, received a number of academic honors, and was named outstanding professor at the University of Virginia in 2001. He earned his undergraduate degree at the University of Colorado and masters and doctorate at the University of Michigan.
