If other bands used a fiddler, the Seldom Scene used a Dobro; if others relied on old standards, the Seldom Scene played rock classics like J.J. Cale's *After Midnight*. Through skilled musicianship and an urban approach to bluegrass, the Seldom Scene has become one of the most influential bluegrass bands of the last 30 years. Their latest album, *SCENEchronized*, was nominated for the 2008 Grammy Award for Best Bluegrass Album.
