ROGER WILLIAMS

Named the greatest selling pianist in history by Billboard magazine, Roger Williams has an astounding 18 gold and platinum albums to his credit. In 2008 he released his 117th album, *Roger Williams Plays Your All Time Favorites*.

Mr. Williams first played the piano when he was three years old. A graduate of Idaho State University, Drake University and the Julliard School of Music, he burst onto the popular music scene in 1955 when he recorded "Autumn Leaves." His version became an American classic and still stands as the greatest selling piano recording of all time. Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger named Mr. Williams "Champion for Youth 2004" in honor of his dedication to securing music education in schools.

Mr. Williams lives in Encino, California, and has two daughters and five grandchildren. A son Jim died in 2004. With charm, energy, and masterful musicianship, Roger Williams continues to thrill audiences worldwide. When asked what he sees for his career in the coming years, Mr. Williams states, "The Best is Yet to Come"!
