Former "French doctor " Frederic Tissot will open at the start of next week an "embassy bureau" in Erbil, in the Kurdish provinces of Iraq. Following the United States, Great Britain, and Germany, Paris will in turn have an official "outpost" in the regions which have been spared violence since the fall of the Saddam Husayn regime in 2003. "It is not a matter of a simple consulate," they make clear at the Quai d'Orsay [Foreign Ministry], "but a political presence."

The opening of this embassy bureau was announced in November 2006 during the visit to Paris by the president of the Republic of Iraq, the Kurd Jalal Talabani. Fearing an attack in France during the election period, Jacques Chirac then opposed sending the diplomat chosen for this sensitive post.

Nest of Spies

Coming a few months after Bernard Kouchner's visit to Baghdad, this establishment there is a new sign of "the end of the indifference" of France toward post-Saddam Iraq. It can only delight the Kurds. Tissot is a defender of their cause. He speaks the language and knows the mountains of Kurdistan for having organized the evacuation to France in 1989 of Kurds fleeing Saddam Husayn's Iraq. "I have always felt myself to be a citizen of the world sensitive to the misfortunes of others," he confides.

In this nest of spies France's representative will be walking on egg shells. Even if calm does reign there, it is regularly broken by the attacks carried out by Al-Qa'ida. Moreover, even if the enemy brothers, Jalal Talabani and Masud Barzani, have buried the war-hatchet, the ancestral divisions among the Kurdish factions are not completely extinguished, as proved by the abortive attack which Masud Barzani was the target of at the end of last year. Tissot arrives at a time when Kurdish aspirations for independence -- which Paris does not support -- are being fought against by their Shi'ite allies within the central government in Baghdad. At the end of December the Kurds had to accept the deferment until June of the referendum on Kirkuk, the oil city, Arabized under Saddam, which the Kurds claim. Victim of the French veto on the war

in Iraq, relations between Paris and the Kurds improved afterwards. Sign of a return of confidence, Frederic Tissot's safety in Erbil will largely be ensured by peshmerga, Kurdish fighters.

Sarkozy's Son Running for Office

PARIS (AP) — America has the Bushes and the Clintons, so why not a Sarkozy dynasty in France?

President Nicolas Sarkozy's 21-year-old son Jean, whose voice, vernacular and glad-handing verve eerily resembles his father, took a big step in that direction Wednesday by launching a bid for local office.

Jean Sarkozy is running for a seat in the chic Paris suburb of Neuilly-sur-Seine, the same town where his father launched his political career more than three decades ago — at age 22 — and later served as mayor for 19 years.

He will run for election in a "canton" — the smallest administrative segment in France — in south Neuilly as part of local contests across France on March 9 and March 16. A win would give him a seat on the council for the Hauts-de-Seine department, which groups the southwestern Paris suburbs.

The younger Sarkozy told a French daily that he has "things to prove" and acknowledged speaking about his political ambitions with his father — but said he did not get specific advice.

"He told me to be myself and assume my responsibilities," the younger Sarkozy was quoted as saying in an interview on the Internet site of Le Figaro newspaper. "I'm very aware of the stakes."

The president's poll numbers have plunged in recent weeks, with many critics faulting him for blurring his personal and public lives — out of step with French presidential tradition — such as in two high-profile getaways since December with former first lady Carla Bruni. They were married on Feb. 2.

Jean, and his older brother Pierre, reportedly a rap producer, are Sarkozy's sons from his first marriage to Marie-Dominique Culioli. After their divorce, Sarkozy married Cecilia Ciganer-Albeniz, with whom he had his third son, Louis. Their 11-year marriage ended in divorce in October.

Jean Sarkozy, a law student and part-time actor, has burst onto France's political scene in recent weeks, displaying the same phrase, intonation and press-the-flesh instincts that are strikingly reminiscent of his father's.

The popular TV satire show *Les Guignols de L'Info*, which spoofs politicians with the use of marionettes, depicts Jean Sarkozy as the same puppet as used for his father — except taller, and with a mane of blonde hair.

The son's bid follows recent political turmoil in his father's political base. The president's own spokesman, David Marti, bowed out of the Neuilly mayor's race amid signs his campaign was floundering. Jean Sarkozy often accompanied his father at public appearances, before unexpectedly dropping support for him on Feb. 12.

While it's tough to handicap the son's chances, Neuilly — France's richest city per capita — is known for its conservatism, and Jean Sarkozy has the blessing of his father's governing conservative UMP party. Three rival candidates also made the deadline for bids on Wednesday.

President Sarkozy has long said he enjoys taking risks — and his son's candidacy, whether encouraged by the president or not, amounts to a gamble that the family name, connections and familiarity with Neuilly will sell.

"It's not an appointment, it's a candidacy," Jean Sarkozy told Le Figaro. "A risk to take, and a risk I accept."

Sarkozy Jr in bid to capture his father's old seat

As if the family of Nicolas Sarkozy was in need of any more public exposure, 21-year-old Jean, the president's son, launched his own campaign for office last week in the constituency where the French leader began his rise to power three decades ago.

"The rise of the dauphin", as some were calling this latest episode of the "Sarko show", came just as France was getting over the excitement of Sarkozy's marriage to Carla Bruni, the Italian supermodel and singer, who replaced Cecilia, the president's errant second wife, as first lady on February 2.

"He's a brave boy," was how Sarkozy described his son last week while on a visit to France's industrial north. "I'm rather proud of the way he's coping."

One of two sons from Sarkozy's first marriage to Marie-Dominique Culioli, the daughter of a Corsican chemist, Jean is running for election in a "canton" – the smallest administrative segment in France – in south Neuilly, the affluent Parisian suburb which his father used as a springboard to power after serving as mayor there for two decades.

Jean admitted last week that he has "things to prove" in the election next month and acknowledged getting advice from his father. "He told me to be myself and assume my responsibilities," he said.

The long blond locks and angelic smile may belie a ruthless streak: there was a smell of scorched earth in Jean's wake as Arnaud Teullier, a loyal Sarkozy supporter and local election candidate, obediently stepped aside to allow the president's son to get his foot on the first rung of the political ladder.

"I'm a good soldier," said Teullier "and totally devoted to him to whom I owe everything in politics." This was a reference to the older Sarkozy.

Jean would be unlucky to lose: the region is one of the wealthiest in France and strongly supportive of Sarkozy's UMP party. As Christophe Grunert, a Socialist militant in the constituency, put it: "If the UMP candidate were a hamster, it would be elected."

Jean can be expected to go far in Neuilly: he is said to possess a telegenic charm to go with his good looks. Some observers claimed his mannerisms were similar to those of the hyper-active president, a Hungarian immigrant's son whose efforts to modernise France through economic reforms have met with complaints about his flashy style and love of "le bling bling".

A popular satirical television programme that lampoons politicians with rubber dolls represented Jean with the same puppet that it uses for "Sarko", albeit with a mane of blond hair. He has been ridiculed elsewhere as a "tête à claques" – "the face you want to slap".

Jean first hit the news in October 2005 when he accidentally drove into the back of a BMW on his scooter. He sped off but, unluckily for him, the driver had noted his number plate. The trial is pending. He has been a regular jogging partner of his father and, like Pierre, his elder brother, a rap producer, has accompanied him on various missions, some of them overseas. As part of the presidential entourage he has met numerous celebrities and foreign politicians such as Tony Blair and may accompany the president and Bruni on a state visit to Britain next month, when they will be guests of the Queen at Windsor Castle.

The president, whose approval rating has fallen disastrously in recent weeks – it was at its lowest ebb of 39% last week – may be hoping for a "bounce" from his son's political debut. The habit of mixing family and

politics has begun to backfire on him, however.

When he tried to parachute David Martinon, his chief press officer and a friend of Cécilia, his former wife, into Neuilly as a mayoral candidate in next month's elections, it provoked a revolt by party followers. They complained that Martinon was not up to it.

Among those who rose up against Martinon was Jean, who had originally backed him with the words: "I support David Martinon to the death." The apparent betrayal resulted in a cartoon showing Jean on the shoulders of his father stabbing Martinon in the back. "Is that how you do it, Papa?" said the bubble.

Bruni did not take kindly to a report recently on a French magazine's website that Sarkozy had sent a text message to Cécilia eight days before his marriage offering to "cancel everything" if she came back to him.

Apparently there was no reply from Cécilia, who divides her time between Neuilly, London and New York and is the mother of Louis, Sarkozy's third son. She has confessed to being in love with Richard Attias, a Moroccan-born events organiser, whom she is expected to marry next month in America.

Sarkozy is suing the magazine for "forgery" and "receiving stolen goods" and the journalist who wrote the article was last week being questioned by police. It emerged yesterday that Cécilia will also be summoned for questioning about the text.

Sarkozy wants six-nation elite EU defence force

(EUX.TV) -- French President Nicolas Sarkozy is pushing to create an elite European defence force consisting of forces from the six largest EU member states: France, Germany, the UK, Spain, Italy and Poland.

According to an outline of the plans presented in French daily Le Figaro, each of the six countries would contribute 10,000 troops for a special intervention force, they would all spend a minimum of 2 percent of GDP on defence, and they would jointly make major defence acquisitions.

The group of six would constitute a European "hard core" defence group, said French MP Pierre Lellouche in a recent [interview](#) with Le Figaro. Lellouche is Sarkozy's spokesman on defence.

Plans for increased defence cooperation among EU member states are seen as controversial in NATO circles. In the past they have drawn fire especially from the United States. EU member states already have a mechanism for joint procurement in the area of defence.

France is due to take over the rotating presidency of the EU in July.

Point d'étape sur le Livre Blanc sur la défense et la sécurité nationale

Le Président de la République a reçu, jeudi 3 janvier, en présence du Premier Ministre et des ministres principalement intéressés, le Président de la Commission du Livre blanc sur la défense et la sécurité nationale, M. Jean-Claude Mallet, accompagné des présidents des groupes de travail de la Commission, qui lui ont présenté un point d'étape de la réflexion et des travaux engagés depuis le mois d'août dernier.

Le Président de la République a relevé la diversité et la densité des consultations engagées par la Commission, conformément au souci de transparence et de pluralisme qu'il avait exprimé le 23 août, lors de la première séance de la Commission.
Après le Livre blanc de 1994, tirant les enseignements de la fin de la guerre froide, le Livre blanc de 2008 sera celui de la mondialisation.

Le Président de la République a validé la démarche proposée par la Commission de définition d'une doctrine globale de sécurité nationale, qui permettra à la fois d'assurer la sécurité des Français et d'assumer nos responsabilités internationales. Il a retenu à cette fin une organisation de la sécurité nationale en cinq grandes fonctions stratégiques : connaissance et anticipation, incluant le renseignement ; dissuasion ; protection ; prévention ; intervention.

Le Président de la République a approuvé la proposition de la Commission de rechercher

à renforcer les politiques de l'Union européenne dans les domaines de la sécurité, de la défense, de l'industrie et de la recherche et en même temps à rénover le lien transatlantique.

Il a considéré ces deux objectifs comme complémentaires d'une même politique de sécurité et de défense.

En ce qui concerne les forces armées, le Président de la République a renouvelé un triple engagement : que les armées disposent de moyens modernisés et adaptés à leurs missions, qu'un effort spécifique soit entrepris pour que les équipements soient entretenus au meilleur niveau et que les militaires et leurs familles voient reconnue la nature spécifique de leur engagement. A cet égard, **il a rappelé l'objectif de maintien d'un effort de défense de la nation de l'ordre de 2% du PIB.** Il a précisé que, compte tenu du cadrage d'ensemble des finances de l'Etat, ces objectifs seront atteints au terme d'un processus de réforme et de rationalisation exemplaire.

Le Président de la République a constaté, avec la Commission, la nécessité de moderniser et renforcer l'organisation de l'Etat, la coordination des moyens civils et militaires et les capacités des forces armées et des moyens de sécurité pour faire face aux risques et aux crises de grande ampleur qui pourraient affecter la vie du pays.

Comme proposé par la Commission, il a décidé la création d'un Conseil de défense et de sécurité nationale, appuyé par un Conseil consultatif dont les membres seront nommés par le chef de l'Etat. Les travaux de la Commission doivent être approfondis dans la perspective d'une remise du Livre blanc au Président de la République, au début du printemps 2008 et de la préparation, d'ici l'été, de ses futures traductions législatives, notamment en matière militaire et de sécurité.

Conformément aux engagements pris par le Président de la République sur le renforcement du rôle du Parlement, le chef de l'Etat a retenu deux propositions novatrices de méthode présentées par la Commission :

- le projet de Livre blanc fera l'objet d'une présentation devant les commissions compétentes des deux assemblées, avant que le chef de l'Etat n'arrête définitivement ses choix.
- une fois le texte arrêté, les orientations principales seront exposées aux assemblées par le Premier Ministre.

Le Président de la République a demandé que d'autres points de situation soient organisés d'ici le début du printemps.

France Endorses Stronger EU Defense Policy

PARIS — French President Nicolas Sarkozy has endorsed a proposal to strengthen European Union policy in defense and security matters, while seeking to renew trans-Atlantic ties, presidential spokesman David Martinon said Jan. 3.

"He considered these two objectives as complementary within the same security and defense policy," Martinon

said in a statement.

The dual-headed proposal was made in a progress report of the commission drafting France's white paper on defense and security, due to be submitted in March. *Process*

Sarkozy is due to take up the rotating presidency of the European Union in July for six months. France also is considering a full integration into NATO's military command structure.

Sarkozy backed the commission's effort to define a "global doctrine on national security, which would both assure security of French people and meet our international responsibilities," the statement said. *Domestic*

To meet these objectives, the commission recommends that national security should be organized along five strategic functions: knowledge and anticipation, which include intelligence; deterrence; protection; prevention; and intervention.

On the French armed forces, Sarkozy maintained a triple commitment: that the services be equipped with modern resources suited to the mission; a big effort be made to maintain equipment at the best possible level; and that personnel and their families should be recognized for the specific nature of their commitment.

In light of this, Sarkozy repeated a target of maintaining defense spending at around 2 percent of gross domestic product. Given the overall constraints of state finances, the objectives would be reached through reforms and rationalization, the statement said.

Sarkozy agreed with the commission on the need to modernize and strengthen the organization of the state and a coordination of civil and military resources to meet threats and crises.

As recommended by the commission, Sarkozy will create a council for defense and national security, supported by a consultative council whose members will be appointed by the head of state.

In line with the commission's proposal, the draft white paper will be presented to the parliamentary committees of the lower and upper house before the president makes a final decision. Once the text is officially completed, the prime minister will present the main lines to both parliamentary houses.

Sarkozy has asked for further progress reports to be made between now and the beginning of spring, the statement said.

The commission chairman, Jean-Claude Mallet, gave Sarkozy the progress report at a meeting that included Prime Minister Francois Fillon, other ministers and the heads of the commission's working parties. It was the first such report since the commission was formed Aug. 23.

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My approach is purely pragmatic. Having learned from history, I want the Europeans, in the years to come, to have the means to shoulder a growing share of their defense. Who could blame the United States for ensuring its own security? No one. Who could blame me for wanting Europe to ensure more of its own security? No one. All of our Allies, beginning with the United States, with whom we most often share the same interests and the same adversaries, have a strategic interest in a Europe that can assert itself as a strong, credible security partner.

At the same time, I want to affirm my attachment to NATO. I say it here before this Congress: The more successful we are in the establishment of a European Defense, the more France will be resolved to resume its full role in NATO.

I would like France, a founding member of our Alliance and already one of its largest contributors, to assume its full role in the effort to renew NATO's instruments and means of action and, in this context, to allow its relations with the Alliance to evolve.

This is no time for theological quarrels but for pragmatic responses to make our security tools more effective and operational in the face of crises. The EU and NATO must march hand in hand.
