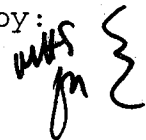

M. JEAN DE PONTON D'AMECOURT

Under Secretary for Policy and Strategic Affairs, Ministry of Defence Paris

Jean de Ponton d'Amécourt was born in 1945. After military service as a Lieutenant in the French Navy, he graduated from the prestigious Institute for Political Studies in Paris. He took Masters' degrees in Economics and Public Law before winning admission to the highly-selective *Ecole Nationale d'Administration*, which trains the elite of France's public service.

His career has included substantial experience in both the public and private sectors. Leaving ENA in 1974, he joined the French Foreign Ministry, dealing with European economic affairs, before being posted to the Ministry's Policy Planning Staff. He then served as a First Secretary in the French Mission to the United Nations in New York, before taking up a Counsellor position at the French Embassy in Washington. He then spent four years in the private sector, in a senior management position in the glass-making industry, before returning to the Foreign Ministry in 1986 to be Deputy Assistant Secretary for Disarmament. From 1986-87 he worked in the Ministry of Defence as Diplomatic Adviser to the Minister, and from 1988 he was the Executive Secretary General of the Paris Conference on the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons.

He then moved back to the private sector, taking a series of high-level management positions with International Distillers and Vintners, including that of Managing Director for Europe. He subsequently became Chairman and Chief Executive of Grand Metropolitan Foods, Europe, responsible for 8000 staff in seven countries. From 1997-99 he was a Director of Roland Berger Strategy Consultants, and from 2000-2002 he was Managing Partner of the French subsidiary of the Harvard-based strategic consultancy, the Monitor Group.

In 2003, he returned to the public service, taking responsibility for raising funds for the "Year of France in China". He took up his present position at the Ministry of Defence in July 2005.

Jean de Ponton d'Amécourt is a Chevalier of the National Order of Merit in France, and holds a cross of Merit (1st class) of the German Federal Republic. He speaks fluent English, and good Spanish and Italian. A keen sportsman, he enjoys tennis, skiing and hunting, and in his quieter moments likes reading, visiting museums and gardening. He is married with three children.
