Marta Dassù became Special Foreign Policy Adviser to Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Massimo D'Alema in May 2006, a few days after D'Alema was named Foreign Minister in Prime Minister Romano Prodi's second center-left Cabinet. Dassù had already served as foreign policy adviser to D'Alema when D'Alema was Prime Minister from 1998 to 2000, and had kept the position with D'Alema's successor Giuliano Amato until 2001.

A specialist in international relations and Italian foreign policy, since 2001 Dassù is also Director of Policy Programs for Aspen Institute Italy and editor of the Aspen Institute's journal *Aspenia*. From 1988 to 1998, she served as Director of the Center for International Policy Studies (CeSPI), a formally independent think tank linked to the former, historic Italian Communist Party's (PCI) and now to the PCI's successor, the Democrats of the Left (DS).

Dassù is a member of the executive board of Italy's authoritative Foreign Affairs Institute (IAI) and of several European and transatlantic networks. She has participated in a number of conferences and workshops organized by leading research institutions, such as France's Institute for International Relations (IFRI), the UK's Royal Institute for International Affairs (RIIA) and its International Institute for Strategic Studies (IISS), and Washington's Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS). In addition, she has worked on research projects and initiatives for the Italian government and foreign institutions, including the Italian Foreign Ministry, the World Bank, NATO and the European Commission.

Dassù is the author of several books and essays on international security issues published in specialized Italian and European journals, including *Conflicts in the XXIst Century*, in 2002 for Aspen Institute, and a contribution to *One Year On: Lessons from Iraq*, a working paper published in Paris in 2004 on the consequences of war in Iraq. She has also taught a course on new conflicts and the role of the media at the University of Rome. She has a university degree in contemporary history.

WASHINGTON, March 24 (Reuters) - The United States plans to impose financial sanctions and travel restrictions against Belarus officials to show its opposition to the government's crackdown on protesters, White House spokesman Scott McClellan said on Friday.

"We strongly condemn the actions by Belarussian security services," McClellan said.

He praised a statement by the European Council against those in Belarus who violated of international standards including Belarus President Alexander Lukashenko. "We plan to take parallel steps involving targeted travel restrictions and financial sanctions," he said.
