Dear Don:

Here's a fax I sent Karl right after I talked to you, letting him know how truly effective you are communicating White House positions. Thank you for your courtesy and the thorough way you answered my questions and listened to my concerns.

As stated in the newspaper earlier this week, I understand that the issues I voiced are being pressed continually on the President and leadership. **That is government's possible interference with believers' freedom to openly share their faith.** Government cannot overexert excessive control—thereby limiting freedom and positive effect. Another deeply held concern: Taxpayers' resources would be distributed to fringe groups that actually undermine the spiritual health of faith-based organizations.

I know all of the individuals who are impacting the thought process, and quite frankly, as Karl Rove should know, I can help communicate the President's heart and sincere beliefs. In order to do so, I have to stay informed on White House positions.

You really can get online for free.

Rev. Horace Carrington, Jr., of the Sweet Home Missionary Baptist Church, is no stranger to technology.

But he always had concerns that some may be left out of the computer revolution.

"I was finding they're was a problem with children, minority children, especially, being able to get what they wanted and meet the needs of

everybody else in reference to technology." Carrington said.

Then he found out about Austin Free-Net, and his dream of filling this church basement with kids using computers online came true.

"These are the people who really helped out getting this program going. They were able to get me technical support, give me different types of programs, software mostly, but they've really helped out." Carrington said of Austin Free-Net.

Helping others with equal computer access is one of the goals of Austin Free-Net.

"We have free Internet access in public places, doesn't cost to get in, doesn't cost to sit down at the computer, you can get your own e-mail account free with the various e-mail services that are there, so it is access for everyone." said Leslie St. Aubin, a volunteer coordinator.

Their community partnerships have resulted in over 30 public access sites from city libraries to senior centers. And if you're not familiar with computers, there's free training.

"We have classes in probably half of our sites and we're working to get those classes increased everyday. There's no excuses and there's nobody left out, we're here to make sure that happens as best we can." St. Aubin said.

As these free public sites continue to spread throughout Austin those excuses are bound to become a thing of the past.

If you're interested in teaching others about computers Austin Free-Net is hosting a train-the-trainer session this Thursday. For more information on volunteering or where their free access sites are located, log onto their Web site at www.austinfreenet.net or call 326-9084.

EASTER ESSAY 2001
BY MICHAEL ALISON

"Early followers of Jesus were convinced that, as the long-awaited Messiah, he had a political agenda - nothing less than the overthrow of Roman occupation and dominance in Palestine and the restoration of national sovereignty for Israel. First century Jews viewed their life and circumstances as one of "captivity", echoing their earlier Egyptian bondage at the time of Moses.... The appearance of the miracle-working Jesus, therefore, suggested the arrival of a new Moses.... It was a heady wine for the new circle of young and enthusiastic followers of Jesus, convinced that they had been chosen to spearhead the impending liberation!

The trouble was that Jesus had a different agenda from theirs. And the final discovery of the difference was shattering for the disciples. The showdown occurred in the garden at Gethsemane, when Jesus seemed suddenly to capitulate, and to offer no resistance to his arrest....."

Then came the story of the resurrected Jesus and the miraculous catch of fish in John 21:

"So the universal miracle of the resurrection had suddenly become personalised for the fishermen, in a little local miracle which could hardly have impinged more directly upon them. The disciples found themselves in the presence of - who, or what? They dared not ask! But he was kind, friendly, without recrimination, helpful beyond imagining, and apparently omnipotent! There seemed suddenly to be a ladder from the lakeside - to heaven!

It was this scene, of course, rather than any triumphant overthrow of Roman rule in Palestine, that turns the religion of Christ into a universal religion.

The catching and cooking, the sharing and eating of the 153 fish chimes in with a kind of universal bottom line for human life at all times and in all places - we work in order to eat, we eat in order to work. And as Christ's voice had called out from the lakeside to the struggling disciples in their boat, so across the canyons of time he calls out to us in our own day and circumstances. Having a problem with the bottom line of a dwindling bank balance? Having a problem with a poor membership drive, in a marginal constituency, or in disappointing donations for a struggling charity? Having a problem with your cholesterol count, your pulse-rate, your profit margin, your mortgage liability, your exam marks, your time-span before parole? "Children, haven't you any fish?" comes the call of Christ. "Nowt!" was the only available answer - the only answer that was needed. Then the turnaround in the struggle became mind-boggling...."

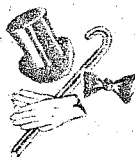

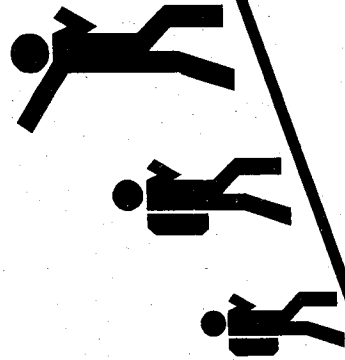

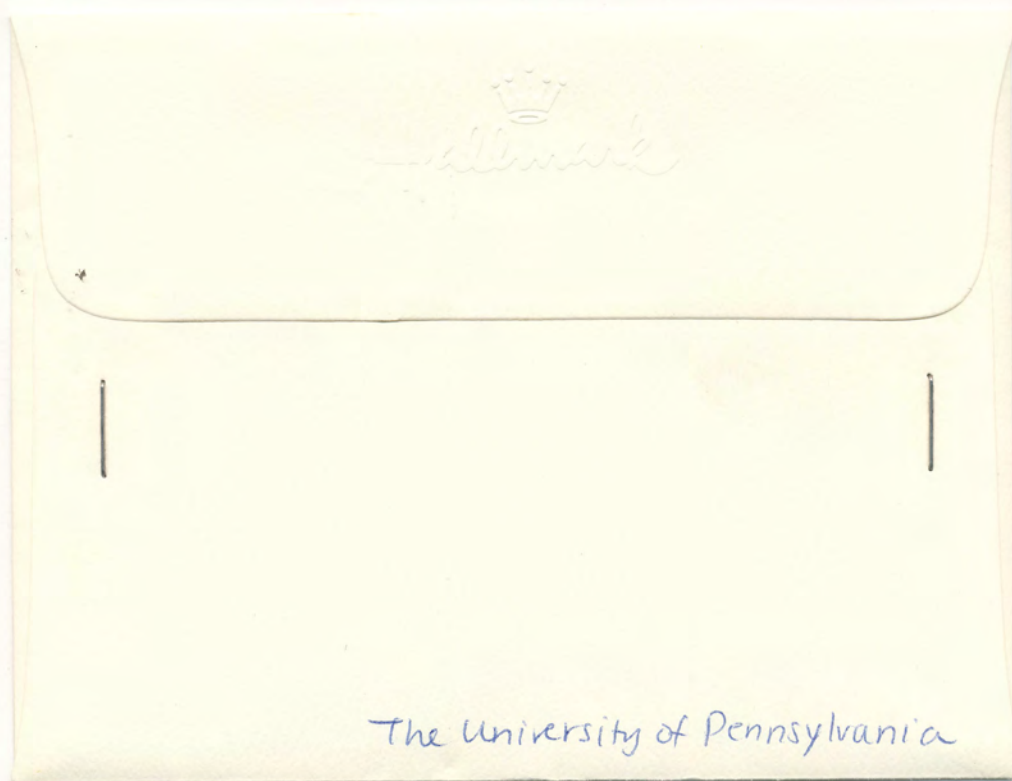

Hi. My name is Bob Sjogren and I'd like to encourage you to fast for holiness in the life of George W. Bush while in the Whitehouse.

Let me give you some background...

I am your basic conservative Christian (Presbyterian by background). I came to know the Lord through Campus Crusade and have been in full time Christian work ever since, serving with Frontiers for 18 years and now on loan to APMC (Advancing Churches In Missions Commitment).

Last year, my wife and I (along with our four kids) went to West Africa to encourage missionaries. The trip took six weeks. Knowing we needed prayer coverage, we ended up getting at least one person to fast for every day we were over there.

While there, we hit what many would call some pretty scary times for our physical safety. Yet through it all, we had perfect peace. Why? Because we knew someone at that very moment was fasting.

Recently, our family watched as our nation chose a president. Now that George W. Bush is in, I can only hope and pray that the scandals that happened to President Clinton will not happen to him. George W. Bush is a believer and carries our Father's reputation in the actions he takes. (I can only wish we had been doing this for President Clinton.)

It is because our heavenly Father is jealous for his glory (Exodus 20:5) that I write to you.

Recently I have felt the Lord speak to me (remember, I'm a conservative Presbyterian, I rarely use those words) that our President needs someone fasting for him every day in the office for his holiness. This will not only cover him through our prayers and fasting, but also give him encouragement (and accountability) knowing that there is someone (and hopefully multitudes) fasting for him each day.

Being swamped with my own work, I thought, "Great idea, who can handle this?" I called a friend who put me in touch with the National Day of Prayer. They basically said, "Great idea, but we're swamped." I then went to Crusade. Same response. I then went to the National Prayer Committee...

In the process I felt the Lord say, "Bob, I asked you to handle this." Since I feel totally swamped and since it is no where in my "calling", I felt God saying "that's what makes you perfectly qualified" (figure that one out!)

So this is not being "sponsored" by anyone. It will be a grass roots movement of believers who are passionate for God.

So, since I walk by faith and feel the Lord's calling me to this, here's my best guess at how to manage it.

If you are willing to fast one day a month primarily for George W. Bush's holiness (and other areas, such as bipartisan work among the Democrats and Republicans, Wisdom in his work, wisdom for his cabinet, healing for our nation, etc. ...but primarily holiness) then e-mail me at "Fast4GeorgeW@juno.com"

Tell me which day you want to fast on such as the 1st, the 14th, ...you get the idea. (I thought about fasting one day a year, but then it is so easy to forget, so we're going with monthly fasting....)

Your name will be put on a list for that day. Then a few days before that date comes up, you will be sent a reminder via e-mail to fast on that day. If for whatever reason you cannot make it, e-mail me and let me know. I will make sure someone is fasting for that day.

Please excuse Christmas and Easter as days to fast on...and don't choose your birth date!

If the President's office puts out prayer requests, we will forward those on to you.

Please take this seriously. This is a four-year commitment (and hopefully an 8 year commitment). If you need or want to be permanently excused, simply e-mail me and let me know that as well.

I hope that President Bush will be able to hear, "There is one person fasting for you each day," then hear, "There are ten people fasting for you each day" then hear "There are 100 people fasting for you each day" then hear "There are 1,000 people fasting for you each day....." You get the idea. That will greatly encourage him and keep him accountable when the Evil One seeks to sidetrack him from his commitment to the Lord.

I personally will be fasting the 20th of each month, starting on his Inauguration Day.

PLEASE FORWARD THIS E-MAIL ON TO AS MANY AS YOU FEEL ARE JEALOUS FOR OUR FATHER'S GLORY and for this nation.

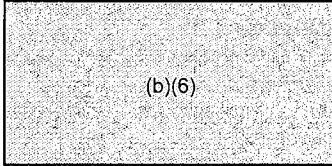
