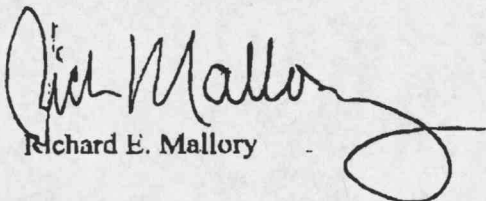

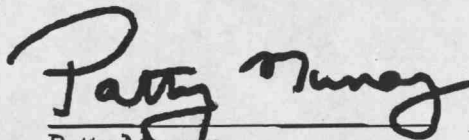
We were pleased to receive your letter of March 5, confirming that you have come to agree to the use of a bipartisan commission process for identifying and evaluating candidates for future vacancies on the federal bench in Washington state. As we have stated repeatedly, we are confident that a bipartisan commission that recommends nominees by a majority vote will produce excellent candidates for nomination.

With regard to the current pending vacancy in Tacoma, we will promptly assemble a group of experienced attorneys and community leaders to evaluate candidates, including Ronald Leighton. We will furnish the White House with our thoughts and recommendations accordingly.

With regard to future vacancies, a bipartisan commission of respected attorneys and community leaders would be assembled with ourselves appointing one half of a six member commission, and the White House or its designee appointing the other half of the members. In order to be recommended by the commission, candidates would need to receive the support of the majority of the members. We then will interview the candidates and forward recommendations to the White House. With regard to the preservation of rights and execution of responsibilities articulated in your letter, we agree.

It is our understanding that this process shall remain in place through the duration of the Bush Administration.
