This letter is to express my opposition to Executive Order #13233, entitled "Further Implementation of the Presidential Records Act"

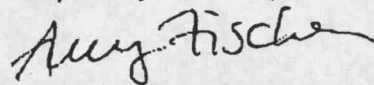
I am a professional, certified archivist, who has lived nearly all of my life in Littleton, Colorado. Of the many guiding principles that I, as a professional archivist, both practice and advocate, free and open access to information is one deemed of vital importance not only to our clients, but also, even more significantly, to the citizens of our democratic society. The implications of Executive Order 13233 are profoundly contrary to this established archival principle and cornerstone of democracy. Further, it is inconsistent with existing statutory law, 44 U.S.C. 2201-2207, which establishes presidential records as the property of the U.S. government and therefore places these records under the administration and management of the U.S. Archivist. This law was created to ensure that access to the vital historical records of our nation would not be governed by executive decree. Executive Order 13233 transfers such administrative decisions to the President, thereby essentially reversing the spirit of the original 1978 Presidential Records Act.

I urge Congress to assert its authority to promote and engage in dialogue that will reaffirm the importance of access to national historical records. It may be that some minor revisions to the Presidential Act are necessary; however, open discourse with consideration of many views and concerns are the methods by which changes occur in a democracy. Please do not let this Executive Order move forward without subjecting it to such examination.

Let me, once again, stress my extreme concern over this Executive Order. Its potential to restrict access to vital information undermines one of our nation's most important foundations. At this critical moment in time, we can ill afford to weaken the pillars of our freedom.

Thank you for your kind attention to this matter.

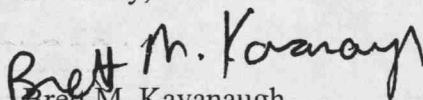
Dear Mr. Teague:
