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BACKGROUND ON NEW MEXICO'S STATE COVERAGE INITIATIVES (SCI)

- New Mexico has one of the highest uninsurance rates in the Nation. Although New Mexico's SCHIP program covers children up to 235 percent of poverty, nearly half (49.4 percent) of adults with income less than 200 percent of poverty are uninsured.
- Most uninsured Americans work, but they are not offered affordable health insurance through their jobs. One reason that the uninsured rate for Hispanic workers is more than twice as high as for other adults (40 percent versus 18 percent) is that they are much less likely to work in jobs that provide affordable health insurance.
- Your Administration has worked with the State of New Mexico to address this problem. On Friday, your Administration approved a waiver submitted by the State. This proposal, called the New Mexico State Coverage Initiatives (SCI) Project, was submitted under the Administration's Health Insurance Flexibility and Accountability (HIFA) program. HIFA is a new program set up last year to make it easier for states to expand coverage. It has already resulted in coverage expansions to thousands of Americans in other States. Altogether, your Administration has already expanded coverage to almost two million Americans since early 2001.
- New Mexico will provide health insurance coverage through employers for childless adults with income up to 200 percent of the Federal poverty level. The State will contract with private managed care organizations to provide benefits similar to mainstream commercial health insurance. An independent enrollment broker will market the program to employers in the State. The cost of coverage will be shared by the employer, the employee, and the State. Monthly premiums and copayments will be applied on a sliding scale based on family income.
- Phase One will cover an estimated 40,000 people, including 29,000 parents of Medicaid/SCHIP children and 11,000 adults without children who have low incomes.
- The program will also improve coverage for many more residents of New Mexico. Children who already qualify for Medicaid and SCHIP will be more likely to get coverage because studies show that giving assistance with health insurance costs to parents makes it more likely that they will enroll their children in coverage as well. Covering adults with the very lowest incomes will reduce the burden of uncompensated care that drives up the costs of government programs and insurance plans. Employers will also find it easier to offer health insurance coverage to their employees with incomes too high to qualify for the program.
- Your Administration appreciates the strong support for this initiative from key members of New Mexico's Congressional delegation. The Department of HHS has received letters of support for the New Mexico waiver from Senator Pete Domenici, Congresswoman Heather Wilson, and Congressman Tom Udall.

BIOGRAPHY OF JAY GOGUE

Dr. Gogue [gooj] became New Mexico State University's 20th president on July 1, 2000. He came to New Mexico State University from Utah State University, where he had been provost since 1995. Gogue was vice president for research at Clemson University in South Carolina from 1988 to 1995, and also served as vice president and vice provost for agriculture and natural resources at Clemson.

He and his wife Susie have three children, Jason, Alison and Barrett.

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BIOGRAPHY OF JOHN SANCHEZ

Inspired by his great-grandfather and grandfather, who was a State Representative, Sanchez turned his interest to public service. In 1998, he was elected Trustee for the Village of Los Ranchos by defeating a former mayor. In 2000, John defeated 30-year Democrat incumbent and Speaker of the House Raymond Sanchez in what many consider the largest State legislative race in New Mexico history. He and his wife Debra have two daughters, Alex and Demaree, and reside in Albuquerque's North Valley.

BIOGRAPHY OF STEVE PEARCE

Steve Pearce was born the third of six children on (b)(6) in Lamesa, Texas. In 1949, the family moved New Mexico, where he attended New Mexico State University (NMSU) and worked his way through college. He graduated from NMSU in 1970 with a B.A. in economics. He was recognized as the outstanding graduate of the Business College and a Distinguished Graduate of ROTC.

Following graduation, Steve began his military service as a pilot training at Reese Air Force Base and was eventually stationed in the Philippines flying missions into Vietnam. He left the military with the rank of captain. After running several successful business operations, he and his wife Cynthia purchased an oilfield service company, which has grown to ten times its original size.

He was elected State Representative for District 62 in 1996 and was reelected in 1998. In 2000, Steve placed second in a three-candidate Republican primary for the U.S. Senate. Steve is active in his business and has been appointed New Mexico Republican Party Platform Committee Chairperson and elected Second Congressional District Vice-Chair for the New Mexico Republican Party. Steve and his wife have one daughter, Lori Pearce Bova.
