*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "Independent Counsel Reauthor-
ization Act of 1994".

SEC. 2. FIVE-YEAR REAUTHORIZATION.

Section 599 of title 28, United States Code, is amended by
striking "1987" and inserting "1994".

SEC. 3. ADDED CONTROLS.

(a) **COST CONTROLS AND ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT.**—Section
594 of title 28, United States Code, is amended by adding at
the end the following new subsection:

"(1) **COST CONTROLS AND ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT.**—

"(1) **COST CONTROLS.**—

"(A) **IN GENERAL.**—An independent counsel shall—

"(i) conduct all activities with due regard for
expense;

"(ii) authorize only reasonable and lawful expendi-
tures; and

"(iii) promptly, upon taking office, assign to a spe-
cific employee the duty of certifying that expenditures
of the independent counsel are reasonable and made
in accordance with law.

"(B) **LIABILITY FOR INVALID CERTIFICATION.**—An
employee making a certification under subparagraph (A)(iii)
shall be liable for an invalid certification to the same
extent as a certifying official certifying a voucher is liable
under section 3528 of title 31.

"(C) **DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE POLICIES.**—An independ-
ent counsel shall comply with the established policies of
the Department of Justice respecting expenditures of funds,
except to the extent that compliance would be inconsistent
with the purposes of this chapter.

"(2) **ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT.**—The Director of the
Administrative Office of the United States Courts shall provide
administrative support and guidance to each independent coun-
sel. No officer or employee of the Administrative Office of
the United States Courts shall disclose information related

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to an independent counsel's expenditures, personnel, or administrative acts or arrangements without the authorization of the independent counsel.

"(3) OFFICE SPACE.—The Administrator of General Services, in consultation with the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts, shall promptly provide appropriate office space for each independent counsel. Such office space shall be within a Federal building unless the Administrator of General Services determines that other arrangements would cost less. Until such office space is provided, the Administrative Office of the United States Courts shall provide newly appointed independent counsels immediately upon appointment with appropriate, temporary office space, equipment, and supplies."

(b) INDEPENDENT COUNSEL PER DIEM EXPENSES.—Section 594(b) of title 28, United States Code, is amended—

(1) by striking "(b) COMPENSATION.—An" and inserting the following:

"(b) COMPENSATION.—

"(1) IN GENERAL.—An"; and

(2) by adding at the end the following new paragraphs:

"(2) TRAVEL EXPENSES.—Except as provided in paragraph (3), an independent counsel and persons appointed under subsection (c) shall be entitled to the payment of travel expenses as provided by subchapter I of chapter 57 of title 5, United States Code, including travel, per diem, and subsistence expenses in accordance with section 5703 of title 5.

"(3) TRAVEL TO PRIMARY OFFICE.—

"(A) IN GENERAL.—After 1 year of service under this chapter, an independent counsel and persons appointed under subsection (c) shall not be entitled to the payment of travel, per diem, or subsistence expenses under subchapter I of chapter 57 of title 5, United States Code, for the purpose of commuting to or from the city in which the primary office of the independent counsel or person is located. The 1-year period may be extended by 6 months if the employee assigned duties under subsection (1)(X)(iii) certifies that the payment is in the public interest to carry out the purposes of this chapter.

"(B) RELEVANT FACTORS.—In making any certification under this paragraph with respect to travel and subsistence expenses of an independent counsel or person appointed under subsection (c), such employee shall consider, among other relevant factors—

"(i) the cost to the Government of reimbursing such travel and subsistence expenses;

"(ii) the period of time for which the independent counsel anticipates that the activities of the independent counsel or person, as the case may be, will continue;

"(iii) the personal and financial burdens on the independent counsel or person, as the case may be, of relocating so that such travel and subsistence expenses would not be incurred; and

"(iv) the burdens associated with appointing a new independent counsel, or appointing another person under subsection (c), to replace the individual involved who is unable or unwilling to so relocate."

(c) **INDEPENDENT COUNSEL EMPLOYEE PAY COMPARABILITY.**—Section 594(c) of title 28, United States Code, is amended by striking the last sentence and inserting: "Such employees shall be compensated at levels not to exceed those payable for comparable positions in the Office of United States Attorney for the District of Columbia under sections 548 and 550, but in no event shall any such employee be compensated at a rate greater than the rate of basic pay payable for level ES-4 of the Senior Executive Service Schedule under section 5382 of title 5, as adjusted for the District of Columbia under section 5304 of that title regardless of the locality in which an employee is employed."

(d) **ETHICS ENFORCEMENT.**—Section 594(j) of title 28, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

"(5) **ENFORCEMENT.**—The Attorney General and the Director of the Office of Government Ethics have authority to enforce compliance with this subsection."

(e) **COMPLIANCE WITH POLICIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE.**—Section 594(f) of title 28, United States Code, is amended—

(1) by striking "shall, except where not possible, comply" and inserting "shall, except to the extent that to do so would be inconsistent with the purposes of this chapter, comply";

(2) by adding at the end the following: "To determine these policies and policies under subsection (1)(1)(B), the independent counsel shall, except to the extent that doing so would be inconsistent with the purposes of this chapter, consult with the Department of Justice";

(3) by striking "An independent" and inserting the following:

"(1) **IN GENERAL.**—An independent"; and

(4) by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

"(2) **NATIONAL SECURITY.**—An independent counsel shall comply with guidelines and procedures used by the Department in the handling and use of classified material."

(f) **PUBLICATION OF REPORTS.**—Section 594(h) of title 28, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

"(3) **PUBLICATION OF REPORTS.**—At the request of an independent counsel, the Public Printer shall cause to be printed any report previously released to the public under paragraph (2). The independent counsel shall certify the number of copies necessary for the public, and the Public Printer shall place the cost of the required number to the debit of such independent counsel. Additional copies shall be made available to the public through the depository library program and Superintendent of Documents sales program pursuant to sections 1702 and 1903 of title 44."

(g) **ANNUAL REPORTS TO CONGRESS.**—Section 595(a)(2) of title 28, United States Code, is amended by striking "such statements" and all that follows through "appropriate" and inserting "annually a report on the activities of the independent counsel, including a description of the progress of any investigation or prosecution conducted by the independent counsel. Such report may omit any matter that in the judgment of the independent counsel should be kept confidential, but shall provide information adequate to justify the expenditures that the office of the independent counsel has made".

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(h) PERIODIC REAPPOINTMENT OF INDEPENDENT COUNSEL.—Section 596(b)(2) of title 28, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence: "If the Attorney General has not made a request under this paragraph, the division of the court shall determine on its own motion whether termination is appropriate under this paragraph no later than 2 years after the appointment of an independent counsel, at the end of the succeeding 2-year period, and thereafter at the end of each succeeding 1-year period."

(i) AUDITS BY THE COMPTROLLER GENERAL.—Section 596(c) of title 28, United States Code, is amended to read as follows:

"(c) AUDITS.—(1) On or before June 30 of each year, an independent counsel shall prepare a statement of expenditures for the 6 months that ended on the immediately preceding March 31. On or before December 31 of each year, an independent counsel shall prepare a statement of expenditures for the fiscal year that ended on the immediately preceding September 30. An independent counsel whose office is terminated prior to the end of the fiscal year shall prepare a statement of expenditures on or before the date that is 90 days after the date on which the office is terminated.

"(2) The Comptroller General shall—

"(A) conduct a financial review of a mid-year statement and a financial audit of a year-end statement and statement on termination; and

"(B) report the results to the Committee on the Judiciary, Committee on Governmental Affairs, and Committee on Appropriations of the Senate and the Committee on the Judiciary, Committee on Government Operations, and Committee on Appropriations of the House of Representatives not later than 90 days following the submission of each such statement."

(j) THRESHOLD INQUIRY.—Section 591(d)(2) of title 28, United States Code, is amended by striking "15" each time it appears and inserting "30".

(k) RECUSAL.—Section 591(e) of title 28, United States Code, is amended to read as follows:

"(e) RECUSAL OF ATTORNEY GENERAL.—

"(1) WHEN RECUSAL IS REQUIRED.—(A) If information received under this chapter involves the Attorney General, the next most senior official in the Department of Justice who is not also recused shall perform the duties assigned under this chapter to the Attorney General.

"(B) If information received under this chapter involves a person with whom the Attorney General has a personal or financial relationship, the Attorney General shall recuse himself or herself by designating the next most senior official in the Department of Justice who is not also recused to perform the duties assigned under this chapter to the Attorney General.

"(2) REQUIREMENTS FOR RECUSAL DETERMINATION.—Before personally making any other determination under this chapter with respect to information received under this chapter, the Attorney General shall determine under paragraph (1)(B) whether recusal is necessary. The Attorney General shall set forth this determination in writing, identify the facts considered by the Attorney General, and set forth the reasons for the recusal. The Attorney General shall file this determination with any notification or application submitted to the division

of the court under this chapter with respect to such information."

(l) **DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION.**—Section 592(e) of title 28, United States Code, is amended by inserting after "Except as otherwise provided in this chapter" the following: "or as is deemed necessary for law enforcement purposes".

(m) **CLARIFICATION OF AUTHORITY TO USE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE PERSONNEL.**—Section 594(d)(1) of title 28, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the following: "At the request of an independent counsel, prosecutors, administrative personnel, and other employees of the Department of Justice may be detailed to the staff of the independent counsel."

(n) **ATTORNEYS' FEES.**—Section 593(f) of title 28, United States Code, is amended—

(1) in the last sentence of paragraph (1) by inserting before "Attorney General" the following: "the independent counsel who conducted the investigation and"; and

(2) in paragraph (2)—

(A) by striking "may direct" and inserting "shall direct such independent counsel and"; and

(B) by striking all after "subsection," and inserting the following: "addressing—

"(A) the sufficiency of the documentation;

"(B) the need or justification for the underlying item;

"(C) whether the underlying item would have been incurred but for the requirements of this chapter; and

"(D) the reasonableness of the amount of money requested."

(o) **FINAL REPORT.**—Section 594(h)(1)(B) of title 28, United States Code, is amended by striking "and the reasons" and all that follows through the period and inserting a period.

SEC. 4. MEMBERS OF CONGRESS.

(a) **DISCRETIONARY AUTHORITY.**—Section 591(c) of title 28, United States Code, is amended to read as follows:

"(c) **PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION WITH RESPECT TO OTHER PERSONS.**—

"(1) **IN GENERAL.**—When the Attorney General determines that an investigation or prosecution of a person by the Department of Justice may result in a personal, financial, or political conflict of interest, the Attorney General may conduct a preliminary investigation of such person in accordance with section 592 if the Attorney General receives information sufficient to constitute grounds to investigate whether that person may have violated Federal criminal law other than a violation classified as a Class B or C misdemeanor or an infraction.

"(2) **MEMBERS OF CONGRESS.**—When the Attorney General determines that it would be in the public interest, the Attorney General may conduct a preliminary investigation in accordance with section 592 if the Attorney General receives information sufficient to constitute grounds to investigate whether a Member of Congress may have violated any Federal criminal law other than a violation classified as a Class B or C misdemeanor or an infraction."

(b) **POSTEMPLOYMENT COVERAGE.**—Section 591(b) of title 28, United States Code, is amended—

(1) by striking paragraphs (6) and (7);

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(2) by redesignating paragraph (8) as paragraph (6), and, at the end of that paragraph, striking the period and inserting "; and"; and

(3) by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

"(7) any individual who held an office or position described in paragraph (1), (2), (3), (4), or (5) for 1 year after leaving the office or position."

SEC. 5. GROUNDS FOR REMOVAL.

Section 596(a)(1) of title 28, United States Code, is amended by striking "physical disability, mental incapacity" and inserting "physical or mental disability (if not prohibited by law protecting persons from discrimination on the basis of such a disability)."

SEC. 6. REPORT ON WHITE HOUSE OFFICE PERSONNEL.

(a) **SUBMISSION OF REPORT.**—On July 1 of each year, the President shall submit a report described in subsection (b) to the Committee on Governmental Affairs of the Senate and the Committee on Government Operations of the House of Representatives.

(b) **CONTENTS.**—A report under subsection (a) shall, except as provided in subsection (c), include—

(1) a list of each individual—

(A) employed by the White House Office; or

(B) detailed to the White House Office; and

(2) with regard to each individual described in paragraph

(1), the individual's—

(A) name;

(B) position and title; and

(C) annual rate of pay.

(c) **EXCLUSION FROM REPORT.**—If the President determines that disclosure of any item of information described in subsection (b) with respect to any particular individual would not be in the interest of the national defense or foreign policy of the United States—

(1) a report under subsection (a) shall—

(A) exclude such information with respect to that individual; and

(B) include a statement of the number of individuals with respect to whom such information has been excluded; and

(2) at the request of the Committee on Governmental Affairs of the Senate or the Committee on Government Operations of the House of Representatives, the information that was excluded from the report shall be made available for inspection by such committee.

SEC. 7. TRANSITION PROVISIONS.

(a) **IN GENERAL.**—Except as provided in this section, the amendments made by this Act shall apply with respect to independent counsels appointed before, on, or after the date of enactment of this Act.

(b) **ASSIGNMENT OF EMPLOYEE TO CERTIFY EXPENDITURES.**—An independent counsel appointed prior to the date of enactment of this Act shall assign to an employee the duty of certifying expenditures, as required by section 594(l) of title 28, United States Code, as added by section 3(a), by the date that is 30 days after the date of enactment of this Act.

(c) **OFFICE SPACE.**—The Administrator of General Services, in applying section 594(l)(3) of title 28, United States Code, as added

by section 3(a), to determine whether the office of an independent counsel appointed prior to the date of enactment of this Act should be moved to a Federal building, shall take into account the moving, legal, and other expenses that might arise if the office were moved.

(d) TRAVEL AND SUBSISTENCE EXPENSES.—For purposes of the restrictions on reimbursement of travel and subsistence expenses of an independent counsel and employees of an office of independent counsel contained in paragraph (3) of section 594(b) of title 28, United States Code, as amended by section 3(b), as applied to the office of an independent counsel appointed before the date of enactment of this Act, the 1-year service period shall begin on the date of enactment of this Act.

(e) RATES OF COMPENSATION.—The limitation on rates of compensation of employees of an office of independent counsel contained in the last sentence of section 594(c) of title 28, United States Code, as amended by section 3(c), shall not be applied to cause a reduction in the rate of compensation of an employee appointed before the date of enactment of this Act.

(f) PERIODIC REAPPOINTMENT.—The determinations by the division of the court contained in the last sentence of section 596(b)(2) of title 28, United States Code, as amended by section 3(h), shall, for the office of an independent counsel appointed before the date of enactment of this Act, be required no later than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act and at the end of each succeeding 1-year period.

(g) REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.—No amendment made by this Act that establishes or modifies a requirement that any person submit a report to any other person with respect to an activity occurring during any time period shall be construed to require that a report submitted prior to the date of enactment of this Act, with respect to that time period be supplemented to include information with respect to such activity.

(h) REGULATORY INDEPENDENT COUNSEL.—Notwithstanding the restriction in section 593(b)(2) of title 28, United States Code, the division of the court described in section 49 of that title may appoint as an independent counsel any individual who, on the date of enactment of this Act, is serving as a regulatory independent counsel under parts 600 and 603 of title 28, Code of Federal Regulations. If such an individual is so appointed, such an independent counsel shall comply with chapter 40 of title 28, United States Code, as amended by this Act, in the same manner and to the same extent as an independent counsel appointed before the date of enactment of this Act is required to comply with that chapter, except that subsection (f) of this section shall not apply to such an independent counsel.

§ 105. Assistance and services for the President

(a)(1) Subject to the provisions² of paragraph (2) of this subsection, the President is authorized to appoint and fix the pay of employees in the White House Office without regard to any other provision of law regulating the employment or compensation of persons in the Government service. Employees so appointed shall perform such official duties as the President may prescribe.

(2) The President may, under paragraph (1) of this subsection, appoint and fix the pay of not more than—

(A) 25 employees at rates not to exceed the rate of basic pay then currently paid for level II of the Executive Schedule of section 5313 of title 5; and in addition

(B) 25 employees at rates not to exceed the rate of basic pay then currently paid for level III of the Executive Schedule of section 5314 of title 5; and in addition

(C) 50 employees at rates not to exceed the maximum rate of basic pay then currently paid for GS-18 of the General Schedule of section 5332 of title 5; and in addition

(D) such number of other employees as he may determine to be appropriate at rates not to exceed the minimum rate of basic pay then currently paid for GS-16 of the General Schedule of section 5332 of title 5.

(b)(1) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (2) of this subsection, the President is authorized to appoint and fix the pay of employees in the Executive Residence at the White House without regard to any other provision of law regulating the employment or compensation of persons in the Government service. Employees so appointed shall perform such official duties as the President may prescribe.

(2) The President may, under paragraph (1) of this subsection, appoint and fix the pay of not more than—

(A) 3 employees at rates not to exceed the maximum rate of basic pay then currently paid for GS-18 of the General Schedule of section 5332 of title 5; and in addition

(B) such number of other employees as he may determine to be appropriate at rates not to exceed the minimum rate of basic pay then currently paid for GS-16 of the General Schedule of section 5332 of title 5.

(c) The President is authorized to procure for the White House Office and the Executive Residence at the White House, as provided in appropriation Acts, temporary or intermittent services of experts and consultants, as described in and in accordance with the first two sentences of section 3109(b) of title 5—

(1) in the case of the White House Office, at respective daily rates of pay for individuals which are not more than the daily equivalent of the rate of basic pay then currently paid for level II of the Executive Schedule of section 5313 of title 5; and

(2) in the case of the Executive Residence, at respective daily rates of pay for individuals which are not more than the daily equivalent of the maximum rate of basic pay then currently paid for GS-18 of the General Schedule of section 5332 of title 5.

Notwithstanding such section 3109(b), temporary services of any expert or consultant described in such section 3109(b) may be procured for a period in excess of one year if the President determines such procurement is necessary.

(d) There are authorized to be appropriated each fiscal year to the President such sums as may be necessary for—

(1) the care, maintenance, repair, alteration, refurnishing, improvement, air-conditioning, heating, and lighting (including elec-

Types of Personnel

The following categories *are included in the EOP internal personnel calculations*.

Determinations as to which category a particular individual might be assigned are made on a *case-by-case basis* and take into account the responsibilities, work location, and supervision of the individual.

EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT EMPLOYEES - Full-time, part-time, or intermittent staff paid from funds appropriated to EOP agencies, including the WHO.

DETAILEE

REIMBURSABLE - An individual temporarily assigned to *a job different from his or her normal duties at his or her employing agency*, for a specified period of time. The individual is performing functions that would normally be performed by an EOP employee and that are *not in support of the mission of their parent agency*, thus the EOP agency reimburses the employing agency. *Reimbursement is determined by several factors* including the length of the detail, the receiving agency's authorizing legislation and/or the terms of the annual appropriations act for that agency.

NON-REIMBURSABLE - An individual temporarily assigned to *a job different from his or her normal duties*, for a specified period of time. The detail is not reimbursable because the employee is supporting matters similar or related to matters ordinarily handled by the parent/loaning agency and *will aid the loaning agency in accomplishing a purpose for which its*

appropriations are provided The detail is also not reimbursable when necessary services cannot be obtained by other means and the costs involved are minimal.

ASSIGNEES – Employees from any department or agency (including Schedule C appointees) assigned on a non-reimbursable basis *to perform the normal duties of their official position* while permanently, or temporarily physically located on the EOP Complex. Also includes members of the *active duty military on detail to another agency subject to the same reimbursement rules* as civilian detailees.

PRESIDENTIAL MANAGEMENT INTERNS - The Office of Personnel Management (OPM) manages this program in which graduate degree recipients are given assignments in different federal agencies. Participants in this program may have rotational assignments within or between agencies. NOTE: *Only those PMIs assigned to the EOP Complex are included in the personnel calculations.*

WHITE HOUSE FELLOWS - Candidates from the private sector or uniformed services who are given temporary appointments throughout the federal government through the President's Commission on White House Fellows. NOTE: *Only those White House Fellows assigned to the EOP Complex are included in the personnel calculations.*

The following categories *are not included in the EOP internal personnel calculations.* Determinations as to which category a particular individual might be assigned are made on a *case-by-case basis* and take into account the responsibilities, work location, and supervision of the individual.

HISTORICALLY PROVIDED SERVICES - These individuals are performing functions that *have been historically provided by their agencies to the EOP.* **(Employees performing historically provided services in the Visitors Office, Photo Office and the Gift Unit are counted, as these positions were in the original base line number of 1,394.)**

SENATE EMPLOYEES - These are individuals who support the Vice President in his role as President of the Senate.

OTHER PROFESSIONAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES - These are employees who *do not fit into any other category.* Included are federal government employees participating in formal career development programs (e.g., the Executive Potential Program or the Women's Executive Program). Under such programs, professional federal employees are rotated into different federal agencies to enhance their careers and to expand their experience. Program participants solicit their own rotations.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL PERSONNEL AGREEMENTS - Under the terms of the Intergovernmental Personnel Act (IPA), through arrangements with state and local governments, tribal governments, government organizations and associations, colleges and universities, and OPM-certified non-profit organizations, the EOP can accept professors and employees of these

organizations for periods of up to two years. Payment is determined on a case-by-case basis taking into account the nature of the assignment and the individual's employing organization.

AGENCY REPRESENTATIVES - Individuals who, as a part of the regular responsibilities of their agency position are *assigned to represent their employing agency* as a member of an interagency task force, board, council, or committee.

VOLUNTEERS - Individuals who volunteer their time and talent to assist the EOP. Volunteers working on discretionary policy issues will be asked to meet certain financial disclosure and conflict of interest requirements.

WHITE HOUSE INTERNS - This program is managed by the White House Intern Office. Students who have volunteered to participate as interns are selected and placed throughout the WHO.

STUDENT VOLUNTEERS - Graduate and undergraduate students who volunteer their time to an EOP agency under the terms of an agreement between the agency and the matriculating university or college.

SUBJECT: EOP USE OF TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES FROM
DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES

Some of the agencies and units of the Executive Office of the President have inquired about the guidelines for making temporary use of employees of other departments or agencies. This memorandum provides guidance concerning the various ways that employees of other departments or agencies may come to work at the EOP, together with a summary of the basic legal restrictions relating to each. Please be aware that the President has a statutory obligation to report to the Congress concerning EOP employment and staffing, so excessive or questionable use of the categories listed below may invite congressional scrutiny. Accordingly, all requests for obtaining assistance through the means described below must be submitted for approval to the White House Personnel Office pursuant to the procedures set forth in the accompanying memorandum from the Personnel Office.

Career detailees

Career civil servants may be detailed to the White House on a non-reimbursable basis for 180 days within any fiscal year but generally only after occupying their original civil service positions for at least three months. After 180 days in the fiscal year, each detailee will become reimbursable to the White House for the full amount of their agency salary. There are no restrictions on the official duties such detailees may perform while serving at the White House, and there is no need for the detailing department or agency to make a certification to the Office of Personnel Management of the kind required (and described below) for Schedule C detailees. The 180-day rule applies to all detailees to the Executive Residence, the White House Office, the Office of the Vice President, the Domestic Policy Council, and the Office of Administration; other units within the Executive Office of the President should consult with OA General Counsel concerning the relevant restrictions contained in Comptroller General opinions.

SES detailees

SES-level political appointees may be detailed to the White House on a non-reimbursable basis for 180 days within any fiscal year on the same terms as career civil servants, i.e., fully reimbursable to the White House after 180 days during the fiscal year. However, such employees are often highly compensated political appointees, and care must be taken to ensure that the duties performed at the White House are commensurate with the level of compensation received. In addition, the detail of such employees should be examined with greater care than the detail of career civil servants, because the number of such employees available to the detailing department or agency is limited by law and, although certification requirements formally apply only to Schedule C political appointees, the policy concerns animating those requirements may be thought to apply to SES-level political appointees.

Schedule C detailees

Occupants of Schedule C political appointee positions in the departments or agencies may be detailed to the White House on a non-reimbursable basis for 180 days within a fiscal year on the same terms as career civil servants, i.e., fully reimbursable to the White House after 180 days during the fiscal year.

However, the head of the detailing department or agency must certify to OPM that the Schedule C position was not created solely or primarily for the purpose of detailing the employee to the White House. Such a certification may be supported by facts such as the following: i) the prospective detailee will report for work at the department or agency for a meaningful period of time prior to being detailed to the White House; ii) the prospective detailee intends to return to work at the department or agency following the detail; iii) the prospective detailee will continue to report to a supervisor at the department or agency during the time of the detail; iv) the prospective detailee was identified for hiring by the department or agency, rather than by the White House; or v) the prospective detailee will continue to work part-time at the detailing department or agency during the detail. In addition, the General Accounting Office has in the past contended that Schedule C employees should not be detailed until 90 days after hiring by the department or agency, even though the law does not contain such a restriction.

Assignees

Employees of whatever category from the departments or agencies who continue to perform their permanent or regular duties while physically located at the White House have been considered by prior White Houses to be assignees rather than detailees and may be employed indefinitely on a non-reimbursable basis as long as their work continues to be exclusively, or nearly exclusively, that of the assigning agency rather than the White House.

Part-time assistants

Employees of whatever category from the departments or agencies who work only part-time at the White House on an intermittent basis (especially if their work at the White House relates to their duties with the lending department or agency) and/or who continue to perform their regularly assigned duties at the lending department or agency while they are also working at the White House are not considered detailees and may thus be used by the EOP on a non-reimbursable basis.

Detailees from intelligence agencies

Employees of whatever category from departments or agencies involved in intelligence may be detailed on a non-reimbursable basis for up to 180 days in the fiscal year without the need to make any certification concerning the purpose for which they were initially hired, even if they are political appointees.¹

Agency Representatives

Employees of departments or agencies may represent their departments or agencies on White House interagency task forces, working groups, boards, councils, or commissions indefinitely on a non-reimbursable basis. The task forces, working groups, boards, councils, or commissions must be formally constituted and properly funded, and the agency representatives must be designated by their employing agencies and must continue to report to and have their work supervised by those agencies. They may not hold themselves out as employees of the Executive Office of the President. The work of agency representatives should at all times support the operations and objectives of the employing department or agency.

¹ Specifically, the Appropriations Act exempts from the certification requirement individuals detailed from the CIA, NSA, DIA, offices within the Department of Defense for the collection of specialized national foreign intelligence through reconnaissance programs; the State Department's Bureau of Intelligence and Research, and "any agency, office, or unit of the Army, Navy, Air Force, and Marine Corps, the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Drug Enforcement Administration of the Department of Justice, the Department of Transportation, the Department of the Treasury, and the Department of Energy performing intelligence functions."
