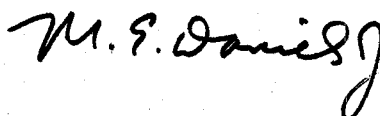
Discussion

H.R. 3248 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 65 North Main Street in Cranbury, New Jersey, as the "Todd Beamer Post Office Building".

Mr. Beamer was an account manager for Oracle Corporation. On September 11, 2001, he was a passenger on United Airlines Flight 93 when it was hijacked as part of the terrorist attacks. Using a cell phone, Mr. Beamer spoke with a telephone operator who alerted authorities of the plane's hijacking. It is believed that Mr. Beamer and other passengers, upon learning of the three other plane hijackings, attempted to overpower the hijackers. The plane crashed in Southwestern Pennsylvania, killing all aboard. Mr. Beamer was 32 years old.

Conclusion and Recommendations

We recommend approval of H.R. 3248, which passed the House by voice vote and the Senate by unanimous consent. Attached for your consideration is a press statement describing the legislation as a "fitting tribute" to Mr. Beamer.

This responds to the request for the views of the Postal Service on the following enrolled bill:

- H.R. 3248, to designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 65 North Main Street in Cranbury, New Jersey, as the "Todd Beamer Post Office Building".
1. Purpose of Legislation. This bill would express appreciation to the passengers and crew of hijacked American Airlines Flight 93 for diverting that aircraft from its intended target, through the honorary designation of a local postal facility.
 2. Position of the Postal Service. The Postal Service defers to Congress concerning the honorary designation of postal buildings for notable public figures.
 3. Timing. No recommendation.
 4. Cost or Savings. No information.
 5. Recommendation Concerning Presidential Action. The Postal Service does not object to approval of these bills by the President.
