“(13) On May 16, 2001, as part of the United States delegation to the World Health Assembly meeting in Geneva, Switzerland, Secretary of Health and Human Services Tommy Thompson announced to the American International Club the Administration’s support of Taiwan’s participation in the activities of the WHO.”

Purpose

Authorizes the Secretary of State to initiate a plan to endorse and obtain observer status for Taiwan at the May 2002 annual summit of the World Health Assembly.

Discussion

Public Law 107-10, which was enacted on May 28, 2001, authorized the Secretary of State to: (1) initiate a plan to endorse and obtain observer status for Taiwan at the World Health Assembly (WHA) summit held in early May 2001; and (2) instruct the U.S. delegation to Geneva to implement that plan.

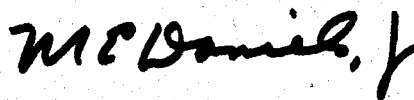
The WHA is the annual ministerial-level meeting of the 191 member states of the World Health Organization (WHO) and the WHO's highest governing body. The WHO requires statehood for membership, and its constitution does not explicitly allow for observers in the WHA. The WHA, however, has previously voted to allow observers (e.g., the Palestinian Liberation Organization) to participate in the activities of the organization. Since 1994, the State Department has worked with the Taiwanese authorities to identify and promote ways for Taiwan to informally participate in the WHO and other international organizations where membership is not feasible. In 1997, the WHA voted on a motion to grant Taiwan observer status, but the measure failed overwhelmingly. At last year's WHA summit, the Taiwan observer issue was raised and set aside without action.

H.R. 2739 amends P.L. 107-10 to authorize the Secretary of State to initiate a plan to endorse and obtain observer status for Taiwan at this year's WHA summit to be held in May 2002.

Conclusion and Recommendation

The Department of State recommends approval of H.R. 2739, advising that "[t]he bill has little practical impact as the legislation authorizes but does not require the Secretary of State to take action."

We join State and NSC in recommending the approval of H.R. 2739, which passed the House by voice vote and the Senate by unanimous consent.
