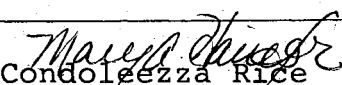

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The President will sign H.R. 3448, the Public Health Security and Bioterrorism Response Act of 2002 into law.

This Bill improves the ability of the United States to prevent, prepare for, and respond to bioterrorism and other public health emergencies. Specifically, the bill accomplishes the following:

- Authorizes new spending for FY 2002 and beyond for grants to States, local governments, and health care facilities for improved planning and preparedness;
- Improves communication between all levels of government, public health officials, first responders, and health care providers;
- Authorizes a new health and Human Services Assistant Secretary for Emergency Preparedness;
- Ensures a sufficient supply of drugs, vaccines, and other medical supplies;
- Enhances controls on deadly biological agents;
- Increases substantially the resources and regulatory authority to secure the safety of our Nation's food supply and drinking water systems; and
- Reauthorizes the popular Prescription Drug User Fee Act through 2007.
