1. Purpose of Legislation. These bills would honor numerous persons, including some former Members of Congress, through the honorary designation of local postal facilities.

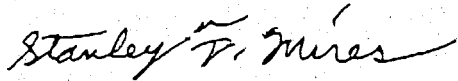
