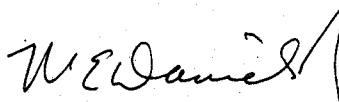
S. 360 would designate Peace Corps headquarters offices, wherever situated, as the "Paul D. Coverdell Peace Corps Headquarters". The enrolled bill would also amend the Paul D. Coverdell World Wise Schools Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-570) to require that references in Peace Corps documents to the World Wise Schools Program be references to the "Paul D. Coverdell World Wise Schools Program". (This program provides the opportunity for U.S. educators and their students to learn more about world affairs through correspondence with a Peace Corps Volunteer working in one of the 75 countries where Peace Corps serves.)

The enrolled bill also would require the Secretary of Education, subject to the enactment of appropriations, to make an award to the University of Georgia to support construction of the Paul D. Coverdell Building at the University's Institute of Biomedical and Health Sciences. S. 360 would authorize appropriations for this purpose of \$10 million for FY 2002.

Conclusion and Recommendations

The Peace Corps recommends approval of S. 360, stating that Senator Coverdell "served with distinction as Director of the Peace Corps from 1989 to 1991 . . . [and] it is appropriate to recognize Senator Coverdell's outstanding services to the Peace Corps."

We join the Peace Corps and Department of Education in recommending the approval of S. 360, which passed the Senate by unanimous consent and the House of Representatives by a vote of 330-61.

Dear Mr. Jukes:

This will respond to your letter of July 18, 2001, requesting the comments of the Peace Corps on S. 360, "An Act to honor Paul D. Coverdell."

The late Senator Paul D. Coverdell served with distinction as Director of the Peace Corps from 1989 to 1991. Sections 1 and 2 of the bill recognize and memorialize that service. The Peace Corps believes it is appropriate to recognize Senator Coverdell's outstanding services to the Peace Corps and recommends that the President approve this legislation.

Section 1 of the bill would require that the headquarters of the Peace Corps, wherever situated, shall be referred to as the "Paul D. Coverdell Peace Corps Headquarters."

Section 2 of the bill amends section 603 of the Paul D. Coverdell World Wise Schools Act of 2000 (title VI of Public Law 106-570) to require the Director of the Peace Corps to ensure that any reference to the Paul D. Coverdell World Wise Schools Program in a document, record, or other paper, including promotional material, produced by the Peace Corps subsequent to the enactment of the bill be a reference to the "Paul D. Coverdell World Wise Schools Program."

Title VI of Public Law 106-570 redesignated the Peace Corps program known as "World Wise Schools, which Senator Coverdell had established, as the "Paul D. Coverdell World Wise Schools Program."

Section 3 of the bill authorizes the appropriation of \$10,000,000 to support the construction of the Paul D. Coverdell Building at the Institute off the Biomedical and Health sciences at the University of Georgia.

The Peace Corps has no knowledge of the purpose of the appropriation authorized by section 3 of the bill, and defers to the opinion of the Secretary of Education, to whom the funds would be appropriated, with respect to this section.

Dear Jim:

I am writing in response to your request for the Department of Education's views on enrolled bill S.360, to honor Paul D. Coverdell. With respect to sections 1 and 2 of the enrolled bill, which would rename the headquarters of the Peace Corps the "Paul D. Coverdell Peace Corps Headquarters" and refer to the World Wise Schools Program as the "Paul D. Coverdell World Wise Schools Program," the Department defers to the recommendation of the Director of the Peace Corps as to whether the President should approve the enrolled bill.

With respect to section 3 of the enrolled bill, which would require, subject to the appropriation of funds, the Secretary of Education to award \$10,000,000 to the University of Georgia to support the construction of the Paul D. Coverdell Building at its Institute of the Biomedical and Health Sciences, the Department has no objection. If section 3 of the enrolled bill were considered alone, the Department of Education would recommend that the President approve the enrolled bill.
