Designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 1030 South Church Street in Asheboro, North Carolina, as the W. Joe Trogon Post Office Building.

H.R. 821 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 1030 South Church Street in Asheboro, North Carolina, as the "W. Joe Trogon Post Office Building".

Mr. Trogon has served as the mayor of Asheboro, North Carolina, since 1983. He also served on the Asheboro City Council from 1973 until 1983. Mayor Trogon is 68 years old.

H.R. 821 passed the Senate by unanimous consent and the House by voice vote.

This responds to the request for the views of the Postal Service on the following enrolled bills:

- H.R. 364, to designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 5927 Southwest 70<sup>th</sup> Street in Miami, Florida, as the "Marjory Williams Scrivens Post Office";
- H.R. 821, to designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 1030 South Church Street in Asheboro, North Carolina, as the "W. Joe Trogdon Post Office Building";
- H.R. 1183, to designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 113 South Main Street in Sylvania, Georgia, as the "G. Elliot Hagan Post Office Building";
- H.R. 1753, to designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 419 Rutherford Avenue, N.E., in Roanoke, Virginia, as the "M. Caldwell Butler Post Office Building";
- H.R. 2043, to designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 2719 South Webster Street in Kokomo, Indiana, as the "Elwood Haynes 'Bud' Hillis Post Office Building";

1. Purpose of Legislation. These bills would honor numerous persons through the honorary designation of local postal facilities.
2. Position of the Postal Service. The Postal Service defers to Congress concerning the honorary designation of postal buildings for notable public figures.
3. Timing. No recommendation.
4. Cost or Savings. No information.
5. Recommendation Concerning Presidential Action. The Postal Service does not object to approval of these bills by the President.

An Act

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 1030 South Church Street in Asheboro, North Carolina, as the "W. Joe Trogon Post Office Building".

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of  
the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.

The facility of the United States Postal Service located at 1030 South Church Street in Asheboro, North Carolina, shall be known and designated as the "W. Joe Trogon Post Office Building".

SEC. 2. REFERENCES.

Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of the United States to the facility referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference to the "W. Joe Trogon Post Office Building".

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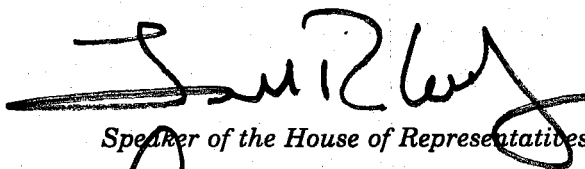

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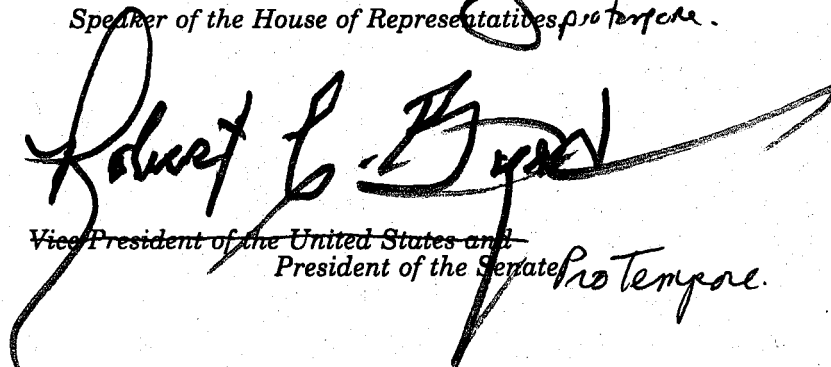

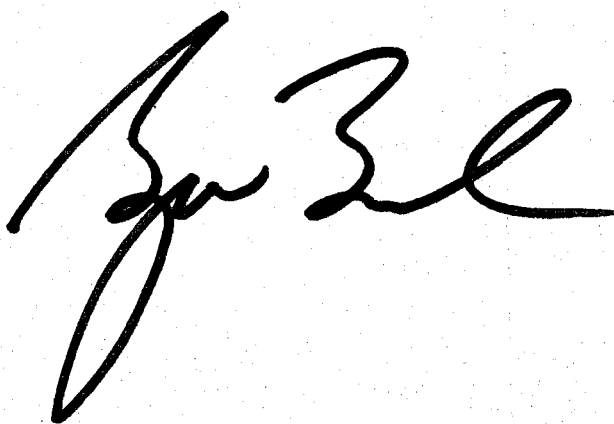
