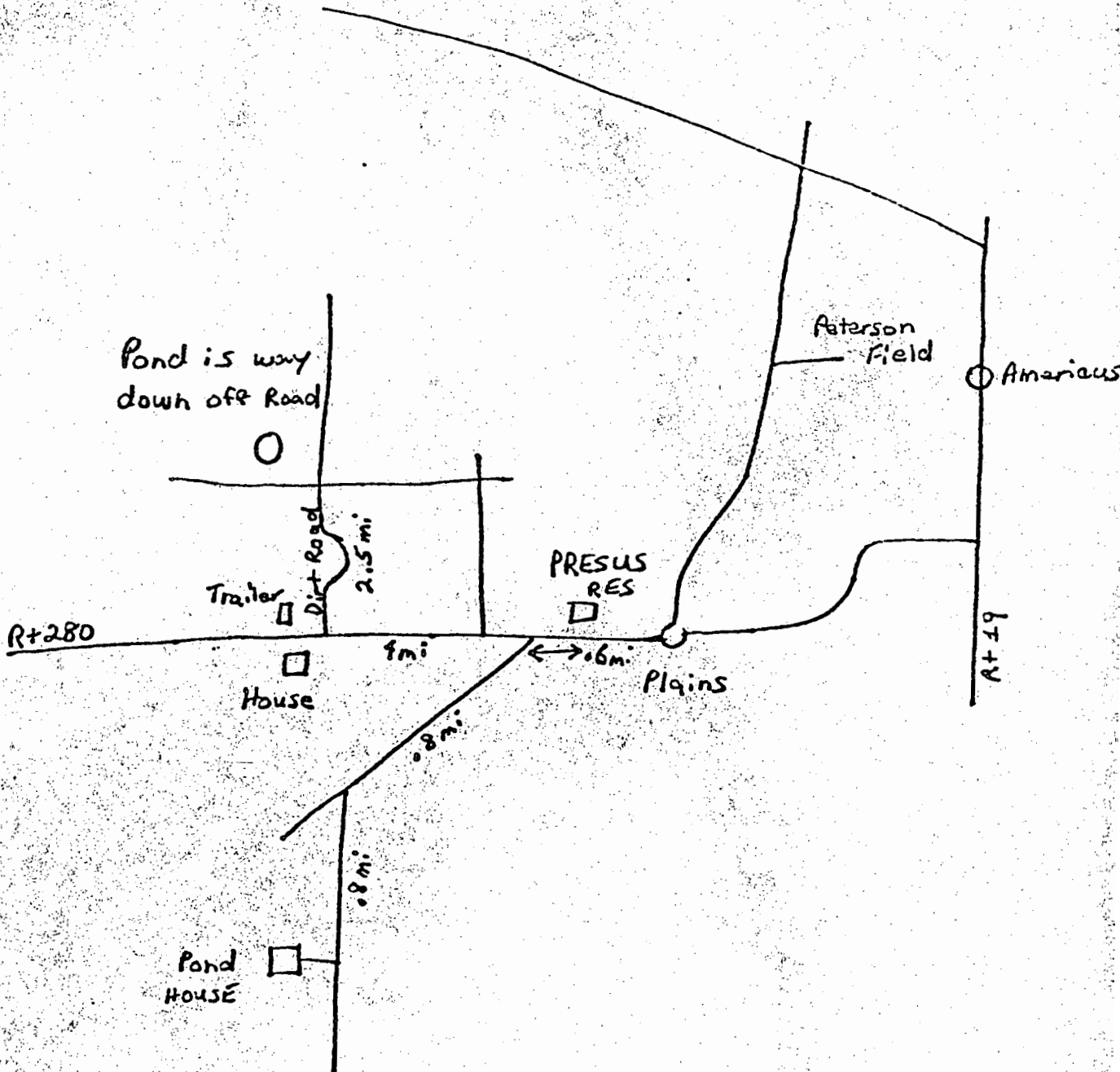
Overview Map
