First Lady Rosalynn Carter will travel to Maine on Wednesday, February 6 for a series of Carter/Mondale Presidential Committee sponsored events. Mrs. Carter will attend receptions in Van Buren, Bath and Portland. The First Lady will return to the White House Wednesday evening.

On Thursday, February 7, the First Lady will depart Washington in the afternoon for Minneapolis where she will attend a Senior Citizen Rally at the Minneapolis Auditorium. Later in the afternoon, the First Lady will travel to San Francisco where she will overnight.

On Friday morning, Mrs. Carter will attend a Carter/Mondale Presidential Committee fundraising breakfast at the St. Francis Hotel in San Francisco. In the afternoon, the First Lady will travel to Fresno where she will attend a fundraising reception, the annual luncheon meeting of the California Farm Bureau and a fundraising luncheon. In the evening, the First Lady will attend a fundraising dinner at the Beverly Hilton Hotel in Los Angeles.

On Saturday, February 9, the First Lady will travel to Oklahoma City where she will attend a Carter/Mondale reception and a fundraising reception for the Oklahoma Democratic Party.

The First Lady will return to Washington later Saturday evening.
