I'M VERY PROUD OF YOUR NEW FACILITY. IT IS EVIDENCE THAT THIS COMMUNITY -- CITIZENS AND OFFICIALS -- ARE COMMITTED TO PROVIDING QUALITY MENTAL HEALTH CARE IN THE CITY FOR THOSE WHO ARE IN NEED OF HELP. THAT IS SO IMPORTANT. IT'S IMPORTANT TO YOU AND IMPORTANT FOR THIS COMMUNITY.

I HAVE ENJOYED CAMPAIGNING THIS YEAR, GOING BACK TO THOSE PLACES I WAS IN 4 YEARS AGO -- SEEING FRIENDS I MADE THEN -- MAKING NEW FRIENDS. IT'S BEEN FUN.

I WAS HERE OFTEN, AND AS THE 1976 KENTUCKY PRIMARY APPROACHED, THE PRESIDENT AND I SPENT MANY NIGHTS IN YOUR HOMES, WALKING STREETS, VISITING PEOPLE WHERE THEY WORKED -- FARMS, TOWNS, FACTORIES, MILLS AND SUBURBS.

This reception was organized by Congressman Mickey Leland, one of C/M's five Campaign Co-Chairs. Almost all of those attending will be from Leland's district--Houston's inner city --which is about 45% black and 20% Mexican-American.

About 1/3 of those attending will be senior citizens from the 15 nutrition centers in the Houston area. This group will be predominantly black, with some Mexican-Americans and Anglos. Most of them are living below the poverty level. Congressman Leland's office mentioned that it has received a considerable amount of mail from senior citizens expressing concern that the President's anti-inflation program will result in cut-backs in the social security and food stamp programs. Senior citizens in Houston have consistently had the highest voter turnout rate in the area.

The rest of the crowd will be members of the Pleasant Grove congregation, which is entirely black, and people from area community centers. These people are from Houston's inner city, and most live on marginal incomes.

Reverend Jackson, the pastor of the Pleasant Grove Missionary Church, is a strong supporter of the President and an influential one. His congregation numbers close to 10,000 and is the largest in Houston's 5th Ward (which is also Congressman Leland's home ward). The Pleasant Grove Church is a new structure whose construction was financed entirely by community donations. It only recently opened, and Reverend Jackson is quite proud of it.
