I AM PLEASED TO BE BACK IN FRESNO. *Weather reminds me of home* SOMEONE ASKED ME IF THE HEAT BOTHERED ME, BUT I SAID "YOU FORGET, I AM FROM PLAINS, GEORGIA." AND I AM FROM A FARMING COMMUNITY, SO I UNDERSTAND SOME OF YOUR INTERESTS AND CONCERNS. I HAVE BEEN HERE TO YOUR FAIR.

YOU MIGHT BE INTERESTED TO KNOW THAT I'VE HEARD A LOT ABOUT FRESNO FROM MY PRESS SECRETARY, TOO. SHE WAS BORN IN VISALIA AND HER AUNT WAS A FRESNO COUNTY RECORDER. SHE SAYS SHE REMEMBERS AS A LITTLE GIRL THAT FARMERS BROUGHT THEIR CROPS TO MARKET AT THE COURT HOUSE. AND THAT EVERY CHRISTMAS PEOPLE FROM ALL OVER THE VALLEY DROVE HERE THROUGH THE FIG GARDENS TO LOOK AT BEAUTIFUL BLOCKS OF OUTDOOR CHRISTMAS LIGHTS.

WELL, OBVIOUSLY DRIVING OVER 50 MILES AWAY TO LOOK AT A WHOLE COMMUNITY LIT UP BY OUTDOOR LIGHTS IS JUST ONE OF THOSE MEMORIES SHE WILL HAVE TO CHERISH. BECAUSE AMERICANS DON'T DO THOSE THINGS ANYMORE.

AND I THINK PEOPLE ARE WILLING--EVEN EXCITED ABOUT THE SMALL, INDIVIDUAL SACRIFICES THAT WE MUST MAKE FOR OUR COUNTRY.

POLITICAL REMARKS FOR MRS. CARTER

THERE ARE CRITICAL MOMENTS IN THE HISTORY OF ANY GREAT NATION. THE DEPRESSION, WORLD WAR II, AND THE CIVIL RIGHTS REVOLUTION WERE ALL IMPORTANT TURNING POINTS FOR OUR COUNTRY. JIMMY BELIEVES THAT OUR COUNTRY ^{now} IS AT ANOTHER CROSSROAD.
