RSC's REMARKS

I AM HERE TO TALK TO YOU ABOUT THE PRESIDENT AND ABOUT THE PRESIDENCY -- ITS DEMANDS -- ITS LIMITATIONS -- ITS OPPORTUNITIES.

IN 1976, WHEN I WAS CAMPAIGNING FOR JIMMY, PEOPLE WANTED TO KNOW WHO HE WAS AND WHAT HE WAS LIKE. I SAID THEN -- HE CARES ABOUT PEOPLE, HE IS TRUTHFUL, RELIABLE, INTELLIGENT AND COURAGEOUS.

I CAN REPEAT THOSE WORDS TODAY BECAUSE AS PRESIDENT HE HAS BEEN TESTED AND THESE ARE THINGS THE AMERICAN PEOPLE HAVE LEARNED ABOUT HIM OVER THE PAST 4 YEARS.

HE CARES ABOUT THE PEOPLE OF OUR COUNTRY AND THE PROBLEMS THEY FACE. AND HIS ACTIONS HAVE BEEN TO MAKE LIFE BETTER FOR OUR PEOPLE.

-- I REMEMBER THE '76 CAMPAIGN -- WE VISITED SENIOR CITIZENS -- SO AFRAID -- MENTALLY AFFLICTED

-- CITIES -- LARGE AND SMALL

I HAVE PERSONALLY SEEN HIM AGONIZE OVER BUDGET DECISIONS -- INVOLVED PROGRAMS THAT HE WANTED TO IMPLEMENT FULLY BUT INSUFFICIENT FUNDS.

WHEN HE MAKES DECISION AS PRESIDENT -- WHETHER IT BE ON ENERGY, ECONOMY, SOCIAL PROGRAMS -- HE THINKS ABOUT THE PEOPLE AND HOW THEIR LIVES WILL BE AFFECTED -- NOW AND IN THE FUTURE.

WE FOUND DURING THE CAMPAIGN HOW DISILLUSIONED PEOPLE WERE WITH MISLEADING STATEMENTS FROM HIGH OFFICIALS -- WATERGATE. HE PROMISED TO TELL THE TRUTH.

AND HE HAS KEPT THAT PROMISE AND HE WILL CONTINUE TO TELL THE TRUTH. AND HE WILL CONTINUE TO MAKE THE DIFFICULT DECISIONS -- EVEN WHEN IT SOMETIMES HURTS.

THE AMERICAN PEOPLE HAVE SEEN THAT HE IS CALM, COURAGEOUS AND RELIABLE. HE HAS PROVEN HIS ABILITY TO DEAL WITH CRISES -- WHETHER IT BE AN ENERGY CRISIS, AN ECONOMIC CRISIS, AN IRANIAN CRISIS (WE COULD EVERY EASILY HAVE BEEN AT WAR, EXCEPT FOR A CALM LEADER), OR EVEN AN UNEXPECTED PERSONAL CRISIS. DEALING SUCCESSFULLY WITH CRISES IS PART OF A PRESIDENT'S JOB -- BECAUSE FAILURE CAN MEAN CATASTROPHE.

ONE OF JIMMY'S GREATEST ASSETS IS HIS MODERATION! THE PRESIDENT SEES PEOPLE EVERY DAY WHO ARE EXCESSIVE IN THEIR DEMANDS -- WHO FEEL THEIR WAY IS THE ONLY WAY. HE HAS TO BALANCE THESE MANY VIEWS -- AND MAKE AN ULTIMATE DECISION -- AND HE DOES -- AND OFTEN TAKES THE HEAT FROM EVERY SIDE. HE KNOWS THE JOB OF THE PRESIDENT IS TO DO WHAT IS RIGHT AND REALISTIC FOR US.

HE WORKS HARD -- HAS INCREDIBLE ENERGY -- CAN ALWAYS MUSTER THE ENERGY TO DO WHATEVER JOB NEEDS TO BE DONE -- AND HE IS SMART. HE HAS THE ABILITY TO GRASP DIFFICULT PROBLEMS -- AND THIS IS CRITICAL IN THE OVAL OFFICE. SO MANY SERIOUS PROBLEMS COME TO A PRESIDENT. EVENTS ARE UNPREDICTABLE, AND OFTEN DECISIONS HAVE TO BE MADE WITHOUT DELAY.

BUT EVEN WHEN DECISIONS ARE MADE WITH MUCH STUDY AND SUFFICIENT TIME, I HAVE NOTICED THAT UNANIMITY AMONG ADVISORS IS MOST RARE WHEN THE DECISIONS ARE THE MOST DIFFICULT.

ONLY ONE PERSON HAS ALL THE KNOWLEDGE -- AND ONLY ONE PERSON HAS THE RESPONSIBILITY. I KNOW FROM CLOSE PERSONAL EXPERIENCE THAT THE PRESIDENCY IS A VERY LONELY POSITION.

JIMMY CARTER HAS KEPT OUR COUNTRY AT PEACE AND HE HAS WORKED FOR PEACE FOR OTHERS. AND THE BEST WAY TO KEEP OUR COUNTRY AT PEACE IS TO KEEP OUR COUNTRY STRONG, AND AS LONG AS JIMMY CARTER IS PRESIDENT OUR COUNTRY WILL BE STRONG.

NOW -- AFTER 3½ YEARS IN OFFICE -- MY HUSBAND IS A WISER MAN. HE HAS LEARNED A LOT ABOUT WHAT CAN BE ACCOMPLISHED FOR OUR COUNTRY.

WHEN WE FIRST WENT TO WASHINGTON, WE WERE OUTSIDERS -- FULL OF CONFIDENCE THAT WE COULD CONQUER CAPITOL HILL OVERNIGHT. WELL, LET ME TELL YOU, IT TOOK SOME TRIAL AND ERROR TO LEARN THE WAYS OF THE HOUSE AND THE SENATE. WE HAD TO LEARN SOMETIMES THE HARD WAY! BUT A GOOD PARTNERSHIP HAS BEEN DEVELOPED. THE EXPERIENCE HAS PAID OFF. SO FAR, IN THE PRESIDENT'S TERM IN OFFICE, CONGRESS HAS PASSED 4 OUT OF EVERY 5 BILLS SENT TO THE HILL! THAT'S A GREAT RECORD -- AS GOOD AS PRESIDENT KENNEDY AND PRESIDENT JOHNSON -- A RECORD OF WHICH THE WHOLE COUNTRY CAN BE PROUD.

AND THE THINGS HE HAS DONE HAVE NOT JUST BEEN THE EASY THINGS.

WE NOW HAVE IN PLACE -- AFTER 3 YEARS OF STRUGGLE -- A COMPREHENSIVE ENERGY PROGRAM. IT WILL BE THE BIGGEST ENTERPRISE EVER UNDERTAKEN IN PEACE-TIME AMERICA -- LARGER THAN THE TOTAL SPACE PROGRAM -- THE INTERSTATE HIGHWAY PROGRAM AND THE MARSHALL PLAN COMBINED.

AND IT'S GOING TO FREE US FROM OUR DEPENDENCE ON FOREIGN OIL. NOW THAT WE HAVE FINALLY LAID A GOOD ENERGY FOUNDATION, WE CAN REVITALIZE THE ENTIRE ECONOMY OF OUR NATION.

ONE THING WE HAVE LEARNED -- THERE ARE NO SIMPLE SOLUTIONS TO SERIOUS PROBLEMS THAT BUILD UP OVER THE YEARS. BUT THERE ARE RESPONSIBLE WAYS TO CREATE GOOD JOBS WITHOUT CAUSING INFLATION.

THERE ARE RESPONSIBLE WAYS TO STRENGTHEN OUR ECONOMY ENOUGH TO GUARANTEE OPPORTUNITY AND SECURITY FOR EVERY AMERICAN.

AND THE PRESIDENT HAS LAID OUT PLANS TO DO JUST THAT. HE HAS PROPOSED A CREATIVE PROGRAM TO REVITALIZE OUR ECONOMY BY HELPING US TO PRODUCE MORE, EXPORT MORE, INVENT MORE, AND EMPLOY MORE. IT WILL HELP THE GOVERNMENT AND THE PRIVATE SECTOR AND THE PUBLIC TO WORK TOGETHER TO KEEP THE ECONOMY ON TRACK. IT WILL HELP THOSE PEOPLE AND COMMUNITIES IN TROUBLE. IT WILL KEEP OUR TAXES -- AND INFLATION -- DOWN -- WHICH IS IMPORTANT TO ALL OF US.

FOR ANY NATION'S ECONOMY, THE SEVERE PROBLEMS COME IN TIMES OF GREAT CHANGE. FOR OUR NATION, THIS IS ONE OF THOSE TIMES.

BUT WE MUST REMEMBER THAT WE HAVE THE MOST PRODUCTIVE WORK FORCE ON EARTH -- THE HIGHEST STANDARD OF LIVING IN THE WORLD -- THE STRONGEST INDUSTRIAL BASE IN HISTORY. GOD HAS BLESSED US WITH UNEQUALLED HUMAN AND PHYSICAL RESOURCES. THERE IS NO DOUBT IN MY MIND THAT WE CAN OVERCOME ANY PROBLEM IF WE ARE CONFIDENT AND UNITED AND IF WE CONTINUE TO WORK IN A PRUDENT AND RESPONSIBLE WAY.

ONE LAST WORD ABOUT THE PRESIDENCY. THERE ARE MANY DIFFICULT DAILY CONCERNS THAT WEIGH ON THE MIND OF A PRESIDENT -- AND MY HUSBAND MUST CONSTANTLY ASSESS HIS ACTIONS WITH A SOBER AWARENESS OF THE FUTURE.

WHAT EFFECT WILL THE DECISIONS MADE TODAY HAVE ON THE FUTURE OF OUR COUNTRY, AND ON THE LIVES OF OUR CHILDREN AND OUR CHILDREN'S CHILDREN?

WHAT WILL THE WORLD LOOK LIKE IN THE YEAR 2000?

WILL WE HAVE A STRONG AND SECURE AND JUST SOCIETY HERE AT HOME?

ONE IN WHICH EVERY CHILD IS WELL NOURISHED, HEALTHY AND EDUCATED TO FULLY USE ALL OF HIS OR HER GOD-GIVEN TALENTS?

A FUTURE FREE FROM WANT AND DISCRIMINATION AND FEAR ...

AND WHERE EVERY PERSON CAN LEAD A CONTRIBUTING, SATISFYING AND HAPPY LIFE ... WHERE PEOPLE CARE ABOUT EACH OTHER.

AND WILL WE HAVE A WORLD AT PEACE?

THIS IS THE VISION WE ALL SHARE AND THE FUTURE WE ALL SEEK.

THIS ELECTION YEAR WE ARE FACED WITH 2 FUTURES. THERE ARE STARK DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE CANDIDATES AND THEIR PLANS FOR THE FUTURE.

AND THE CHOICE OF PATHS -- OUR PATH -- OR A CLEARLY-DIFFERENT CONCEPT OF THE FUTURE WILL BE MADE IN NOVEMBER.

WE NEED YOUR CONTINUING HELP. BUT I AM CONFIDENT THAT WITH YOUR HELP ON ELECTION DAY, THE RIGHT CHOICE WILL BE MADE AND JIMMY CARTER WILL BE RE-ELECTED PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

ONE LAST THING. WE HAVE A WONDERFUL COUNTRY WITH WONDERFUL PEOPLE. AND AS WE ENTER THIS NEW DECADE OF THE 1980'S, IT IS IMPORTANT THAT WE ABOVE ALL KEEP OUR FAITH -- IN GOD, IN OUR COUNTRY, IN OUR FAMILIES, IN OUR FELLOW COUNTRYMEN.

LET US REMEMBER ALSO OUR VALUES -- THOSE THINGS THAT ARE IMPORTANT IN THE THE WORLD, LIKE-FREEDOM, INDEPENDENCE, LOVE. LET US REMEMBER OUR VALUES AS WE WORK TOGETHER TO MAKE THIS COUNTRY EVEN GREATER THAN IT ALREADY IS.

THANK YOU, MARY ROSS. IT IS A PLEASURE TO BE WITH YOU.

I BRING GREETINGS FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

AMY -- WILL SOON BE 13 YEARS OLD -- TYPICAL -- CONSCIOUS OF HOW SHE LOOKS -- JUST HAD A BODY WAVE -- HAS STARTED BACK TO SCHOOL. I WISH I COULD BRING HER WITH ME WHEN I TRAVEL -- VERY BUSY SCHEDULE.

I WOULD LIKE TO COMMEND YOU AND YOUR ORGANIZATION FOR YOUR ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND YOUR VISION.

EIGHTY YEARS AGO YOUR FIRST PRESIDENT, S. WILLIE LAYTON, INSPIRED NEGRO BAPTIST WOMEN TO MOVE OUT INTO THEIR COMMUNITIES -- AND OUT INTO THEIR WORLD -- AND INTO THE MISSION FIELDS.

AFTER READING YOUR PROGRAM AND THE THINGS YOU HAVE DONE AND ARE DOING, I WAS REMINDED OF MY DAYS IN PLAINS AND OF HOW IMPORTANT THE MISSIONARY SOCIETY WAS TO ME AND MY MOTHER. WE STUDIED COUNTRIES' NEEDS -- SAVING FOR OFFERINGS. FIRST SPEECH I SAID NEVER SPOKEN -- "GO YE THEREFORE AND TEACH ALL NATIONS, BAPTIZING THEM IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER, SON AND HOLY GHOST." YOU HAVE FOLLOWED THIS COMMAND OF JESUS.

YOUR CURRENT PRESIDENT, MARY ROSS, A NATIVE OF MY OWN STATE OF GEORGIA, PICKED UP THE LEGACY OF S. WILLIE LAYTON. SHE HAS CONTINUED WORKING HER OWN KIND OF MIRACLE WITHIN THIS ORGANIZATION.

I HAVE READ ABOUT WHAT SHE HAS DONE FOR THE FOREIGN MISSION RETREAT, NATIONAL BAPTIST YOUTH CAMP AND SR. RETREAT -- WITH THE MISSION -- AND I COULD GO ON BECAUSE HER ACCOMPLISHMENTS ARE MANY. SHE HAS SHOWN WHAT MIRACLES CAN HAPPEN WHEN YOU HAVE JESUS AS A PARTNER.

So, CONGRATULATIONS TO YOU, MARY ROSS, AND ALL OF YOU BAPTIST WOMEN FOR ALL YOU DO TO BE OF SERVICE TO OTHERS.

THIS IS AN IMPORTANT TIME FOR YOU TO CONVENE TO DISCUSS IMPORTANT ISSUES, AND YOU HAVE CHOSEN VERY IMPORTANT ISSUES TO THINK ABOUT -- FAMILY, CITIZENSHIP, MORALITY, VALUES. ONE OF OUR MOST IMPORTANT CHALLENGES - STRENGTHENING FAMILY. YOU KNOW WHAT A STRONG FAMILY LIFE CAN DO. NEVER HAPPIER THAN WITH MY FAMILY -- THIS WEEKEND -- WE ARE A CLOSE FAMILY -- GIVES US STABILITY. THE FAMILY IS THE STRENGTH OF OUR COUNTRY -- BUILT ON A MORAL AND SPIRITUAL FOUNDATION -- PROVIDES THAT LONG-FOR PLACE TO STAND IN A TROUBLED WORLD.

WE DO HAVE A TROUBLED WORLD, AND THE DECADE OF THE '80's IS GOING TO BRING CHALLENGES TO ALL OF US.

AND I CAN ASSURE YOU THAT JIMMY CARTER IS DOING EVERYTHING HE CAN TO HELP YOU ACHIEVE THE GOALS WHICH ARE IMPORTANT TO YOU. YOUR GOALS -- YOUR HOPES AND DREAMS -- ARE IMPORTANT TO HIM AND TO ME.

AND I AM PROUD THAT JIMMY CARTER IS A MAN OF COMPASSION AND COURAGE -- WHO BELIEVES THAT ONE OF GOVERNMENT'S MOST BASIC OBLIGATIONS IS TO THE DISADVANTAGED, THE POOR, THE AFFLICTED, TO THE ELDERLY AND TO CHILDREN -- THAT GOVERNMENT MUST ENSURE FOR EVERYONE THE OPPORTUNITY FOR A DECENT LIFE AND A HOPEFUL FUTURE.

HE HAS WORKED TO CREATE JOBS. THERE ARE MORE BLACKS AT WORK TODAY, DESPITE THE RECESSION, THAN AT ANY TIME IN OUR HISTORY. AND JUST LAST WEEK, THE HOUSE PASSED THE PRESIDENT'S YOUTH EMPLOYMENT INITIATIVE, WHICH WILL ADD \$2 BILLION TO THE \$4 BILLION NOW BEING SPENT ON YOUTH EMPLOYMENT -- A PROGRAM FOR TRAINING AND EDUCATION FOR YOUNG PEOPLE WHO NEED A JOB AND WHO NEED HELP.

ALL YOUNG PERSONS SHOULD HAVE THE SKILLS AND THE OPPORTUNITIES TO USE THE TALENTS GOD HAS GIVEN THEM TO BECOME A PRODUCTIVE, CONTRIBUTING CITIZEN TO OUR SOCIETY.

HE HAS APPOINTED MORE BLACKS TO HIGH POSITIONS IN GOVERNMENT THAN ANY OTHER PAST PRESIDENT.

THESE APPOINTMENTS ARE IMPORTANT AND NECESSARY -- BECAUSE THEY CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE IN HOW GOVERNMENT WORKS, AND HOW GOVERNMENT SERVICES REACH THOSE WHO NEED HELP.

THE PRESIDENT HAS NAMED 40 BLACKS TO THE FEDERAL BENCH, MORE THAN ALL OTHER PRESIDENTS SINCE OUR NATION WAS FOUNDED. AND I DON'T NEED TO TELL YOU THAT THESE ARE LIFETIME POSTS -- AND THAT BLACK JUDGES WILL BE MAKING AN IMPACT ON OUR CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM FOR THE REST OF THIS CENTURY.

I AM NOT GOING TO LIST ALL OF HIS ACCOMPLISHMENTS, BUT I AM PROUD OF HIM.

-- SUBMITTED FIRST NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN BY ANY PRESIDENT - COVER IN 1ST PHASES - ELDERLY, POOR, MOTHERS, BABIES.

HE HAS WORKED VERY HARD TO MAKE SURE THAT THE POOR, ELDERLY, DISADVANTAGED, WEAK ARE CARED FOR IN THIS TIME OF INFLATION. HE'S WORKED TO SAVE SOCIAL SECURITY FROM BANKRUPTCY.

WE REALIZE THERE IS SO MUCH MORE THAT NEEDS TO BE DONE FOR THE DISADVANTAGED IN OUR COUNTRY.

BUT, I WANT YOU TO KNOW THAT JIMMY CARTER -- AND I -- ARE WORKING EVERY DAY IN WASHINGTON WITH YOUR THOUGHTS AND CONCERNS AND PROBLEMS AND HOPES AND DREAMS IN MIND. YOUR DREAMS FOR A BETTER FUTURE FOR OUR CHILDREN.

I AM GRATEFUL THAT YOU INVITED ME HERE TODAY TO SPEAK ABOUT THE PRESIDENT AND TO SHARE WITH YOU MY FEELINGS ABOUT OUR RESPONSIBILITY AS CITIZENS AND AS INVOLVED WOMEN. I WANT TO TELL YOU AGAIN HOW MUCH I ADMIRE YOUR WORK. I HAVE SEEN FROM MY EARLIEST DAYS IN THE SOUTH THE COURAGE OF BLACK WOMEN. I HAVE SEEN YOUR STAND FOR SPIRITUAL PROGRESS -- FOR AN END TO RACISM -- AN END TO POVERTY -- AND AN END TO HUNGER.

I HAVE SEEN YOUR STAND FOR EQUAL RIGHTS AND EQUAL OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL AMERICANS.

THESE ARE THE PRINCIPLES THAT GUIDE ALL OF YOU GATHERED HERE -- AND THESE ARE THE PRINCIPLES THAT HAVE GUIDED JIMMY CARTER SINCE HE HAS BEEN PRESIDENT.

UNDERLYING ALL OF THIS IS MY HUSBAND'S BELIEF IN MORALITY AND JUSTICE AND HIS DEEP RELIGIOUS CONVICTION. THIS BELIEF IS THE CHIEF INFLUENCE ON HIS LIFE AS IT IS ON THE LIVES OF YOU WHO ARE HERE.

FOR WE ALL KNOW THAT THE ULTIMATE TEST OF OUR LIVES IS NOT FAME OR WEALTH, BUT IN HOW WE HAVE SERVED GOD AND -- THROUGH THAT -- HOW WE HAVE SERVED OUR FELLOW HUMAN BEINGS IN THE CAUSE OF FREEDOM, FREEDOM FROM DISCRIMINATION, FREEDOM FROM HUNGER, FREEDOM FROM FEAR, FREEDOM FROM WANT, FREEDOM OF A FULL, CONTRIBUTING SATISFYING HAPPY LIFE.

FOR THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, LET ME THANK YOU FOR WHAT YOU MEAN TO US PERSONALLY AND FOR WHAT YOU MEAN AS ACTIVE, CONCERNED CITIZENS TO OUR COUNTRY -- AND FOR YOUR LAYALTY AND SUPPORT.

WE CARE FOR ALL OF YOU.

EIGHTY YEARS AGO, YOUR FIRST PRESIDENT, S. WILLIE LAYTON, INSPIRED NEGRO BAPTIST WOMEN TO MOVE OUT INTO THEIR COMMUNITIES -- AND OUT INTO THEIR WORLD. INTERNATIONAL UNDERSTANDING, EDUCATION, TRADES AND PROFESSIONS: SHE CHALLENGED WOMEN TO TAKE A MEASURE OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR THESE ISSUES. AND YOU DID.
