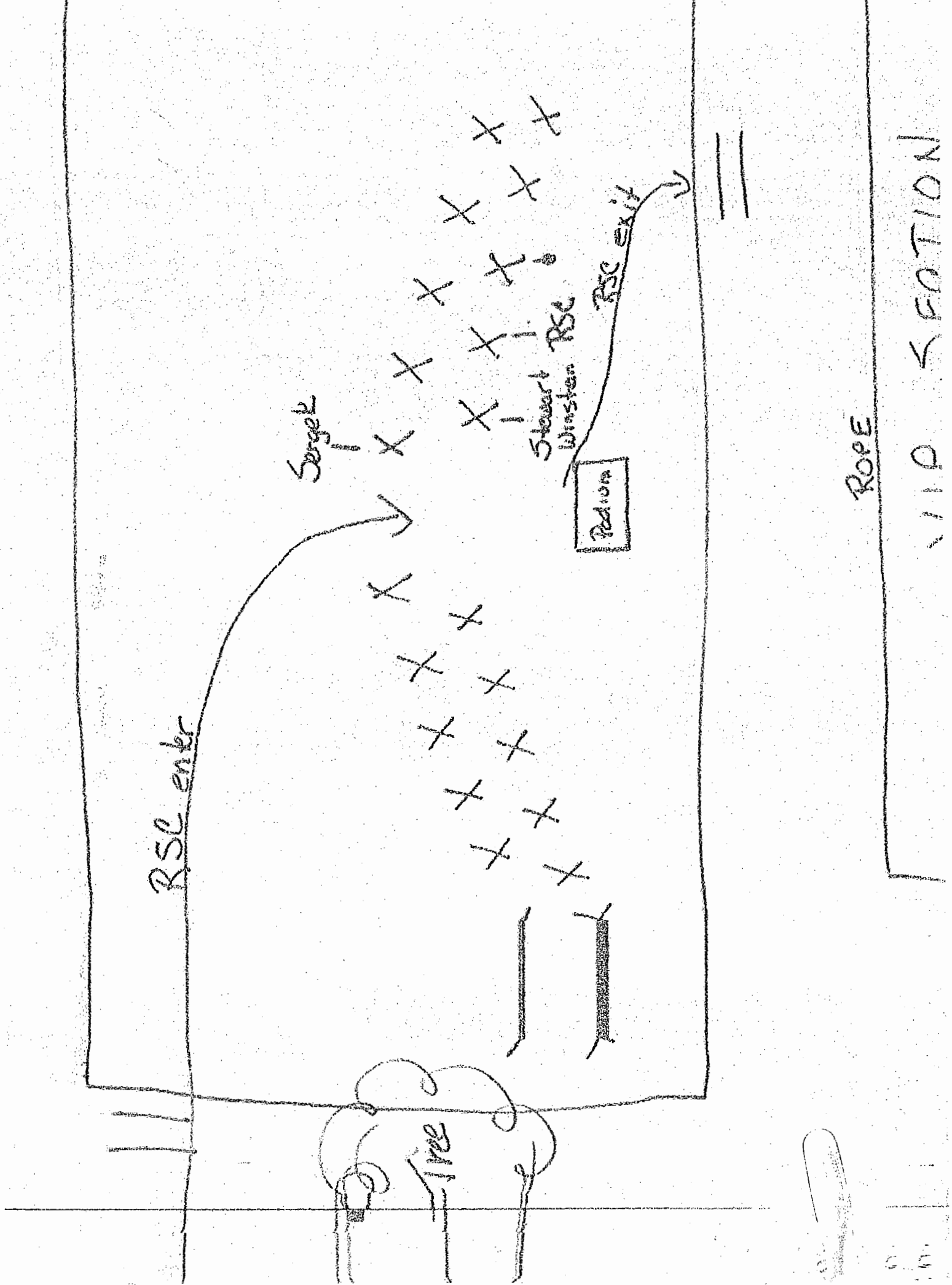

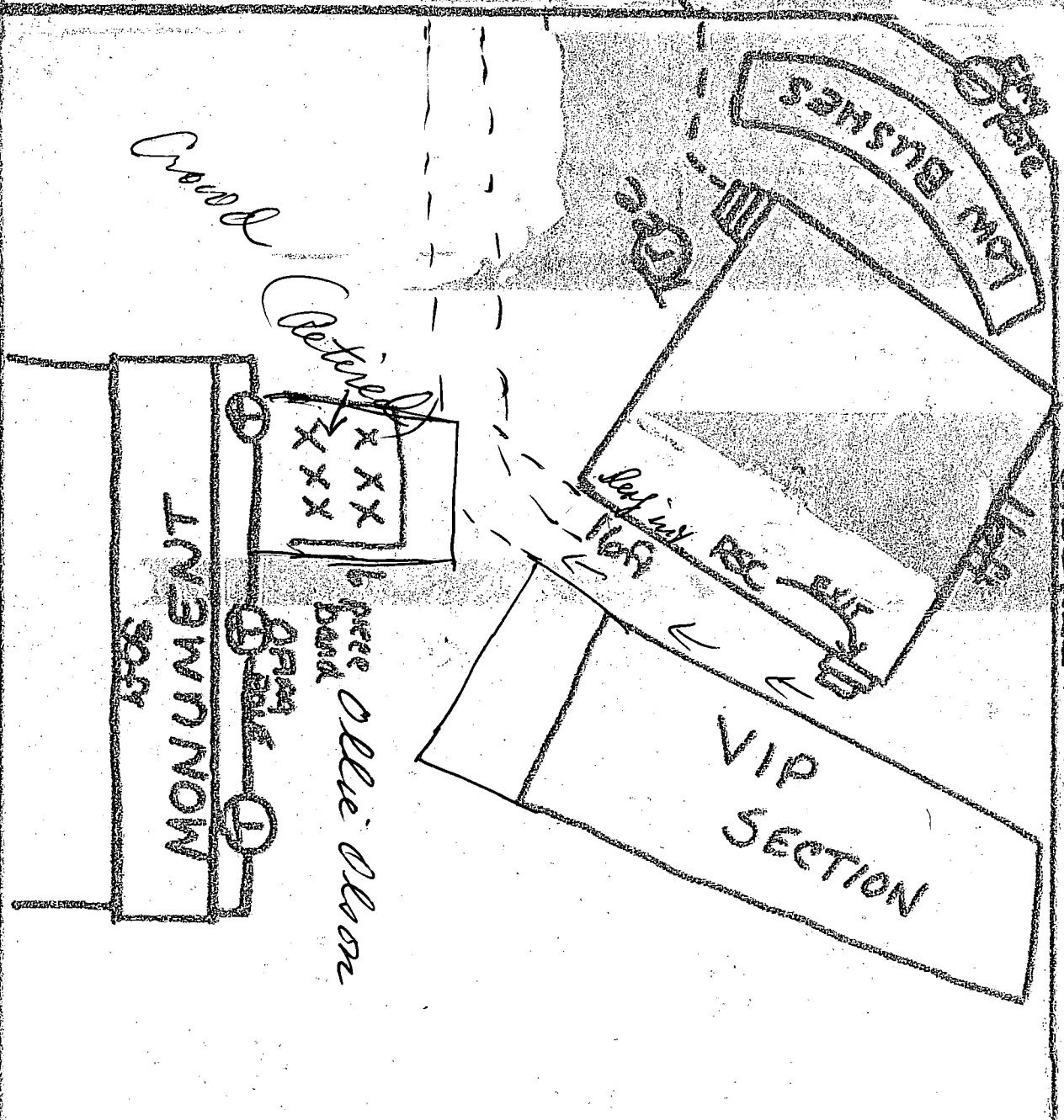

WE WANT TO BUILD AN ECONOMY THAT OFFERS HOPE AND OPPORTUNITIES AND A JOB FOR EVERYONE AND STABLE PRICES FOR ALL OUR CITIZENS. WE WANT TO BUILD A SOCIETY WHERE EVERY PERSON HAS A FAIR AND EQUAL OPPORTUNITY TO DEVELOP AND USE <sup>TO</sup> THE FULLEST THE TALENTS GOD HAS GIVEN HIM OR HER.

WE WANT TO LIVE IN A WORLD AT PEACE, WHERE AMERICA'S STRENGTH IS CLEAR, AND WHERE HUMAN RIGHTS ARE RESPECTED AND PRESERVED.
