SACRAMENTO CHILDREN'S HOME - SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA

Mrs. Carter's Remarks

It's wonderful to be here with you today. I enjoyed the tour through this fine facility, and I congratulate the concerned community leaders who work to be sure these services are available to those in need.

Exactly four years ago this week, I came to California to visit the Kern View Community Mental Health Center in Bakersfield. There I stated that if my husband was elected President, I would ask him to establish a Presidential Commission on Mental Health to examine the mental health needs of our country -- something that had not been done in 15 years.

As you know, I had worked with mental health programs in Georgia when Jimmy was Governor. And as I travelled across the country campaigning in 1975 and 1976, I personally visited mental health facilities, both good and bad; and I heard over and over again about the terrible problems so many people confronted in finding help for mental and emotional difficulties.

Just three weeks after Jimmy took office as President, he signed an Executive Order establishing the President's Commission on Mental Health, and asked me to serve as Honorary Chairperson. He has never wavered in his commitment to improving services for the mentally ill. And just last week, he signed into law the Mental Health Systems Act, landmark legislation that grew out of the report of the President's Commission on Mental Health and that charts a new course for federal mental health policy in the 1980's.

And one of your California Congressmen, Henry Waxman, played a vital role in passing this bill. This new law, Public Law 96-398, offers hope and opportunity to those who we have listened to and who over the past three and a half years have raised their voices in concern.

- The young mother in Tennessee who pleaded desperately before our Commission for better programs for her severely-disturbed son ... services like those provided here at the Sacramento Children's Home.
- The social worker who described the case of a young Puerto Rican child, labelled as mentally ill only because he didn't understand English;
- The elderly people dismissed as senile and shut away in nursing homes, people in rural areas who had no services at all, minorities whose problems were often misidentified and treatment frequently inadequate.

I remember in particular the state mental health commissioner who observed bluntly, "don't just tell us to move patients out of institutions, help us plan and create the programs they need in the community." And I know the people of California fully understand the devastating effects -- the terrible suffering -- that occurs when hospitals are closed with no place in the community for patients to go.

The Mental Health Systems Act represents a great victory for the millions of vulnerable people struggling with mental and emotional problems, and it represents a great victory for the dedicated professionals and people we found in communities all across our country who care -- and who are striving to provide comprehensive, humane services for those who need help.

It defines a more appropriate federal role in initiating and supporting mental health services and provides flexibility in responding to community needs. It targets limited resources on the most underserved areas and groups and establishes a new national priority for the care and support of the chronically mentally ill -- something that is so important to you here in California.

This Act forges an innovative new partnership between federal, state and local authorities in the planning and delivery of services and provides a framework for making comprehensive community-based mental health services available throughout our country. Unlike our opponent, Jimmy Carter knows that states must be involved in all aspects of mental health care.

In other important areas -- in financing, in research and prevention, in protecting patient's rights -- my husband's Administration has moved to correct the damage caused under eight years of Republican neglect. The President has proposed amendments to Medicare that would end discrimination against reimbursement for out-patient care and has included mental health benefits in his national health plan. The research budget of the National Institute of Mental Health has been increased by 75 percent, and for the first time, an Office of Prevention has been established. We have initiated a pilot advocacy program and the new Act provides additional funds for programs to protect the rights of the mentally ill.

For the first time, the Departments of HUD and HHS are cooperating on a joint effort to meet the housing and other support needs of the chronically mentally ill, and collaboration between the National Institute of Mental Health and other Federal agencies is becoming the rule rather than the exception. I am very proud of my husband's record in mental health.

It is so important to provide services for those who need help. In a country as great as ours, we all have an obligation to reach out to those who are vulnerable and to be sure that they know that all people have problems. Some handle them better than others, and all can be helped -- and so much of the time overcome their problems and live happy, contributing lives.

There are still problems that are disturbing -- a particular concern of mine is stigma. Stigma, more than anything else, still holds back progress in our field more than anything else. We have much more work to do to care for those who need our help. I want to continue over the next four years -- and with your help we can continue over the next four years -- to work to meet the needs of the vulnerable.

I have to talk to you about Jimmy Carter. I am proud that he is a man of compassion and courage, who believes that one of government's most basic obligations is to the disadvantaged, the poor, the afflicted, to the elderly and to children -- that government must ensure for everyone the opportunity for a decent life and a hopeful future.

He cares about the people of our country and the problems they face. He realizes the impact on everyone in the nation of our national problems -- energy, inflation -- and has worked to solve these problems and is making progress.

We now have a comprehensive energy program. And his economic policies are working. One thing we have learned. There are no simple solutions to serious problems that build up over the years. But there are responsible ways to create good jobs without causing inflation. There are responsible ways to strengthen our economy enough to guarantee opportunity and security for every American.

God has blessed us with unequalled human and natural resources, and there is no doubt in my mind that we can overcome any problem if we are confident, and united, and if we continue to work in a prudent and responsible way.

Jimmy Carter has learned a lot in the last four years, and he is a wiser man today. We need the benefit of his experience, his intelligence, his moderation and his calmness as we work together to make this country even greater than it already is.

The First Lady will travel to Everett, Washington Tuesday afternoon to attend a reception with senior citizens. Following that, she will attend a Carter-Mondale labor and Democratic Party rally.

Mrs. Carter will fly from Everett to Seattle, Washington, where she will attend a fund raising reception for State Representative Nita Rinehart.

The First Lady will return to the White House early Wednesday morning, October 14.

THANK YOU FOR THE INTRODUCTION AND FOR THE WARM WELCOME
HERE THIS MORNING.

I'VE BEEN TRAVELLING FOR MANY WEEKS ON THE CAMPAIGN TRAIL--
AND IT'S WONDERFUL TO SHIFT GEARS AND BE WITH YOU IN THIS
BEAUTIFUL CHURCH -- BEAUTIFUL MUSIC -- ON SUNDAY MORNING TO
WORSHIP.

THE CHURCH HAS ALWAYS BEEN IMPORTANT TO JIMMY AND ME. I
REMEMBER WHEN HE WAS ELECTED GOVERNOR -- A FEW DAYS BEFORE WE
MOVED TO ATLANTA, WE WENT TO SEE A VERY CLOSE FRIEND WHO WAS
DYING WITH CANCER. SHE ASKED US WHAT WE WERE GOING TO DO ABOUT
OUR CHURCH LETTER. JIMMY TOLD HER THAT HE THOUGHT WE WOULD
LEAVE IT IN OUR CHURCH AT HOME. IT WAS THE ONLY CHURCH HE HAD
EVER BEEN A MEMBER OF. SHE SAID, "MY MOTHER ALWAYS TOLD ME

SO, THE FIRST SUNDAY AFTER WE MOVED INTO THE GOVERNOR'S
MANSION, WE JOINED THE NORTHSIDE DRIVE BAPTIST CHURCH IN ATLANTA!

AND THE FIRST SUNDAY AFTER WE MOVED INTO THE WHITE HOUSE,
WE JOINED THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH IN WASHINGTON!

I GREW UP IN PLAINS, GEORGIA -- AS DID JIMMY -- POPULATION
600. AND IN SMALL TOWNS IN RURAL AMERICA WHEN I WAS GROWING UP --
AND I THINK STILL TODAY -- THE ENTIRE SOCIAL LIFE OF THE
COMMUNITY REVOLVED AROUND THE CHURCH.

WE HAD BAPTIST, METHODIST AND LUTHERAN CHURCHES IN PLAINS. MY GRANDMOTHER WAS LUTHERAN, MY GRANDFATHER BAPTIST, AND MY PARENTS WERE METHODIST. AND I WENT TO ALL THREE CHURCHES -- ALMOST EVERY TIME THE DOORS WERE OPENED!

BESIDES SUNDAY SCHOOL, CHURCH AND PRAYER MEETING, A REGULAR PART OF OUR LIVES WERE FAMILY NIGHTS AT THE CHURCH -- DINNER ON THE GROUNDS -- METHODIST LEAGUE -- BYPU -- AND LATER TRAINING UNION G.A.'S -- BIBLE SCHOOL -- REVIVAL MEETINGS.

I WILL ALWAYS BE GRATEFUL FOR THIS EARLY RELIGIOUS TRAINING -- AND FOR MY FAMILY AND THE TEACHERS AND LEADERS WHO TAUGHT ME ABOUT GOD AND WHO LEAD MY CHILDHOOD FRIENDS AND ME TO TAKE SERIOUSLY CALLS TO SERVICE. HELPING OTHERS BUILT AROUND MY MOTHER'S MISSIONARY CIRCLE AND THE G.A.'S AND OUR SS CLASS ACTIVITIES WAS A CENTRAL PART OF MY LEARNING AND MY LIVE. AND I'M SURE THIS IS TRUE WITH YOU TODAY.

WHEN JIMMY AND I MARRIED, I JOINED HIS CHURCH -- THE SAME BAPTIST CHURCH WHERE MY GRANDFATHER WORSHIPPED.

AND AS OUR FAMILY GREW, INVOLVEMENT IN THE CHURCH WAS AS NATURAL FOR OUR CHILDREN AS GOING TO SCHOOL -- AND DURING THOSE YEARS AT HOME, JIMMY AND I HELD JUST ABOUT EVERY OFFICE AND RESPONSIBILITY AT ONE TIME OR ANOTHER THAT THE CHURCH OFFERED. IN FACT, JIMMY HAD BEEN A REGULAR SUNDAY SCHOOL TEACHER EVEN WHEN HE WAS A YOUNG MIDSHIPMAN AT ANNAPOLIS.

WE DEVELOPED A GOOD HABIT IN TRAINING UNION TOO IN THE PLAINS BAPTIST CHURCH -- DAILY BIBLE READINGS. WE USED TO READ THEM TOGETHER WITH OUR BOYS.

NOW THE DAY IS NOT COMPLETE WITHOUT THIS TIME OF WORSHIP. WITHOUT A TIME TO BE STILL AND KNOW THAT I AM WITH GOD. JIMMY AND I READ A CHAPTER ALOUD EACH NIGHT -- USING A SPANISH BIBLE.

WE HAVE NOT LET LIVING IN THE WHITE HOUSE INTERFERE WITH OUR REGULAR WORSHIP ON SUNDAYS.

ALTHOUGH THE DEMANDS ON JIMMY'S TIME ARE GREAT, AND IT SOMETIMES CAUSES A STIR WHEN WE GO TO CHURCH, WE ARE REGULAR MEMBERS OF THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF WASHINGTON. JIMMY STILL TEACHES THE SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASS OCCASIONALLY.

WE OFTEN GO TO CAMP DAVID FOR THE WEEKEND ... CHAPLAIN ... AND WE HAVE SERVICES EVERY SUNDAY. WE MADE A LITTLE CHAPEL THERE IN ONE OF THE ROOMS - MOVIE THEATRE.

AMY, WHO IS 12 -- ALMOST 13, HAS MADE SOME GOOD FRIENDS IN OUR FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH IN WASHINGTON. SHE ATTENDS THE YOUTH FUNCTIONS THERE. SHE HAS ALSO BECOME FRIENDS WITH YOUNG PEOPLE IN OTHER CHURCHES AND PARTICIPATES IN SOME ACTIVITIES WITH THEM. WE ARE ANXIOUS THAT SHE CONTINUE TO MATURE IN HER FAITH.

MY TESTIMONY ABOUT THE CHURCH IN OUR LIVES COULD BE DUPLICATED BY MILLIONS ACROSS THE NATION AND AROUND THE WORLD. I AM GLAD THAT THIS IS TRUE AND THAT RELIGIOUS FAITH AND PARTICIPATION IN CHURCH IS IMPORTANT TO SO MANY PEOPLE IN OUR COUNTRY. DID YOU KNOW THAT THE PERCENTAGE OF PEOPLE WHO ATTEND WORSHIP REGULARLY IS THE HIGHEST IT HAS EVER BEEN IN AMERICAN HISTORY? I BELIEVE WE ARE EXPERIENCING A SPIRITUAL AWAKENING IN THE COUNTRY. WE ALL PRAY THIS IS TRUE.

WITH THE COMMITMENT THAT I FEEL FROM YOU HERE AT HIGH STREET BAPTIST CHURCH AND WITH THE NUMBERS OF BELIEVERS THROUGHOUT OUR COUNTRY, JUST THINK OF ALL THE GOOD WE CAN DO IN THE NAME OF OUR LORD. WE CAN REACH ACROSS RACIAL AND ECONOMIC AND RELIGIOUS LINES. WE CAN SHARE OUR LOVE -- AND CARE ABOUT ONE ANOTHER -- AND SERVE ONE ANOTHER.

WE ARE BLESSED AS A PEOPLE. GOD HAS BLESSED US WITH UNEQUALLED HUMAN AND NATURAL RESOURCES, AND OUR RELIGIOUS FAITH HAS BLESSED OUR NATION.

THERE IS NO DOUBT THAT OUR NATION AND THE WORLD ARE GOING THROUGH A PERIOD OF SIGNIFICANT CHANGE, BUT WE NEED TO UNDERSTAND THAT THOUGH OUR TIMES ARE DIFFICULT, THEY ARE NOT THE WORST OF TIMES. WE ARE NOT IN A GREAT DEPRESSION. WE ARE NOT IN A WORLD WAR. WE ARE NOT FACING SUCH STAGGERING CRISES AS THESE.

BUT WE ARE NONETHELESS FACING SOME MAJOR CHALLENGES. WE ARE LEARNING TO LIVE WITH AND DEAL WITH AN ENERGY CRISIS.

GOD HAS ALWAYS TAUGHT US TO BE GOOD STEWARDS AND TO SET A GOOD EXAMPLE FOR OTHER NATIONS -- AND WE ARE PROVING NOW THAT WE CAN DO THAT.

WE ARE STILL, BY FAR, THE STRONGEST NATION ON EARTH. BUT OUR STANDARDS OF MORALITY, FOR YEARS UNCHALLENGED, ARE BEING QUESTIONED AND PULLED AT. I HAVE HEARD OUR TIMES CALLED DAYS OF "FLOATING ANXIETY." THAT IS, WE ARE SURE THINGS ARE NOT QUITE LIKE THEY USED TO BE, OR LIKE WE WANT THEM TO BE, BUT WE ARE STILL NOT QUITE SURE WHAT'S WRONG.

HE HAS LEARNED THE INTRICACIES OF GOVERNMENT -- WHERE THE INFLUENCES ARE -- WHERE THE PROGRAMS ARE -- HOW TO COORDINATE THEM TO MAKE THEM WORK BETTER TO SERVE THE PEOPLE. IT TAKES TIME TO LEARN THE INNER WORKINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT.

IT TAKES TIME TO DEVELOP A GOOD WORKING RELATIONSHIP WITH CONGRESS.

IT TAKES TIME TO DEVELOP A KNOWLEDGE OF WORLD LEADERS -- AND THE PRESIDENT HAS DONE THIS AND HE'S LEARNED THE INTER-RELATIONSHIP OF OUR COUNTRY WITH COUNTRIES AROUND THE WORLD. HE KNOWS WHERE THE TENSIONS ARE, AND THE REASONS FOR THEM.

EXPERIENCE IS AN ASSET THAT IS VERY VALUABLE TO THE PRESIDENT AND TO OUR COUNTRY. AND THERE ARE OTHER ASSETS THAT ARE IMPORTANT. ONE IS HIS MODERATION. AND OFTEN TAKES THE HEAT FROM EVERY SIDE. BUT HE KNOWS THE JOB OF A PRESIDENT IS TO DO WHAT IS RIGHT AND REALISTIC FOR OUR COUNTRY.

AND HE IS SMART. HE HAS THE ABILITY TO GRASP DIFFICULT PROBLEMS. SO MANY SERIOUS PROBLEMS COME TO A PRESIDENT AND EVENTS ARE UNPREDICTABLE -- OFTEN DECISIONS HAVE TO BE MADE WITHOUT DELAY.

BUT EVEN WHEN DECISIONS ARE MADE WITH MUCH STUDY AND SUFFICIENT TIME, I HAVE NOTICED THAT UNANIMITY AMONG ADVISORS IS MOST RARE WHEN PROBLEMS ARE THE MOST DIFFICULT.

THERE IS ONLY ONE PERSON WHO HAS ALL THE KNOWLEDGE. ONLY ONE PERSON HAS THE RESPONSIBILITY. I KNOW FROM CLOSE PERSONAL EXPERIENCE THAT THE OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENCY IS A VERY LONELY POSITION.

I BELIEVE -- AND JIMMY CARTER BELIEVES -- THAT THE MOST IMPORTANT THING WE NEED RIGHT NOW FOR OUR COUNTRY IS STABILITY AND CONTINUITY IN THE PROGRAMS AND PLANS FOR OUR COUNTRY. WE DON'T NEED UPHEAVAL JUST AT THE TIME WE'RE BEGINNING TO SOLVE THE PROBLEMS.

WE HAVE NOT HAD A TWO-TERM PRESIDENT SINCE EISENHOWER.

I READ AN ARTICLE -- CONTINUITY

FOR THE FUTURE OF OUR COUNTRY -- I ASK YOU TO WORK VERY HARD FOR THE NEXT TWO WEEKS. YOU ARE THE ONES WHO WORK HARD. BUT IT IS SO IMPORTANT. I WANT TO ENCOURAGE YOU TO DO EVEN MORE.

RSC's REMARKS

WONDERFUL TO BE HERE WITH YOU TODAY. ENJOYED TOUR THROUGH THIS FINE FACILITY, AND I CONGRATULATE THE CONCERNED COMMUNITY LEADERS AND VOLUNTEERS WHO WORK TO BE SURE THESE SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE TO THOSE IN NEED IN THIS AREA.

EXACTLY 4 YEARS AGO THIS WEEK, I CAME TO CALIFORNIA TO VISIT THE KERN VIEW COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH CENTER IN BAKERSFIELD. THERE I STATED THAT IF MY HUSBAND WERE ELECTED PRESIDENT, I WOULD ASK HIM TO ESTABLISH A PRESIDENTIAL COMMISSION ON MENTAL HEALTH TO EXAMINE THE MENTAL HEALTH NEEDS OF OUR COUNTRY.

AS YOU KNOW, I HAD WORKED WITH MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAMS IN GEORGIA WHEN JIMMY WAS GOVERNOR. AND AS I TRAVELLED ACROSS THE COUNTRY CAMPAIGNING IN 1975 AND 1976, I PERSONALLY VISITED MENTAL HEALTH FACILITIES, BOTH GOOD AND BAD; AND I HEARD OVER AND OVER AGAIN ABOUT THE TERRIBLE PROBLEMS SO MANY PEOPLE CONFRONTED IN FINDING HELP FOR MENTAL AND EMOTIONAL DIFFICULTIES.

JUST THREE WEEKS AFTER JIMMY TOOK OFFICE AS PRESIDENT, HE SIGNED AN EXECUTIVE ORDER ESTABLISHING THE PRESIDENT'S COMMISSION ON MENTAL HEALTH, AND ASKED ME TO SERVE AS HONORARY CHAIRPERSON. HE HAS NEVER WAIVERED IN HIS COMMITMENT TO IMPROVING SERVICES FOR THE MENTALLY ILL. AND JUST LAST WEEK, HE SIGNED INTO LAW THE MENTAL HEALTH SYSTEMS ACT, LANDMARK LEGISLATION, THAT GREW OUT OF THE REPORT OF THE PRESIDENT'S COMMISSION ON MENTAL HEALTH AND THAT CHARTS A NEW COURSE FOR FEDERAL MENTAL HEALTH POLICY IN THE 1980's.

WE LISTENED TO SO MANY DURING HEARINGS OF THE PRESIDENT'S

COMMISSION ON MENTAL HEALTH, AND THIS LEGISLATION OFFERS HOPE AND OPPORTUNITY TO THOSE WHO WERE CONCERNED AND IN NEED.

-PEOPLE LIKE THE YOUNG MOTHER WHO PLEADED DESPERATELY BEFORE OUR COMMISSION FOR BETTER PROGRAMS FOR HER SEVERELY-DISTURBED SON ... SERVICES LIKE THOSE PROVIDED HERE AT THE SACRAMENTO CHILDREN'S HOME.

-THE SOCIAL WORKER WHO DESCRIBED THE CASE OF A YOUNG HISPANIC CHILD, LABELLED AS MENTALLY ILL ONLY BECAUSE HE DIDN'T SPEAK ENGLISH AND THE PERSON TRYING TO HELP HIM DIDN'T SPEAK SPANISH.

-THE ELDERLY PEOPLE DISMISSED AS SENILE AND SHUT AWAY IN NURSING HOMES

-PEOPLE IN RURAL AREAS WHO HAD NO SERVICES AT ALL

-MINORITIES WHOSE PROBLEMS WERE OFTEN MISIDENTIFIED AND TREATMENT FREQUENTLY INADEQUATE.

I REMEMBER IN PARTICULAR THE STATE MENTAL HEALTH COMMISSIONER WHO OBSERVED BLUNTLY, "DON'T JUST TELL US TO MOVE PATIENTS OUT OF INSTITUTIONS, HELP US PLAN AND CREATE THE PROGRAMS THEN NEED IN THE COMMUNITY."

AND I KNOW THE PEOPLE OF CALIFORNIA FULLY UNDERSTAND THE DEVASTATING EFFECTS -- THE TERRIBLE SUFFERING -- THAT OCCURS WHEN HOSPITALS ARE CLOSED WITH NO PLACE IN THE COMMUNITY FOR PATIENTS TO GO.

THE MENTAL HEALTH SYSTEMS ACT REPRESENTS A GREAT VICTORY FOR THE MILLIONS OF PEOPLE STRUGGLING WITH MENTAL AND EMOTIONAL PROBLEMS.

AND IT REPRESENTS A GREAT VICTORY FOR THE DEDICATED PEOPLE -- PROFESSIONALS -- WE FOUND IN COMMUNITIES ALL ACROSS OUR COUNTRY WHO CARE AND WHO ARE STRIVING TO PROVIDE COMPREHENSIVE, HUMANE SERVICES FOR THOSE WHO NEED HELP.

THERE ARE THREE POINTS I WOULD LIKE TO MAKE ABOUT THE MENTAL HEALTH SYSTEMS ACT. 1) IT PROVIDES FLEXIBILITY IN RESPONDING TO COMMUNITY NEEDS. 2) IT TARGETS LIMITED RESOURCES ON THE MOST UNDERSERVED AREAS AND GROUPS AND ESTABLISHES A NEW NATIONAL PRIORITY FOR THE CARE FOR THE CHRONICALLY MENTALLY ILL -- SOMETHING THAT IS SO IMPORTANT HERE IN CALIFORNIA. 3) THIS ACT FORGES NEW PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN FEDERAL AND STATE AND LOCAL AUTHORITIES IN THE PLANNING AND DELIVERY OF SERVICES. JIMMY CARTER HAS BEEN A GOVERNOR AND KNOWS THAT STATES MUST BE INVOLVED IN ALL ASPECTS OF MENTAL HEALTH CARE.

IN OTHER IMPORTANT AREAS -- IN FINANCING, IN RESEARCH AND PREVENTION, IN PROTECTING PATIENTS' RIGHTS, MY HUSBAND HAS MOVED TO CORRECT THE DAMAGE CAUSED BY EIGHT YEARS OF REPUBLICAN NEGLECT.

I AM VERY PROUD OF MY HUSBAND'S RECORD IN MENTAL HEALTH. IT IS IN GREAT CONTRAST TO THAT OF OUR OPPONENT. I WAS DISTURBED TO LEARN, DURING WORK ON THE PRESIDENT'S COMMISSION ON MENTAL HEALTH AND DURING HEARINGS, OF HIS RECORD WHILE GOVERNOR. HE LITERALLY PRESIDED OVER THE DISMANTLING OF MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES IN THIS STATE.

IN A COUNTRY AS GREAT AS OURS, WE ALL HAVE AN OBLIGATION TO REACH OUT TO THOSE WHO ARE VULNERABLE AND TO BE SURE THAT THEY ARE CARED FOR AND HELPED -- AND SO MUCH OF THE TIME THEY OVERCOME THEIR PROBLEMS AND LIVE HAPPY, CONTRIBUTING LIVES.

WE NOW HAVE THE NEW LEGISLATION, BUT THERE ARE STILL PROBLEMS THAT ARE DISTURBING -- A PARTICULAR CONCERN OF MINE IS STIGMA.

WE MUST CONTINUE TO WORK UNTIL MENTAL ILLNESS IS AS ACCEPTABLE AS ANY OTHER ILLNESS. AND THERE ARE OTHER THINGS THAT NEED TO BE DONE. I WOULD LIKE TO CONTINUE OVER THE NEXT FOUR YEARS -- AND WITH YOUR HELP WE CAN CONTINUE OVER THE NEXT FOUR YEARS -- TO WORK TO MEET THE NEEDS OF THE VULNERABLE.

I HAVE TO SAY A FEW WORDS MORE ABOUT JIMMY CARTER. HE CARES ABOUT THE PEOPLE OF OUR COUNTRY AND THE PROBLEMS THEY FACE.

HE REALIZES THE IMPACT ON EVERYONE IN THE NATION OF OUR NATIONAL PROBLEMS -- ENERGY -- INFLATION -- AND HE HAS WORKED TO SOLVE THESE PROBLEMS, AND HE IS MAKING PROGRESS.

WE NOW HAVE A COMPREHENSIVE ENERGY PROGRAM. AND HIS ECONOMIC POLICIES ARE WORKING -- GOOD ECONOMIC REPORTS.

ONE THING WE HAVE LEARNED. THERE ARE NO SIMPLE SOLUTIONS TO SERIOUS PROBLEMS THAT BUILD UP OVER THE YEARS. BUT THERE ARE RESPONSIBLE WAYS TO SOLVE THE PROBLEMS -- GOOD PROGRAMS IN PLACE. WE NEED CONTINUITY -- WE HAVEN'T HAD A TWO-TERM PRESIDENT SINCE EISENHOWER.

JIMMY CARTER IS WISER NOW. HE HAS LEARNED A LOT IN THE LAST FOUR YEARS. WE NEED THE BENEFIT OF HIS EXPERIENCE, INTELLIGENCE, MODERATION AND CALMNESS ... AS WE WORK TOGETHER TO MAKE THIS COUNTRY EVEN GREATER THAN IT ALREADY IS.

CALIFORNIA IS A VERY IMPORTANT STATE. WE NEED YOUR HELP TO MAKE SURE HE IS RE-ELECTED.

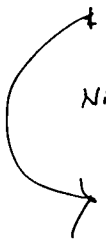
