SUBJECT: DECOR AND ENTERTAINMENT FOR KING HUSSEIN DINNER

DECOR

The ~~center of the table~~ throughout the length of the table, will be covered with <sup>sea</sup> shells from the Smithsonian collection and ~~decorated with seaweed, ferns, and trailing vines, and tiny flowers~~ to simulate the ocean floor <sup>and</sup> will be incorporated with the shells.

~~King Hussein is an oceanography buff and the lovely colors and shapes of the shells should be interesting.~~

The mollusk collection at the Smithsonian has been accumulating since 1840. There are approximately 12 million specimens and were all donated to the museum from around the world. Most of the shells we will use are from the western Pacific, Ryukyu (Reyoukoo), of which Okinawa is the main island.

The shell shapes include cones, cowries, augers, conch, giant clams, top shells, turbans, nerites, Trident trumpet, and cameo shells.

TOASTS: The First Toast should be made by the host to: HIS MAJESTY THE KING OF THE HASHEMITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN.

The Response Toast should be made to: THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

Subsequent toasts, if any, may be made in declining order of precedence.

NATIONAL ANTHEMS: It is not recommended that the National Anthems of the United States and the visitor be played unless the sponsoring organization is confident that the orchestra is able to play them very well. It is not necessary to play the Anthems at strictly social functions or at formal luncheons and dinners, as awkward situations and inconveniences may result. It is not the custom in Washington, D.C. to play the National Anthems at State Dinners or Luncheons. When the Anthems are played at events, it is customary to play the Anthem of the visitor's country first, then the Anthem of the United States.

FLAGS: When the flags of the United States and the visitor's country are used, consider the area where the flags are to be placed as a stage or focal point, then place the flag of the United States on the left as viewed from the audience, and the visitor's flag on the right.
