SUBJECT: GERRY MCENTEE

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Gerry McEntee, the President of AFSCME, has been trying to talk to the President for over three months (he acknowledged having casual meetings with the President like the bill signing). He said to me today, "I am embarrassed that I have not spoken with the President."

It would be helpful if the President called him before the AFL-CIO conference beginning on Friday in Bal Harbour.

If the President calls, he should be aware that McEntee a) seems to be okay on national service, i.e. he is not unduly worried about "job displacement;" and b) may raise the names of two people he believes would be excellent additions to the Clinton Administration, Rick Bloomingdale and Tony Carnevale.
